THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 1
2024 - RHP **Ronel Blanco** makes history, hurling the 17th no-hitter in franchise history in a 10-0, complete-game win over the Blue Jays...Blanco allowed just two walks with seven strikeouts in his gem (105 pitches)...the Astros broke out the long ball in this one, tallying five home runs, including two by **C Yainer Diaz**...the win marks the Astros first of the season, making first-year Astros manager **Joe Espada** the first manager in MLB history to collect the first win of his career via a no-hitter...the no-hitter was also the earliest by date in MLB history.

APRIL FOOLS!: The Astros and Red Sox will play an April Fools Day matchup today with the Astros going for a sweep in what is the finale of their seven-game homestand...**RHP Mike Burrows**, who grew up a Red Sox fan from Waterford, CT, will get the start for the Astros today opposite **LHP Garrett Crochet** and the Sox.

GOIN' STREAKING: The Astros have won four straight games and are going for a five-game winning streak today, which would match their season high from 2025 (reached twice last June)...only the Astros and Rangers have four-game winning streaks this season, with both streaks active going into play today.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS: The Astros are off to a 4-2 start, their best start since also going 4-2 in their first six games of 2022...should the Astros win today, it would be their best seven-game start since they went 6-1 to open the 2021 season.

ABOUT BURROWS: RHP **Mike Burrows** was acquired from the Pirates this offseason as part of a three-team, six-player trade in which the Astros sent **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays, while the Rays sent **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates...Burrows impressed this Spring, making five starts and posting a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP) while allowing a .200 opponent batting average with 17 strikeouts.

ASTROS VS. CROCHET: The Astros are seeing **LHP Garrett Crochet** today for the first time since they worked him for five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings on 86 pitches in an Astros 7-6 win on Aug. 11, 2025 at Daikin Park...that start was Crochet's shortest start, in terms of innings, of the 2025 season.

RIVALRY VS. THE RED SOX: The Astros and Red Sox have developed a nice rivalry over the last 10 years, as the two clubs have seen each other in three different postseason series since the 2017 season...the Astros won two of those three series, winning the 2017 ALDS and 2021 ALCS, while the Red Sox took the 2018 ALCS.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (976), trailing only the Dodgers (1,036).

LAST NIGHT'S W: The Astros picked up their fourth consecutive win last night, this time by a score of 9-2 over the visiting Red Sox...**RHP Hunter Brown** (1ER/6IP) was great in his start, allowing just one hit en route to his first win of the season...**RHP Cody Bolton** (1ER/3IP) followed Brown and picked up his first Major League save...the offense scored in five different innings and was led by **DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x3, HR, 2RBI), **3B Carlos Correa** (2x3, 2RBI) and **1B Christian Walker** (2x4, 2RBI) who all picked up multi-hit and multi-RBI games.

CRAZY EIGHTS: The Astros have scored eight-plus runs in four straight games for the first time since July 26-30, 2021...the offense has scored 37 runs in their last four games, while hitting .319 (44x138) with 14 doubles and six homers in that span...the Astros franchise record is five straight games with eight-plus runs, accomplished just once, from Aug. 29-Sept. 3, 2004.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (39), doubles (17) and total bases (93), while ranking tied for first in hits (55) and second in walks (20), OBP (.371), SLG (.458) and OPS (.829)...individually, **2B Jose Altuve** leads the Majors in runs scored (7), **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in total bases (19) and **1B Christian Walker** leads the Majors in doubles (5).

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: **LF Yordan Alvarez** (499 RBI) is one RBI shy of reaching 500 career RBI, a mark only 14 players in franchise history have reached...Alvarez also checks in with 173 career homers, which makes him just one homer shy of matching franchise icon **OF George Springer** (174HR) for seventh on the Astros all-time list.

YORDAN AND THE BABE: **LF Yordan Alvarez** has played 31 career games against the Red Sox, including six in the postseason, combining for a .411 (46x112) average with 12 doubles, 10 homers, 31 RBI, a .489 OBP and an .804 SLG...among all Major League players with at least 125 regular season and postseason plate appearances against the Red Sox, Alvarez leads all in batting average, OBP, SLG and OPS...the lists below include the postseason.

JOSE, JOSE, JOSE, JOSE!: **2B Jose Altuve** went 4x4 with four runs scored and a pair of homers on Monday night, giving him 42 four-hit games since he debuted in 2011, which are by far the most in the Majors in that time frame (**1B Freddie Freeman** ranks second with 31)...Altuve's four runs scored matched his career high, which he's accomplished seven times, most recently on July 4, 2025 at LAD.

GOIN' DEEP: **LF Brice Matthews** hit his first homer of the season on Monday, a 434' shot to left-center field...Matthews' homer was the longest of his career, the longest by an Astro this season (by 35 feet) and the seventh-longest in the Majors in 2026.

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market...they also added a Rule 5 pick in **RHP Roddery Muñoz**, the Astros first Rule 5 selection since the 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

SEASON DEBUT: Made his Astros and season debut last Friday vs. the Angels...surrendered 5 runs on 9 hits, including 2 home runs, while striking out 6 and allowing 2 walks...tossed a career-high 94 pitches in the start, surpassing his previous high of 91 pitches from July 30, 2025 vs. SF as a member of the Pirates...picked up 3 of his 6 strikeouts with his changeup and held hitters to an 0x5 mark on the pitch.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Native of Connecticut, Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from the Constitution State...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON: As a native of Connecticut, Mike's father, Tom, routinely took him to Red Sox games at Fenway Park while growing up...some of Mike's fondest memories involve singing along to closer RHP Jonathan Papelbon's entrance music, "I'm Shipping up to Boston" by the Dropkick Murphys...Mike credits finding his love for baseball by going to Red Sox games in his youth and he would go on to emulate Josh Beckett's pitching delivery...will be making his 2nd career appearance and 1st career start vs. the Red Sox...he tossed 2.0 innings of relief on Aug. 30 of last season at Fenway Park, allowing 1 run on 5 hits with 2 strikeouts.

SPRING TRAINING: Had a phenomenal Spring, posting a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP), .200 opponent batting average, 1.06 WHIP and 17 strikeouts through 5 starts.

ACQUIRED: After spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates minor league system, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a three-team, six-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

2025 RECAP: Pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed one-or-fewer runs in seven of his last eight appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97)...trailed only **MIL RHP Chad Patrick** (127), **WSH RHP Brad Lord** (108) and was tied with **CHC RHP Cade Horton**.

ABOUT BURROWS: Is a 2018 graduate of Waterford HS (CT), where he went 6-0 with a 0.38 ERA and 98 strikeouts over 44 innings as a senior...also threw a no-hitter his junior year, in which he struck out 21 batters...committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...was selected out of high school by Pittsburgh in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft...was offered an over-slot bonus to sign and forgo his commitment to UConn...signed by Pirates scout Eddie Charles.

SPRING TRAINING: finished Spring Training with a 3.86 ERA (3ER/7IP), 7 walks and 5 strikeouts with a .200 opponent average.

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last seven seasons (2019-25)...owns a 16-12 record with 16 saves, a 2.75 ERA (101ER/331IP) and 451 strikeouts in 331.0 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks fourth in strikeouts (451), seventh in appearances (319) and 12th in innings (331.0).

LAST APPEARANCE: pitched Sunday vs. LAA, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings on 23 pitches (17 strikes) en route to picking up the win...has 2 appearances and 2 decisions on the young season.

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season...pitched on Opening Day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing his only run on a solo homer by Mike Trout...dazzled hitters with an uptick in velocity, including throwing a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of Yoan Moncada...marked the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

SPRING TRAINING: had a powerful Spring Training, owning a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (1ER/10.2IP) in 6 appearances...walked 3 and struck out 8 with a 0.94 WHIP and a .189 (7x37) opponent batting average.
