RAY REPORT-The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-3),
Kansas City (3 to play) and Oakland (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Fieldthe Rays have
lost a season-high four straight games, their longest skid since dropping five straight
from July 16-20, 2023entering the streak, they had gone 11-4 in their previous 15 games
from May 3-18 on the heels of a 2-8 stretch from April 21-May 1yesterday's off day
began a stretch of four in a span of 15 days from May 23-June 6the Rays are a season-
high 9.5 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since concluding the
2022 season 13.0 games backthey are under .500 for the first time since entering play
on May 15 (21-22) and have spent the entire season within four games of the .500 mark.
The Rays are coming off a 13-game stretch entirely against AI Fast opponents

The Rays are coming off a 13-game stretch entirely against AL East opponents, going 6-7...they dropped from 6.0 GB to 9.5 GB in the division over that span. During their four-game skid, the Rays are averaging 2.3 runs per game and have been outscored, 23-9...they are slashing .176/.243/.248 (22-for-125) collectively with only 5 XBH.

Tampa Bay pitching has yielded 5+ runs in all four games of the losing streak, their longest single-season stretch since Sept. 22-26, 2023 (4G)...the Rays have not allowed 5+ tallies in five straight since Aug. 9-13, 2023.

The Rays have trailed by 3+ runs at some point in each of their last five games... they have lost back-to-back games despite holding multi-run leads in both contests—they began the season 20-1 when leading by multiple runs at any point, with the lone loss coming on April 27 at CWS (led 3-0, lost 8-7).

The Rays will don their throwback Devil Rays uniforms tonight, which they are 13-4 in since the threads debuted on Opening Day last season (2-1 in 2024).

SERIES STUFE—Tampa Bay is coming off a series sweep at the hands of Boston, its second of the season, joining April 26-28 at CWS...the Rays have still won four of their last six series on the heels of an 0-4-1 stretch...however, they have dropped back-to-back home sets for the first time since losing three straight from July 4-23, 2023 (PHI, ATL, BAL).

The Rays are 6-10 in series openers, including 3-6 at Tropicana Field...they are 5-2 in their last seven following a 1-8 start, but have not won a series-opening contest at home since May 6 vs. CWS (8-2), dropping two straight (NYY, BOS).

OPENING ACT—RHP Shawn Armstrong will make his fourth start of the season as an opener for bulk reliever LHP Tyler Alexander...despite allowing at least one run in each outing, the Rays are 2-1 in his previous starts this season (March 31 vs. TOR; April 14 vs. SF; April 24 vs. DET), all opening for Alexander...Armstrong has been the Rays opener each of the last five times the club has utilized one dating back to July 15 (G2), 2023 at KC.

In his last appearance, a start on May 17 at TOR, Alexander retired 22 consecutive Blue Jays to open the game before Danny Jansen's bloop single with one out in the 7th...it marked the second-longest individual perfect game bid in Rays history behind Drew Rasmussen, who sat down 24 BF on Aug. 14, 2022 vs. BAL before allowing a Jorge Mateo double on the first pitch of the 9th inning.

Since introducing the concept of an opener on May 19, 2018 at Angel Stadium, the Rays are 104-67 (.608) when using one, including 2-1 this season and a 12-9 mark in 2023...they are 411-296 (.581) in all other contests over that timeframe

Last season, the Rays used an opener 19 times in the first half of the season compared to only twice after the All-Star break (July 15-G2 at KC; Sept. 30 at TOR).

PEN PALS—Despite a 7.56 ERA (8.1IP, 7ER) in their last two games, the Rays bullpen has turned in a 2.29 ERA (70.2IP, 18ER) since May 3, second lowest in the majors behind the Guardians (2.24)...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA.

** LHP Garrett Cleavinger owns a 12.0 scoreless inning streak, the second-longest active run among AL relievers who have pitched in 2024 behind TOR Yimi García (15.1)...Cleavinger has gone 18 games without allowing an earned run, tied for the fourth-longest active streak in MLB behind PHI Matt Strahm (20G), SD Robert Suarez (19G) and CLE Emmanuel Clase (19G).

** RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 15 BF across five scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 7 SO...RHP Phil Maton has posted a 1.42 ERA (12.2IP, 2ER) and 0.55 WHIP in his last 14 games.

SMALL BALL—Tampa Bay has recorded 67 infield hits, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the majors...the Rays lead the AL in stolen bases (55), ahead of the Royals (50), and rank highly in times reaching via error (2nd, 17), pitches per plate appearance (3rd, 3.98), singles (T3rd, 291), hit-by-pitches (4th, 23) and sacrifice hits (T4th, 5).

However, the Rays rank 14th in the AL in slugging pct. (.359), ahead of only the White Sox (.331)...it signals their lowest mark through 51 games of a season since 2002 (.350)...their 116 XBH are second fewest in MLB behind the Marlins (111).

The Rays have allowed 67 HR, second most in the majors behind the White Sox (68), while hitting 42 HR of their own, 13th most in the AL/tied for 24th in MLB... their -25 HR margin is second lowest in the majors, besting only the White Sox (-33).

DIGGING IN—The Rays lead the majors in two-strike hits (180) and have the fifth-best average in two-strike counts (.183), trailing the Padres (.189), Royals (.187), Astros (.185) and Angels (.184)...according to Statcast, the Rays average bat speed drops to 69.5 mph in two-strike counts, fifth slowest in the majors, compared to 72.1 mph in all other counts... Isaac Paredes' swings have been tracked at an average of 65.7 mph after reaching two strikes...only SD Luis Arraez (61.3), TOR Justin Turner (64.6) and LAA Nolan Schanuel (64.7) have registered slower bat speeds in two-strike counts.

Paredes has recorded an MLB-leading 31 two-strike hits, outpacing HOU Jose Altuve and LAD Mookie Betts (both 29)...min. 75 AB, only Betts (.299) owns a better two-strike average than Paredes' .298 (31-for-104).

WELCOME BACK, Q!-Prior to being hired in Kansas City last season, Royals Manager WELCOME BACK, QI—Prior to being hired in Kansas City last season, Royals Manager Matt Quatraro spent five years on the Rays coaching staff, serving as bench coach (2018) and third base coach (2018-22), helping guide the club to its second World Series appearance in 2020...he began his coaching career with 10 seasons in the Rays farm system from 2004-13, primarily as a manager...Quatraro, who played all seven of his minor league seasons in the Rays system from 1996-2002, became the first Tampa Bay farmhand to join the organization as a coach in 2004.

Quatraro is one of three former members of Kevin Cash's coaching staff currently managing in the big leagues, joining MIN Rocco Baldelli and PIT Derek Shelton.

ROYAL AFFAIRS—The Rays and Royals meet for the first of six games in 2024 tonight in St. Pete...Tampa Bay will travel to Kauffman Stadium to conclude the season series from July 2-4...the Rays have won five straight season series over the Royals dating to 2018 (clubs did not meet in 2020), going 23-11 (.676) in that span (4-3 in 2023)...they have won three of four, six of nine, and 10 of the last 16 meetings...the Rays are 8-1-2 in their last 11 series vs. the Royals since Aug. 2017...they are undefeated in their last five home series against Kansas City (4-0-1), with their last series loss coming from May 8-11, 2017 (3-1).

The Rays are 3-6 against the AL Central, splitting their six home games (3-3)...this, after posting the AL's best winning pct. against the division in 2023 (.719/23-9).

- Rays reliever LHP Richard Lovelady, a 2016 Royals draftee, was in Kansas City's system from 2016 until a spring 2023 trade to the Cubs...he made 82 relief appearances for the Royals from 2019-21.
- RHP Jason Adam was drafted by the Royals in 2015 and made his major league debut with them in 2018 before being traded to such Blue Jays the following spring...he still resides in the Kansas City area during the offseason.
- INF Richie Palacios' uncle, Rey, was a backup catcher/utilityman for the Royals from 1988-90.
- Rays Pitching Coach Kyle Snyder spent parts of three MLB seasons with the Royals (2003, 2005-06), appearing in 29 games (19 starts)... The was drafted by both Tampa Bay (27th round, 1996) an Kansas City (1st round, 1999).
- Royals Bench Coach Paul Hoover played for the Devil Rays (2001-02), served as a Tampa Bay minor league coach (2012-18) and was a member of **Kevin Cash**'s major league coaching staff (2019-22).
- Royals INF Bobby Witt Jr.'s father pitched for Tampa Bay in 1999 during his 16-year career.
- Royals starter RHP Brady Singer pitched at the University of Florida (2016-18) and is a graduate of Eustis (FL) High School, located approximately 40 miles northeast of Orlando.
- Royals starter RHP Michael Wacha appeared in 29 games (23 starts) for the Rays in 2021.
- Royals reliever RHP Nick Anderson pitched for the Rays for three seasons (2019-21)...OF Hunter Renfroe appeared in 42 games for the Rays in 2020...both players were members of Tampa Bay's 2020 World Series squad.

TONIGHT'S OPENER: RHP SHAWN ARMSTRONG (0-1, 4.09)

- Armstrong will serve as the Rays opener for LHP Tyler Alexander. he has not allowed a run in his last three appearances (3.0IP, 1H, 4SO). This marks his fourth start of the season after going 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (4.0IP, 3ER) in three previous starts opening for Alexander
- his last such outing on April 24 vs. DET, he allowed a 1st-inning RBI-single, which was preceded by his second career balk. He made six starts last season, including four as an opener (June 7, July 15, Aug. 12, Sept. 30)...did not allow an ER in those games (12.0IP)
- In his career, Armstrong is 0-2 with a 1.19 ERA (22.2IP, 3ER) over 11 starts, all with Tampa Bay...the Rays are 8-3 in those games.

LAST TIME OUT—On May 17 at Toronto, Alexander carried a perfect game in the 8th inning, retiring 22 consecutive Blue Jays before **Danny Jansen's** bloop single...Jansen's single was followed by a **Davis Schneider** homer and a **Daniel Vogelbach** fielder's choice to end the outing...Alexander went on to receive the win after tossing a career-high 7.1 innings, allowing

- three runs on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts.

 It marked the second-longest individual perfect game bid in Rays history behind **Drew Rasmussen**, who sat down 24 BF on Aug. 14, 2022 vs. BAL before allowing a **Jorge Mateo** double on the first pitch of the 9th inning.
- of the 9th inning. The 22 consecutive batters retired tied **Matt Garza** for the second most at any point in a game in Rays history behind Rasmussen... Garza turned the trick during his no-hitter on July 26, 2010 vs. DET, the only no-no in Rays history. In addition to tossing a career-high 7.1 innings, Alexander fired a career-high 105 pitches, his most since Aug. 7, 2019 vs. Chicago-AL (102)...he became the first Rays pitcher to throw 7.0+ innings in back-to-back outings since **Zack Littell** (2GS) from Sept. 7-12, 2023.

ROYALTY—Alexander has made 11 career appearances (1GS) opposite Kansas City, going 2-2 with a 4.29 ERA (21.0IP, 10ER)...in his lone start on Sept. 11, 2022, he took the loss after allowing four runs on six hits and one walk over 5.0 innings.

In his first career appearance vs. Kansas City on Aug. 11, 2019, he was unable to recorded an out, allowing four runs on four hits.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Alexander has recorded a career-high 73.2 pct. first-pitch strike rate, up from 72.4 pct. last season...min. 150 BF, it signals the second-highest mark in the majors behind AZ **Brandon Pfaadt** (74.1%).

BOTTOMS UP—The 7-9 spots in the opposing order are a combined 20-for-60 (.333) with a .938 OPS against him...he has held 1-6 hitters to a .207 (25-for-122) average and .664 OPS.

Nine-hole hitters are 10-for-20 (.500) with 2 2B and 1 HR...min. 15 BF, the .500 AVG is the highest in MLB, with the next closest pitcher being WSH Patrick Corbin (.455/10-for-22).

In comparison, Alexander has limited opposing lead-off hitters to a .087 (2-for-22) clip with 7 SO.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—He allowed a career-high-tying 3 HR in his May 12 start vs. New York-AL (3x, last: Oct. 5, 2022 at SEA)...he has allowed 1+ HR in three straight outings after going three straight appearances (2GS)

- without conceding a long ball.

 In the start on May 12, he became the first Tampa Bay pitcher to work 7.0+ innings while allowing 3+ HR since Chris Archer on May 12, 2018 (G1) at Baltimore (7.0IP, 7H, 6ER, 3BB, 3HR, 4SO).

 In his last 17 GS since Aug. 14, 2022, Alexander has yielded 21 home
 - runs (2.18 HR/9.0IP), allowing a homer in 13 of the 17 outings

SWINGMAN—Of his 129 career appearances, 49 (38.0%) have come as a starter while 80 were in relief...his 41 relief appearances of 2.0+ IP since 2020 are tied for sixth most in the majors—he has gone 7-3 with a 3.51 ERA (110.1IP, 43ER) in those outings.

In his six starts this season, Alexander has produced a 5.06 ERA (32.0IP, 18ER)...in three outings working behind an opener, he has recorded a 5.40 ERA (15.0IP, 9ER).
