**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The O's fell to the Astros, 8-1, in the finale of the three-game set at Minute Maid Park...Were swept for the second time this year, joining a three-game set in St. Louis from May 20-22...Were swept by the Astros for the first time since a three-game series at Oriole Park from June 21-23, 2021, and for the first time in Houston since a three-game set from April 2-4, 2018...Dropped their second series to an AL opponent this season, joining April 26-28 vs. Oakland (1-2)...Have scored just one run in each of the last two games, the first time they have been held to one or zero runs in consecutive games since June 30 to July 1, 2023.

**ALL-STAR VOTING:** MLB today announced the second balloting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game...The 2024 MLB All-Star Ballot, which is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at [MLB.com/vote](http://MLB.com/vote), all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App, and the MLB Ballpark App, will be accessible until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 12 p.m. ET on Thursday, June 27...The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6 p.m. on Thursday, and will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who starts for each league...As of the second update, an MLB-high-tying six Orioles are on pace to advance to Phase 2 (see box at right), while three are leading their positions; the Orioles have not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014.

- Ⓞ **Adley Rutschman** leads AL catchers and ranks third in the AL with 1,638,425 votes; seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment; would become the third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; **Matt Wieters** was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).
- Ⓞ **Gunnar Henderson** leads AL shortstops with 1,551,124 votes; vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Manny Machado** in 2018.
- Ⓞ **Ryan Mountcastle** leads AL first basemen with 1,400,373 votes, having overtaken Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (1,338,688) since the first update; seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Chris Davis** in 2013.
- Ⓞ **Jordan Westburg** ranks second among AL third basemen with 846,352 votes, trailing Cleveland's Jose Ramirez (1,426,755); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.
- Ⓞ **Anthony Santander** and **Colton Cowser** are each seeking their first All-Star selections; Santander ranks fifth among AL outfielders with 808,100 votes, while Cowser ranks sixth with 649,710 votes.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Orioles have lost three games in a row for just the second time this year, joining May 20-22; following that skid, they won five in a row, eight of nine, 10 of 12, 16 of 20, 18 of 24, and 20 of 27...The O's have not lost four in a row since September 12-15, 2023...At 49-28 (.636), the Birds own the fourth-best record in MLB, behind the Yankees (.650, 52-28), Guardians (.653, 49-26), and Phillies (.662, 51-26)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 150-89 (.628), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors...The O's are 233-168 (.581) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.582, 234-168), Braves (.622, 248-151), and Dodgers (.643, 259-144).

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 125 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (115) and Dodgers (108)...Have homered in 22 consecutive games, the longest streak in MLB this season and the longest such streak in team history, ahead of a 20-gamer from July 17 to August 9, 1998; the MLB record is 31 straight games with a home run by the 2019 Yankees, and the last team with a home run streak of at least 22 games was the Braves with a 28-game streak from June 10 to July 15, 2023.

- Ⓞ The Orioles are 42-19 this year when homering, 33-5 when hitting multiple home runs, 17-4 when hitting at least three, and 4-1 when hitting four.
- Ⓞ Baltimore has five players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Angels, Dodgers, and Padres for the most in MLB this season: **Gunnar Henderson** (24), **Anthony Santander** (20), **Adley Rutschman** (14), **Jordan Westburg** (13), and **Ryan Mountcastle** (11).
- Ⓞ Henderson and Santander are the only teammates in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season.
- Ⓞ The O's lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** ranks second in MLB with 24 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (28)...He ranks among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

- Ⓞ He owns a career-best 30-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an O's batter since **Nick Markakis'** 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009, and the longest by a batter under 23 years old in Orioles history.
- Ⓞ Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an O's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

**SUMMER SLUGGER:** **Anthony Santander** leads MLB with 11 home runs this month...He is the first O's batter with double-digit home runs in a single calendar month since he did so in September 2022 (10)...He is the first Oriole to hit 11+ homers in a single month since **Manny Machado** hit 12 in August 2017...The club record for home runs in a month is 15 by **Jim Gentile** in August 1961...The club record for home runs in June is 12 by **Boog Powell** (1964), **Rafael Palmeiro** (1998), **Albert Belle** (2000), and **Chris Davis** (2013).

- Ⓞ Santander's 81 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (127).

**MONTHLY DUES:** The Orioles need two wins in their next seven games to clinch a winning record in June...With a 17-9 record in May, the O's have been above .500 in eight consecutive full months since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the team (min. 10 games played in the month) since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors; Atlanta had its streak of 11 straight winning months since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles begin a seven-game homestand tonight with the first of three games against the Guardians...The O's will then host the Rangers from Thursday through Sunday for a rematch of the 2023 ALDS, including ESPN's *Sunday Night Baseball* on June 30...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it will be Baltimore's 35th appearance on *Sunday Night Baseball*, in which they are 15-19.

**AGAINST CLEVELAND:** The Orioles and Guardians begin a seven-game season series with the first of three games in Baltimore tonight...The O's will travel to Cleveland for four games from August 1-4...Baltimore went 3-4 against Cleveland last year, dropping two out of three at Oriole Park from May 29-31 and splitting a four-game set at Progressive Field from September 21-24.

**WRAPPING UP THE ROAD TRIP:** The Orioles went 2-4 on the most recent six-game road against the Yankees (2-1) and Astros (0-3)...Marked their first losing road trip since going 2-3 from June 16-21, 2023 at Chicago-NL (1-2) and Tampa Bay (1-1).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles today recalled outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** from Triple-A Norfolk and designated infielder/outfielder **Nick Maton** for assignment...The Orioles' 40-man roster currently has 39 players.

**QUICK HITS:** Povich is scheduled to make his fourth career start tonight against the Guardians...He became the first Oriole pitcher to make his Major League debut this season and fourth Oriole overall, joining INF Jackson Holliday, C David Bañuelos, and INF/OF Connor Norby...He became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL; is the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, joining Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...He became the 11<sup>th</sup> Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1 IP)...At 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23y-249d) on August 28, 2011 (G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...He was acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nunez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...A Nevada native, Povich was originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision on June 19 at New York-AL...Tossed 4.2 innings, allowing one run on one hit and five walks with one strikeout; the one hit was a leadoff single in the first inning...Retired nine consecutive batters before issuing a two-out walk to Juan Soto in the fifth inning, the last hitter he faced before being removed from the game...Threw 94 pitches, 55 strikes.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** In his only career start at Oriole Park, he tossed 6.0 shutout innings against the Braves on June 12; allowed five hits and one hit batter with six strikeouts.

**NIGHT OWL:** Owns a 0-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (1 ER/10.2) across both of his night starts this season compared to a 0-1 record with a 10.13 ERA (6 ER/5.1 IP) in his lone day start.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Lefty hitters are slashing .231/.444/.308 (3-for-13) off Povich in his three starts compared to the .178/.255/.244 (8-for-45) against righties.

**HIGH TIDE:** Has gone 5-1 with a 3.18 ERA (20 ER/56.2 IP), a 1.11 WHIP, and 75 strikeouts against 21 walks in 11 starts for the Tides this year...At the time of his promotion, he ranked among International League leaders in strikeouts (2<sup>nd</sup>), opponent average (3<sup>rd</sup>, .203), ERA (4<sup>th</sup>), WHIP (4<sup>th</sup>, 1.11), and wins (T-4<sup>th</sup>); only trailed teammate RHP Chayce McDermott (82) in strikeouts...His 75 strikeouts were tied for fifth among all minor league pitchers.

**PROSPECTING:** Currently ranked as the No. 5 Orioles prospect and No. 99 overall by *Baseball America*...He is ranked as the club's No. 1 pitching prospect...At 24 years, 73 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and second-youngest player overall behind Gunnar Henderson at 22 years, 361 days.

**APRIL SHOWERS:** Named the International League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and a league-best 40 strikeouts in five starts...Also named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month after leading O's minor leaguers (min. 20 IP) in ERA, WHIP, and strikeouts...Named International League Pitcher of the Week for April 1-7 after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), three hits, three walks, and 14 strikeouts in two starts at Charlotte during the week.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Spent the season between Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk...Combined to go 8-10 with a 5.04 ERA (71 ER/126.2 IP) and 106 hits (18 HR), 76 total runs, 66 walks, five hit batters, and 171 strikeouts in 28 games, all starts...Named an *MiLB.com* Organization All-Star...Finished third among all minor leaguers in strikeouts; his 12.15 K/9 ranked third among full-season minor leaguers...Selected as Eastern League Pitcher of the Week three times (5/1, 5/15, & 6/19)...Fanned 10 on April 29 (G1) vs. Richmond and May 11 at Harrisburg...Struck out a career-high 13 batters on June 15 vs. Richmond; struck out the first six batters of the game and retired the first 18 hitters of the game; pitched 7.0 innings for the first time and surrendered just one hit...Completed at least 6.0 innings in five starts.
