THE TWINS: After taking two of three in Toronto over the weekend, the Twins returned home and dropped game one of their three-game series/homestand with the Yankees last night... tonight, they will play the second of three with New York and conclude the series tomorrow afternoon... after tomorrow's game, they will travel to Cleveland to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Guardians (May 17-19) and three against the Nationals (May 20-22).
 ☞ Twins have won 17 of their last 21 games... since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (17-4), ahead of the Dodgers (16-4) and Phillies (16-5).
 ☞ Twins are 9-3 in their last 12 at home after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight here.
 ☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing consecutive games for the first time since dropping five-straight from April 14-19.

YANKEES TAKE OPENER OVER TWINS: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 5-1... Chris Paddack was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on a career-high-tying 12 hits (also, April 16 at BAL), with two walks and four strikeouts... the offense recorded seven hits, struck out eight times, drew zero walks and went 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position... Ryan Jeffers hit his 10th home run of the season and first leadoff homer of his career, proving to be the only run for the Twins on the evening.

I WANT TO SPEAK TO YOUR MANAGER: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins... since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (442-309) and Aaron Boone (437-314)... 14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Kevin Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Aaron Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez)... below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins went 4-3 against the Yankees last season, going 2-2 in New York from April 13-16 and 2-1 at Target Field from April 24-26... Minnesota will travel to the Bronx for three games from June 4-6.

☞ Minnesota is 5-4 in their last nine vs. the Yankees... in that span, Twins pitchers have posted a 3.65 ERA (79.0 IP, 32 ER) with a 10.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .292 (50-for-171) with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 34 RBI, a .585 slugging percentage and a .943 OPS in 45 career regular season games vs. New York... Correa's .585 slugging percentage against NY is the second-best among actives (minimum of 175 plate appearances), trailing only José Ramírez (.591)... his .943 OPS ranks fourth, trailing Ramírez (.992), Mike Trout (.979) and Francisco Lindor (.945).
 ☞ Notables lifetime vs. Marcus Stroman: Carlos Correa is 5-for-10 (.500) with a double and a walk... Christian Vázquez is 8-for-22 (.364) with two doubles and a walk... Trevor Larnach, Kyle Farmer and Manny Margot each have one home run.

BUCK UPDATE: Byron Buxton is scheduled to play on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul tonight and tomorrow vs. Omaha at CHS Field (both games at 6:37 pm CT)... Buck has missed the club's last 11 games with right knee inflammation.

YES JEFF: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .328 (22-for-67) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, five walks, a .397 on-base percentage, a .761 slugging percentage and a 1.159 OPS in his last 19 games, since April 22.

☞ Among all MLB qualifiers on the season, Jeffers ranks fifth in OPS (.997), trailing Shohei Ohtani (1.108), Marcell Ozuna (1.038), Mookie Betts (1.004) and Kyle Tucker (.997)... additionally, he ranks third in baseball in slugging percentage (.629), fifth in RC/27 (9.18) and fifth in OPS+ (183.9).

☞ Since June 20, 2023, Ryan Jeffers has hit .299 (92-for-308) with a .955 OPS in 90 games.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Twins are looking to avoid dropping their first series since April 19-21 vs. Detroit (1-2), which would snap a streak of six consecutive series victories... 2024 series results to the right.

☞ Six consecutive series wins marks the first time since August 27-September 16, 2010, when they won series at Seattle, vs. Detroit, vs. Texas, vs. Kansas City, at Cleveland and at Chicago-AL.

MAX PRODUCTION: Max Kepler struck out in his only at-bat last night, entering the game a pinch-hitter in the seventh inning, snapping his 14-game hitting streak.

☞ Since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .406 (26-for-64) with nine doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 17 RBI, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.146 OPS in 20 games... Twins 16-4 in his games.

☞ Since June 30, 2023, Kepler is hitting .306 (107-for-350) with 26 doubles, two triples, 17 home runs, 60 RBI and a .910 OPS in 100 games... Twins are 63-37 in those 100 games.

BIRTHDAY PARTIES FROM NEW WESTMINSTER TO TUPELO: Twins HOFer and Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau is celebrating his 43rd birthday today... he shares a birthday with former Twin Brian Dozier, who is celebrating his 37th today.

- ☞ Twins hitters have 104 extra-base hits out of 236 total hits (44%) against RHP this season — best in MLB; league avg: 34%.
- ☞ Twins hitters have drawn 568 walks in 5,886 PA's (10%) against RHP since last season — best in AL; League Avg: 8%.
- ☞ Twins have answered-back in 32% of innings after an opponent scores in late innings since last season — fifth highest in MLB; League Avg: 28%.

STELLAR VS. SEATTLE: Last pitched May 9 vs. Seattle, opposite Logan Gilbert, and earned his third-straight win in Minnesota's 11-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits in 6.1 innings, with no walks and 10 strikeouts...only run came on Luke Raley's second-inning RBI single...recorded six-straight outs via strikeout from innings 2-4...pitched into the seventh inning for the second time this season (3/28 at KC)...was pulled after Raley's one-out single; Kody Funderburk entered and got an inning-ending double play.

- ☞ Induced 15 whiffs on 43 swings (34.9%)...now has a 31.3 percent whiff rate, ranking in MLB's 85th percentile.
- ☞ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph), each resulting in an out.
- ☞ Seventh career double-digit strikeout game, fifth with Minnesota (2023-present).

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 4 vs. Boston, earning his second-straight win and third of the season in Minnesota's 3-1 victory...allowed one run on five hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts...only run came in the first; Tyler O'Neill doubled with two outs, then Willyer Abreu ended a 10-pitch at-bat with an RBI single...allowed only three more baserunners after the first inning.

- ☞ Generated a season-high 19 whiffs on 47 swings (40.4%).
- ☞ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); each resulted in a groundout...induced season-high nine ground balls.

PABLO VS. THE YANKEES: Has made two career starts vs. New York-AL, going 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), two walks and 11 strikeouts...first faced Yankees on August 21, 2018, allowing one run in 6.0-inning no-decision...faced them again April 16, 2023, allowing two runs on seven hits in a 6.0-inning loss.

- ☞ Has allowed three home runs to Juan Soto, tied with Eloy Jiménez for the most of any hitter... has walked Soto eight times, the most of any hitter.
- ☞ New York-AL has posted a .777 OPS vs. right-handed pitching, the second highest in baseball behind Los Angeles-NL (.795).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making fifth home start of 2024...has gone 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (22.0 IP, 8 ER), 1.05 WHIP and 10.64 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings at home, compared to 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (22.0 IP, 11 ER), 0.91 WHIP and 11.86 K/9 in four road starts...has allowed a .232 batting average (19-for-82), .590 OPS and 0.41 home-runs-per-9.0-innings at home, compared to .198 (16-for-81), .680 OPS and 2.05 HR/9 on the road.

PABLO DAYS: The Twins, in partnership with Pablo and Kaylee López, announced a special 'Pablo Day' ticket package for each of Pablo's home starts at Target Field from May to September that includes an exclusive, Venezuela-inspired jersey and philanthropic contributions to three local nonprofits designated by the López family...for more info, visit twins.com/pabloday.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On May 9, Seattle's left-handed hitters went 3-for-13 with five strikeouts vs. López, while righties went 1-for-10 with a double and five strikeouts...through eight games vs. López this season, left-handed hitters have hit .233 (21-for-90) with a .633 OPS, 28.4 percent strikeout rate and 3.2 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .192 (14-for-73) with a .637 OPS, 35.4 percent strikeout rate and 3.8 percent home run rate.

- ☞ His 35.4 percent strikeout rate vs. righties ranks third (min. 500 total pitches) behind Zack Wheeler (37.6%) and Dylan Cease (35.8%).

- ☞ May 9 vs. Seattle, threw a season-high 15 curveballs...Mariners went 0-for-7 with five whiffs (on 9 swings) and five strikeouts against the pitch.
- ☞ Threw a season-high 19 sinkers vs. Seattle; previous high was 8, April 28 at Los Angeles-AL.
- ☞ 4-seamer has the fifth-lowest batting average against (.131), sixth-highest whiff rate (31.1%) and fourth-highest strikeout rate (34.3%) in baseball (min. 50 PA).

PABLO'S PUNCHOUTS: Ranks fifth among qualifying MLB pitchers this season with 11.25 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings...May 9 vs. Seattle was his fifth career start with 10-or-more strikeouts and no walks, all coming since 2022; only Zac Gallen (6) has made more such starts from 2022-24...has made 17 starts with eight-or-more strikeouts since the beginning of 2023, tying Luis Castillo for the second most in baseball (Spencer Strider, 25).

- ☞ Has made 40 starts with Minnesota; his 289 strikeouts are the most by a pitcher in his first 40 starts with the franchise (1901-present).

- ☞ Acquired from Miami on January 20 along with prospects José Salas and Byron Chourio.
- ☞ Threw 5.1 scoreless innings and won Opening Day start March 30 at Kansas City.
- ☞ Signed four-year extension April 21, keeping him under contract through 2027 season.
- ☞ Tossed first career complete-game shutout with 12 strikeouts vs. Kansas City on July 5.
- ☞ Selected to first All-Star team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with two strikeouts.
- ☞ Set another career-high with 14 strikeouts September 10 vs. New York-NL, throwing eight scoreless frames in a 2-0 loss.
- ☞ Ranked in 98th percentile in baseball in pitching run value (26), 95th percentile in chase percentage (34.3%), 93rd percentile in xERA (3.00).
- ☞ Earned first Cy Young Award votes of his career and finished seventh in AL voting.
- ☞ Won Game 1 of ALWCWS vs. Toronto on October 3 at Target Field, throwing 5.2 innings as Minnesota snapped an 18-game Postseason losing streak.

- Won both 2023 Postseason starts, allowing one run in 12.2 total innings and helping Twins snap 18-game Postseason losing streak with a G1 win in the ALWCWS vs. Toronto.
- In 2023, earned first All-Star selection and finished seventh in AL Cy Young Award voting after posting career highs in innings (194.0) and strikeouts (234).
- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as No. 2 starter for 3 Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
