PITTSBURGH PIRATES (36-60) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (61-35)

July 23, 2021 at Oracle Park, San Francisco, CA -- GAME #96/ROAD #50 RHP CHAD KUHL (3-5, 4.31 ERA) vs. RHP JOHNNY CUETO (6-5, 4.01 ERA)

THE PIRATES... had the day off yesterday...Have lost four games in a row after winning three straight and four-of-five...Have gone 7-7 in their last 14 games after losing six in a row...Have scored a season-high 11 runs twice; 7/5 vs. Atlanta and 6/18 vs. Cleveland...Have won a season-high

three straight games on four occasions.

BUCS BY THE BAY: Dating back to the 2011 season, the Pirates have gone 6-2-1 in their last nine series played at Oracle Park in San Francisco...The Bucs have gone 12-5 here since 2015 and 17-8 in their last 25 games, dating back to April 15, 2012.

A GIANT SERIES: The Pirates and Giants are meeting this weekend for the second time this season...The clubs split a fourgame series at PNC Park between May 13-16 with the Giants out-scoring the Bucs 15-13.

KUHL RUNNINGS: In his last five starts, dating back to June 18, **Chad Kuhl** has gone 3-1 with a 1.98 ERA (27.1ip/6er) and the team has won four of the five games...In his six starts at night this season, Kuhl has gone 3-1 with a 2.64 ERA while holding the opposing team to one run in each of his last four outings under the lights (23.0ip/4r/3er).

THE HITS KEEP COMING: The Bucs have collected at least 10 hits in each of their last seven games, something they haven't acomplished since the 2006 season (June 28-July 4)...The Pirates are the only team this season with 10 or more hits in seven consecutive games and the first to do so since the Yankees in 2019, according to the Elias Sports Bureau...The Bucs are hitting .319 (83-for-260) in their last seven games and their .302 batting average since the 4th of July is the second-highest in all of MLB behind Washington (.303)...The Pirates also rank second among all Major League teams with a .283 batting average during the month of July, trailing only the Nationals (.288).

STEADY AT SHORT: Kevin Newman leads all Major League shortstops with a .996 fielding percentage, having made just one error in 276 total chances...He began this season with 76 consecutive errorless games, a National League record to start a season and a club record for a shortstop at any point in a season.

STRATTON HIS STUFF: Originally selected by San Francisco in the first round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft (20th pick overall), **Chris Stratton** led all National League relief pitchers in innings pitched (30.0) last season...He enters tonight's action ranked third among all Major League relievers with 51.2ip...Dating back to May 1, Stratton has posted a 1.45 ERA (37.1ip/6er) and 34 strikeouts in his 28 appearances.

THE HIT MAN: All-Star second baseman **Adam Frazier** leads all Major League players with 122 hits and his .327 batting average ranks second in the National League behind Nick Castellanos (.329)...Frazier has gone 19-for-52 (.365) in his last 13 games is hitting .345 (87-for-252) in his last 65 games, dating back to May 8.

<u>THE PITTSBURGH STEALER:</u> Gregory Polanco has been successful in all 10 of his stolen base attempts this season...He leads the National League with the most attempts without being caught...The Pirates single season "record" for most stolen base attempts without being caught is held by **Miguel Dilone** (12 in 1977).

<u>CENTER OF ATTENTION:</u> All-Star outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** leads all National league center fielders with 16 home runs and he is tied with Cedric Mullins for second-most in the Majors behind Adolis Garcia (18)...Since becoming the everyday center fielder on April 22, Reynolds' 85 hits from that position are tops in the N.L. and second in MLB behind Mullins (91).

ROAD WARRIORS: Bucco All-Stars **Bryan Reynolds** (.331) and **Adam Frazier** (.330) rank first and second respectively in road batting average among N.L. hitters (min: 170 AB)...Frazier is hitting .380 (19-for-50) in his last 14 games played on the road and Reynolds has hit safely in 24 of his last 26 road games, going 37-for-104 (.356) with five homers and 19 RBI.

THE MEN BEHIND THE MASK: Jacob Stallings and Michael Perez have combined to produce 52 RBI this season; that's tied with the White Sox for the second-most RBI among all catchers in MLB, trailing only Tampa Bay (57)...Stallings has 40 RBI from the catcher's position this season; second behind Yadier Molina among N.L. backstops and fourth-most among all big league catchers behind Kansas City's Salvador Perez (42), Oakland's Sean Murphy (42) and Molina (41).

THE BIG NOGOWSKI: John Nogowski connected off Taylor Widener for his first big league home run Tuesday night...Nogo has hit safely in five of his last seven games and in 10 of his 13 games with the Pirates (21-for-51, .412)...His 21 hits since making his Pirates debut on 7/5 are the second-most in the Majors behind LAA's David Fletcher (26).

BITS ON BEDNAR: Bucco righthander **David Bednar** leads all National League rookie relief pitchers in appearances (42) and trails only Kansas City's Jake Brentz (46) among all big league rookies...Bednar has made eight straight scoreless outings (8.0ip) and has been scored upon just once in his last 14 appearances (13.0ip/1er).
