EVERYBODY CAN CHANGE: The Giants look to get back in the win column with a victory in tonight's series opener vs. the Phillies.

- ▶ SF has dropped each of its last three games after winning the homestand opener vs. the Mets last Thursday...during this three-game losing streak SF has been outscored 24-5.
- ▶ This 3-7 start through the team's first 10 games is tied for the Giants' second-worst start in the SF era (since 1958), besting only the 2-8 mark from 1983...the Giants have started 3-8 only six times in the SF era (2019, 2015, 2009, 2000, 1985 and 1983).
- ▶ The 1-6 record at home thus far is also tied for the second worst start by the Giants since 1958, last doing so in 2015, and trailing only their 0-7 start in 1990...the Giants have started 1-7 (or worse) only four times in the SF-era: 2000 (1-7), 1990 (0-8), 1977 (1-7) and 1972 (1-7).

HE'S NOT A MACHINE! HE'S A MAN! SF welcomes in the Philadelphia Phillies for the first of a three-game series tonight...the Giants have not lost a home series to the Phillies since 2013 and have won seven consecutive home series over the Phillies dating to 2018 (excludes 2020 when the two teams did not play).

- ▶ The seven-series home winning streak vs. the Phillies is tied for the Giants' longest active streak vs. any team (with Colorado)...the streak is also the Giants' longest home series-winning streak vs. Philadelphia since taking 10 straight from 1926-1928 (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ SF is 12-3 against the Phillies at home dating to the beginning of 2021 with a +16 run differential (79-63)...last season, SF went 2-1 against the Phillies here in early July.
- ▶ Since 2019, SF has a winning record in five of its last six seasons with games played against the Phillies, which is the most winning seasons by any team vs. the Phillies over that span (*Stats, LLC*).

NO, ADRIAN, I DO AND I GOTTA LEAVE THIS PLACE TOO: Giants **RHP Adrian Houser** will make his home Giants debut tonight...he received the loss despite a solid start in his Giants debut last Wednesday...he struck out four while allowing three runs (one earned) on six hits and a walk over 5.1 frames at San Diego on April 1.

- ▶ Houser allowed just one hit in seven at-bats with RISP last week at San Diego...since the start of the 2025 season, opponents are hitting just .209 vs. him with RISP (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ The righty is 1-2 in eight games (three starts) vs. the Phillies over his career, posting a 3.90 ERA (12er, 27.2ip), 15 strikeouts and a 1.08 WHIP.
- ▶ Houser was a stopper last season, especially with the White Sox...overall, he went 5-5 with a 3.30 ERA (33er, 90.0ip) in 15 starts following his team losing the previous game...with the White Sox, he went 4-2 with a 1.57 ERA (9er, 51.2ip) in eight such games.

HIT THE ONE IN THE MIDDLE: The Giants have totaled just 26 runs through their first 10 games, which is their fewest through 10 games to start a season since 2019 (25)...in addition to 2026 and 2019, the Giants have been held to 26 or fewer runs through their first 10 games just three other times in the SF era (2015, 2008 and 1985).

- ▶ SF's offense has been a bit all or nothing through the first 10 games...in three wins, the Giants have scored 19 runs on 35 hits, while in seven losses they have scored seven total runs on 32 hits, averaging 1.0 runs per game and 4.6 hits per game.
- ▶ Of the 11 Giants that have a plate appearance this year, five are batting above .215 with four batting under .200.
- ▶ To the right is a chart of where SF ranks in numerous offensive categories.

I MUST BREAK YOU: Phillies starter Andrew Painter threw his four-seam fastball 34 times (33 to lefties) in his debut on March 31...that accounted for 40.5% of his pitches thrown.

- ▶ The Giants have a .453 OPS vs. four-seamers this season, which is lowest in MLB by nearly .100 points (next closest is Cincinnati with a .542 OPS).
- ▶ Since the start of last season, SF's .734 OPS vs. four-seam fastballs is 24th in MLB.
- ▶ Painter's second and third most-used pitches in his debut were his slider (21.4% usage rate) and curveball (20.2% usage rate)...the Giants have a .710 OPS vs. breaking balls this season, which is fifth-best in the Majors.

YO ADRIAN: Enters his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Received the loss despite an overall strong start vs. the Padres on April 1...allowed three runs (one earned) as two errors came back to bite the Giants...struck out four across 5.1 innings with one walk and six hits surrendered.

AGAINST THE PHILLIES: Will be facing the Phillies for the first time since June of 2024...has a 1-2 record with a 3.90 ERA (12er, 27.2ip), 15 strikeouts and a 1.08 WHIP in eight games (three starts)...Phillies IF Alec Bohm is just 1-for-11 (.091) vs. Houser in his career.

CACTUS LEAGUE: Went 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP over three Cactus League starts...also made and exhibition start vs. Team USA.

2025 RECAP: Had a well-traveled 2025...he originally pitched in Spring Training with Texas on an MiLB deal...after not making the Rangers out of camp, he pitched nine games (eight starts) with Triple-A Round Rock before opting out of his contract to sign an MLB deal with Chicago-AL...he promptly went 6-2 with a 2.10 ERA (16er, 68.2ip) with the White Sox before being traded to the Rays at the deadline...he went 2-3 with a 4.79 ERA (30er, 56.1ip) in 10 starts to end the season with Tampa Bay.

SINK OR SWIM: Houser's sinker had a run value of +6 last season per *Baseball Savant*, which is the pitch's best mark since it had a +23 run value in 2021...since the start of last season, the Phillies' .789 OPS vs. sinkers is ninth-best in MLB.

THE SENIOR CIRCUIT: Had a 2.19 ERA (13er, 53.1ip) in nine starts against National League opponents last season while owning a 4.14 ERA (33er, 71.2ip) in 12 starts against American League foes.

DAY MAN: In 2025, Houser had a 2.36 ERA (13er, 49.2ip) in eight day game starts compared to a 3.94 ERA (33er, 75.1ip) in 13 night games...over his career, the vet has been nearly a half run better in day games than night games...he is 15-13 with a 3.73 ERA (113er, 272.1ip), 206 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in 68 career day games (45 starts)...in 106 night games (81 starts), he is 25-32 with a 4.22 ERA (219er, 466.2ip), 374 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP.

CRACK OF THE BAT: Houser had a 47.6% hard hit rate last season, which ranked in the bottom 5% of MLB...vs. his sinker, opponents had a 53.0% rate of balls hit 95+ mph.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers slashed .274/.356/.456 (.812 OPS) vs. Houser in 2025, while righties slashed .249/.293/.320 (.612 OPS).

CHANGIN' THE PACE: Houser's changeup had an opposing batting average of .234, but an xBA of .276...he posted a 35.1% whiff rate with his changeup.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 4/4 vs. NYM; 1.1ip, 3h, r, er, k, hr (22 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 0-for-6 against him early in 2026 while righties are 4-for-8 with two homers...has held lefties to a .179 clip (67-for-375) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 4/5 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, h, bb (19 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in five of SF's first 10 games.
- ▶ His homer allowed to NYM's Francisco Álvarez Friday night was the first he'd allowed since October 4, 2022 (also vs. the Mets), a span of 35.2 innings at the MLB level in that time.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-16 (.375) with three XBHs off him.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 1.2ip, 2h, bb, 2k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in four of SF's first 10 games, tossing 4.2-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 38.1 innings dating to June 11, 2023, the 12th-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/4 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Appeared in four games for SF (all lopsided losses) but has thrown 4.0 total innings with no hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 4/5 vs. NYM; 0.2ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed four runs and a .556 average (5-for-9) over his last two outings (1.1ip).
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 47.2 innings dating to August 14, 2024, tied for the sixth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.
- ▶ Miller was originally drafted by the Phillies in the fourth round in 2019 out of Stanford University...he joined SF from Philadelphia on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 4/2 vs. NYM; SV, 3.0ip, 2h, 2k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled Thursday with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL... logged his first career save in his Giants debut Thursday night pitching against the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.
- ▶ Went 6-4 with a 3.62 ERA (39er, 97.0ip) with 111 strikeouts over 21 games between Triple-A Sacramento and Triple-A Syracuse.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/2 vs. NYM; 0.2ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in four of SF's first 10 games
- ▶ In six career outings vs. the Phillies, Walker has thrown 5.1 shutout innings with one hit, a walk & seven strikeouts...has a 1-0-1 record and .063 BAA in those outings, with SF winning four of the six games.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Enjoyed his best stretch of the 2025 season from July 4-September 3 where he posted a 1.64 ERA (4er, 22.0ip) in 23 games.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 4/5 vs. NYM; 0.1ip, 2h, 2r, 2er (8 pitches)

- ▶ Suffered the loss yesterday as he allowed two runs in 0.1 innings... after not allowing a hit over his first three outings, opponents are 4-for-their-last-8 off him.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Has two hits in 25 at-bats (.080) in seven home games this year and is hitting .184 (7x38) with a homer and three RBI early this season.
- ▶ Is 2-for-23 (.087) with seven strikeouts off fastballs this season...is a combined 5-for-15 (.333) with a HR vs. breaking balls & offspeed.
- ▶ Hit .256 with 22 homers vs. fastballs last year...his +15 run value vs. four-seamers last season was sixth-best in the NL.
- ▶ Last season, he became the first Giants player to reach 30 home runs in a season since **Barry Bonds** had 45 home runs in 2004...he became the first Giants infielder and right-handed hitter to reach 30 homers in a season since **Jeff Kent** (37 homers in 2002).
- ▶ Led SF with 30 homers and 12 steals, becoming the first SS to lead the Giants in both categories in a season since **George Davis** in 1897.
- ▶ His 143 home runs as a shortstop since 2021 are most in the Majors ahead of NYM's Francisco Lindor (139).

#1 LUIS ARRAEZ ▶ IF

- ▶ Hit safely in seven of his first 10 games this season (.275 AVG).
- ▶ Has six hits in 15 at-bats (.400) vs. lefties early in the season...is 5-for-25 (.200) vs. right-handers.
- ▶ Signed a one-year contract with SF this past offseason.
- ▶ Won the WBC with Venezuela...hit .308 (8x26) with six runs, four doubles, two homers and 10 RBI in seven games and was named to the All WBC Tournament team at first base.
- ▶ Had career best in games (154) and steals (11) in 2025 with SD.
- ▶ Led the NL in hits (181) for a second consecutive year.

#9 HARRISON BADER ▶ OF
