FOURTH OF JULY FESTIVITIES: The D-backs are hosting the ultimate Fourth of July weekend at Chase Field featuring a 2-day Fireworks Spectacular presented by Bar-S on July 3 & 4, and a Patriotic Tee giveaway for the first 20,000 fans on June 5.

Additionally, the team is offering 2 patriotic specialty food items during the 3-day celebration: Apple Pie Nachos (Churro Dog HQ, Section 129) and a Firecracker Dog (Big Dawgs, Sections 105 & 324).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 8-2 vs. Giants last night powered by 4 home runs.

- **Zac Gallen** won his sixth game after allowing 2 runs (1 ER) over 7.0 innings with 0 walks and 10 strikeouts.
- **Jake McCarthy** hit a 3-run homer (2) in the fourth inning and extended his hitting streak to 6 games...at 422 ft. was the second-longest homer of his career.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** added a 2-run homer in the fifth inning to extend his hit streak vs. Giants to 21 straight starts and has homered in back-to-back games.
- **Randal Grichuk** went 2-for-4 with 1 double, 1 homer and 1 RBI.
- **James McCann** followed with his first homer as a D-back to go back-to-back with **Grichuk**.
- **Anthony DeSclafani** tossed 2.0 scoreless innings, his fourth appearance of 2.0+ innings.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs signed RHP **Jake Woodford** (No. 41) to a Major League contract, optioned RHP **Juan Morillo** to Triple-A Reno after last night's game and designated LHP **Kyle Nelson** for assignment.

GALLEN'S 10/0 RATIO: Since 2022, **Zac Gallen's** 9 starts with 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks are most in the Majors (Source: SportRadar).

STINGY PITCHING: D-backs pitchers have allowed 0 walks in their last 19.2 IP (since Top 8 on June 29 vs. Marlins).
• Since June 23 (8 G) the D-backs starters' combined 2.98 ERA ranks fourth in MLB, behind the Phillies (1.04), Dodgers (2.77) and Brewers (2.97).

POTENT TANDEM: Since June 23, **Jose Herrera** (5 G) and **James McCann** (3 G) are hitting a combined .409 (9-for-22)/1.124 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 6 walks...the D-back duo ranks among leading catchers [min 30 PA] since June 23 in AVG (1st), OBP (1st, .533), runs (T-1st, 8) and OPS (2nd, 1.124).

FRESH ARRIVALS PROVIDE SPARK: Since being recalled from Triple-A Reno, **Jake McCarthy** has a 6-game hitting streak, batting .286 (6-for-21)/.985 OPS with 1 triple, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 1 walk.

- **James McCann**, since being signed on June 23, has hit safely in his first 3 games at a .500 (4-for-8)/1.667 OPS clip, with 1 double, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 3 walks.

BEST THINGS IN 3'S: The D-backs recorded their 14th game with 3+ homers last night and are 8-1 in their last 9 games when doing so and 11-3 overall.

- Since June 1, the D-backs' 7 games with 3+-homers are tied for second in the Majors (also: Cubs and Mets), behind the Angels (8).
- Their 14 3+-homer games are fourth in the NL, behind the Cubs (19), Dodgers (16) and Mets (15).

SNAKES VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 games vs. Giants with a 5.60 R/Game AVG and slashing a combined .292 (50-for-171)/.363/.567/.930 OPS with 8 doubles and 13 homers.

- Are 10-5 vs. Giants in their last 15 games since April 21, 2024 and 10-3 in their last 13 games @ Chase Field since May 12, 2023.

HOT BATS VS. GIANTS: **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 21 straight starts since June 24, 2023, batting .373 (31-for-83)/1.018 OPS with 7 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks...has recorded 2 hits in 5 of his last 8 games.

- **Ketel Marte**, in his last 15 starts since Sept. 19, 2023, is hitting .322 (19-for-59)/.906 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 8 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 12 games since Sept. 19, 2023, is hitting .319 (15-for-47)/.385 OBP with 2 doubles, 5 RBI and 5 walks, including 6 multi-hit games.
- **Josh Naylor**, in his last 10 games since April 16, 2022, is hitting .318 (14-for-44)/.902 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 1 walk, including 6 multi-hits.

HEAD-TO-HEAD NL WEST: In head-to-head NL West play, the D-backs own the best OPS (.839), SLG (.504) with the most homers (40), extra-base hits (82) and stolen bases (16)...additionally, they rank second in win pct. (13-8, .619), behind the Dodgers (17-6, .739).

- **Eugenio Suarez** has homered in 5 of his last 7 games...in his last 16 games, is hitting .333 (19-for-57)/1.195 OPS with 3 doubles, 8 homers, 22 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 20 games, is hitting .333 (225-for-75)/.914 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 15 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Ketel Marte**, in his last 12 games, is hitting .318 (14-for-44)/1.025 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.

SAFELY AT HOME: **Josh Naylor** has reached base in 19 of his last 20 home games, batting .365 (27-for-74)/1.002 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 16 RBI and 6 walks.
• Hit safely in 6 of his last 7 at home at a .423 clip (11-for-26) with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 3 walks.

MORE TRENDING HOME BATS: **Eugenio Suárez** has reached base safely in 8 of in his last 9 games, is hitting .333 (11-for-33)/1.116 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers and 11 RBI.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has homered in back-to-back games...in his last 16 games, is batting .305 (18-for-59)/.861 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers and 9 RBI.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 11 home games, is batting .310 (13-for-42)/.892 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 7 walks.

SPARK UP TOP: **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 15 games batting leadoff since April 11, is slashing .328 (20-for-61)/.406/.459/.865 with 5 doubles, 1 homer, 11 RBI and 8 walks.
