METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets earned a 3-2 win over the Twins last night, snapping a 12-game losing streak...The Mets are seeking their third series win of the season and their second at home...The Mets are in the midst of a 10-day, nine-game homestand (1-1) against the Twins (1-1), Rockies (three games) and Nationals (three games).

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game the Mets made the following roster moves - RHP Christian Scott has been re-called from Triple-A Syracuse...RHP Austin Warren was optioned to Triple-A Syracuse following last night's game...INF Francisco Lindor has been placed on 10-Day IL with a left calf strain...INF Ronny Mauricio has been re-called from Triple-A Syracuse.

GREAT SCOTT! Christian Scott is set to make his return to the Major Leagues tonight...It will be his first appearance since July 21, 2024...The right-handed pitcher has made three starts at Triple-A Syracuse...After he allowed seven runs (six earned) in his first start, he made two additional starts allowing two earned runs on four hits, two walks, 12 strikeouts over 10.1 innings of work...In 2024, Scott underwent right elbow UCL reconstruction surgery with an internal brace...He was named the New York Mets 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after making 19 starts across three levels that season and posting a 5-4 record with a 2.57 ERA (25 ER/87.2 IP) with 12 walks and 107 strikeouts.

JUAN OF A KIND: Juan Soto has safely hit in all nine of his games this season...He is batting .353 (12-34) with three runs, two doubles, one homers, five RBI, four walks, a .421 OBP, a .500 SLG and a .921 OPS.

FIRST RESPONDERS NIGHT PRESENTED BY FORD: The New York Mets will celebrate the incredible work of First Responders on April 23...From 5:00 - 7:00 p.m., emergency and service vehicles will be at Citi Field outside of the Seaver VIP entrance, giving fans of all ages a chance to explore fire trucks, police vehicles, ambulances and more, plus meet the brave first responders who serve our community every day...Members of FDNY, NYPD, EMS, State Troopers and Port Authority will throw out the ceremonial first pitch on First Responders Night.

RETURN OF THE MARCUS: Over the last eight games, Marcus Semien is batting .308 (8-26) with two runs, two doubles, two RBI, three walks, two steals and a .764 OPS.

GOT TO GO TO MOES: Ronny Mauricio is in his second stint with the Major League team this year...Since returning to Triple-A, Mauricio is 8-25 with eight runs, one double, five homers, 10 RBI, three walks and two steals.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: The Mets are 1-4 against the AL in 2026...New York went 24-24 against the American League in 2025...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the Mets are 303-304 against the American League.

TWINS-METS NOTES: The Twins are visiting Queens for the first time since July 29-31, 2024...The Mets own an 9-4 record against the Twins at Citi Field.

HOME, SWEET HOME: The Mets are in the midst of their third homestand of the season...The team is 4-7 in New York this year...The team has posted a 4.37 ERA (50 ER/103.0 IP) at Citi Field in 2026...They are hitting .216/.288/.315 at Citi Field.

BATTING FIRST: Bo Bichette hit leadoff for the first time last night...In his career, he is batting .279/.323/.454 with 91 runs, 45 doubles, one triple, 25 home runs, 82 RBI and 42 walks when batting leadoff...He has never hit a leadoff home run in his career.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Elian Peña has appeared in 16 games with the St. Lucie Mets...In his first season stateside, Peña is batting .323 (20-62) with nine runs, five doubles, one home runs, nine RBI, six steals, 13 walks, a .442 OBP, a .452 SLG and an .893 OPS.

THE HUASCAR GOES TO: Huascar Brazobán has not allowed an earned run in 11 multi-inning appearances since 2025...He has yet to allow a run over 10.2 innings this season, tied for the third-most innings without allowing a run in the Majors by a relief pitcher.

RANK IT: The Mets are 30th in the league with a .288 OBP and 26th in the league in walks with 72...The team is 26th in the Majors with a .224 average and 29th with a .334 SLG...The Mets have hit 17 home runs this year, which is tied for 27th in the Majors.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the club will wear a memorial "Davey" patch on the sleeve of their home and road uniforms during the 2026 season...Johnson passed away on September 5, 2025 at the age of 82...He finished his Mets career with the most managerial wins in franchise history (595) and the best winning percentage (.588)...In 1986, Johnson guided the team to a franchise-record 108 regular season victories and capped the year off with a dramatic World Championship...From 1984-1990, under his helm, the Mets averaged more than 95 wins.

THIS DAY IN 1986: The Mets were off today on this day in 1986... This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions New York Mets...The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 World Champion Mets on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information regarding programming for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration will be available at a later date at Mets.com/1986.

START ME UP: Today Scott will make his first Major League start of 2026...He has made nine starts with the Mets in 2024 and he has posted a 4.56 ERA (24.0 ER/47.1 IP) while recording 39strikeouts.

2024 SEASON RECAP: Scott finished his rookie season going 0-3 with a 4.56 ERA (24 ER/47.1 IP), adding 39 strikeouts and 12 walks before being placed on the IL with a sprained UCL in his right elbow...Made his MLB debut on May 4 in Tampa Bay, throwing 6.2 innings and allowing just one run, adding six strikeouts and one walk...Recorded a career-high eight strikeouts on May 11 against Atlanta, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing just three runs.

SINCE YOU'VE BEEN BACK: Has made three starts since he has been recalled from Triple-A Syracuse in 2024...Has posted a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/5.2 IP) in that span with four home runs, four walks and 10 strikeouts.

DOWN AT THE FARM: Since he returned to Triple-A, Scott made four starts with the Syracuse Mets, posting a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) with six walks and 19 strikeouts...All together in nine starts at Triple-A, Scott is 3-0 with a 2.76 ERA (13 ER/42.1 IP) with 12 walks and 55 strikeouts.

WHAT A DEBUT: Scott made his major league debut on May 4 in Tampa Bay...He recorded a no decision in the Mets 3-1 loss, throwing 6.2 innings and allowing just one run on five hits with one walk and six strikeouts...He became the third Mets player to make his major league debut this year...Scott is the first Mets pitcher to toss at least 6.0 innings in their debut since Steven Matz did so on June 28, 2015 vs. Cincinnati.

SIZZLING IN SYRACUSE: At the time of his first call up, was 3-0 with a 3.20 ERA (9 ER/25.1 IP) at Syracuse...Has made five starts, allowing six walks and striking out 36...Led the International League in WHIP (0.71) and batting average against (.136), while placing fourth in strikeouts (36) and ninth in ERA (3.20). **23 AND ME:** Named the New York Mets 2023 Pitcher of the Year after making 19 starts this across three levels season and posting a 5-4 record with a 2.57 ERA (25 ER/87.2 IP) with 12 walks and 107 strikeouts.

HE'S GOT PROSPECTS: Entered the 2024 season as the 99th best prospect in the minors by ESPN.

SLIDE TO THE RIGHT: While seeking a third pitch, looked at Pitching Ninja video and discovered the slider grip used by Max Scherzer...It's still the grip he uses today... Was predominately a reliever throughout his career at the University of Florida and transitioned to a starting role after he was selected by the Mets.

MINOR LEAGUE BACKGROUND: In 2023, held opposing hitters to a .199 batting average and posted 10.98 strikeouts per nine innings...Started for the Rumble Ponies in Game One of the Northeast Division Series...In 2022, he split his time between A St. Lucie and A+ Brooklyn with a combined 4.45 ERA in 18 appearances...In 2021, he had three relief outings for FCL Mets and threw 12 strikes out of 16 total pitches.

- Threw 1.1 scoreless innings in relief on April 21 vs. Minnesota (1.1 IP, 2 K)...Since the start of last year, he has recorded four or more outs without allowing an earned run in 18 relief appearances, which is tied for the sixth-most appearances among NL relievers.
- He hasn't allowed an earned run over 10.2 innings this year...He is one of four pitchers in the majors to throw as many innings without allowing an earned run.
- Didn't allow any runs while recording the last two outs of the fourth inning on April 17 at Chicago-NL (0.2 IP, 2 H, K).
- Since joining the Mets in 2024, he has made 38 appearances (two starts) at Citi Field...In those contests, he is 3-1 with eight holds, a 2.98 ERA (15 ER/45.1 IP) and 39 strikeouts.
- Over four career appearances (one start) against Minnesota, he has thrown 5.1 scoreless innings and hasn't surrendered a hit over 11 at-bats.
- Fired 2.2 scoreless innings in relief on April 11 vs. the Athletics (2.2 IP, 2 H, 3 K)...Marked his ninth scoreless relief appearance of at least 2.0 innings since the beginning of last season...Is tied for the seventh-most such games among NL relievers during that span.
- Dating back to September 20, 2025, he hasn't allowed an earned run in each of his last 13 appearances (15.2 IP).
- Made his third career Opening Day roster and his second consecutive with the Mets.
- Pitched in three games for the Dominican Republic in the World Baseball Classic...He tossed 4.0 scoreless innings and struck out seven of the 13 batters he faced.
- Appeared in three Grapefruit League games and he threw 3.0 scoreless innings...He struck out five of the 11 batters he faced during the spring.
- Last season, he made a career-high 52 appearances and finished with a 5-2 record, two saves, 12 holds, 57 strikeouts, and a 3.57 ERA (25 ER/63.0 IP).
- In 2025, he allowed just five earned runs over 25 combined appearances in March, April, and May (1.34 ERA)...His ERA through his first 25 games of the season is the 11th-best in franchise history.

- Suffered his first loss of the season when he allowed the free runner to score on April 19 at Chicago-NL (0.2 IP, R, K).
- Has made 22 career appearances at Citi Field and he is 1-0 and 15-for-15 on save opportunities...Has posted a 1.25 ERA (3 ER/21.2 IP) with 27 strikeouts over those appearances.
- Over 11 career appearances against Minnesota, he is 2-0 with four saves, one hold, a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts...Over 133 career Interleague matchups he has 56 saves, a 3.54 ERA (50 ER/127.0 IP) and 186 strikeouts...His 56 saves in Interleague play are tied for the third-most in Major League history.
- Tossed a scoreless eighth inning at Chicago-NL on April 18 (1.0 IP, H, BB)...Hasn't allowed an earned run in each of his first four appearances for the Mets.
- Struck out two over a scoreless inning in his Mets and 2026 debut on April 11 vs. the Athletics (1.0 IP, H, 2 K)...Has now made an appearance for 10 Major League clubs.
- Signed with the Mets as a minor league free agent with an invite to Spring Training...Over six Grapefruit League appearances, he finished with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER/6.0 IP) and five strikeouts.
- Made an appearance for Single-A St. Lucie on April 7 and he completed a scoreless inning while recording one strikeout.
- Over 17 Major League seasons, he owns a career 56-49 record with a 2.57 ERA (236 ER/825.1 IP), 1285 strikeouts, and 440 saves...Among relievers all-time, he is tied for fourth in strikeouts and fifth in saves...Among active relievers, he ranks second in strikeouts behind only Aroldis Chapman (1338) and second in saves behind Kenley Jansen (481).
- Last season, he appeared in 14 games between Atlanta (one game) and Houston...He went 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) with two holds and 17 strikeouts.
- He is a nine-time All-Star, which is the second-most selections all-time among relief pitchers, only trailing Mariano Rivera's 13 selections
- He was the National League Rookie of the Year in 2011 while with the Atlanta Braves...He was also named the Trevor Hoffman NL Reliever of the Year in 2014 with Atlanta and the Mariano Rivera AL Reliever of the Year with Boston in 2017.

- Allowed five earned runs over 4.0 innings in relief on April 17 at Chicago-NL (4.0 IP, 6 H, 5 ER, 2 K, BB)...Has thrown 16.0 innings in relief this season, which is the fifth-most among NL relievers.
- Since joining the Mets in 2024 he is 8-3 with a 3.58 ERA (52 ER/130.2 IP) and 145 strikeouts over 25 games (21 starts) at Citi Field.
- Over seven career appearances (six starts) against Minnesota he is 6-1 with a 2.04 ERA (9 ER/39.2 IP) and 47 strikeouts...He is holding Twins batters to a .218 (32-147) batting average.
- Fired 3.0 scoreless innings in relief and recorded a season-high four strikeouts on April 12 vs. the Athletics (3.0 IP, 4 K)...Was his fifth career relief appearance of at least 3.0 scoreless innings.
- He and Chase Dollander (5x, Colorado) are the only two relievers who have thrown 3.0 or more innings in at least four relief appearances this season.
- Went 0-2 with a 3.72 ERA (4 ER/9.2 IP) with two walks and nine strikeouts in three starts during Spring Training.
- In 38 career games in relief, Manaea is 5-4 with a 4.06 ERA (48 ER/106.1 IP) with 33 walks and 115 strikeouts.
- In 2025, finished the season going 2-4 with a 5.64 ERA (38 ER/60.2 IP), 12 walks and 75 strikeouts in 15 appearances (12 starts).
- Last season was originally placed on the 15-Day IL on March 27 (retro. March 24) with a right oblique strain and then was transferred to the 60-Day IL on April 29.
