Best in Baseball

Matt Olson went 3-for-10 and collected a double, triple and a home run yesterday, driving in four combined runs in Atlanta's doubleheader sweep.

With the performance, Olson has now compiled 20.6 bWAR dating to the start of the 2022 season when he joined Atlanta the most by any first baseman in baseball. He surpassed Freddie Freeman (20.5 bWAR) with yesterday's effort.

Since that 2022 season, Olson leads all first basemen in extra-base hits (297), total bases (1,221) and defensive runs saved (44), ranks second in homers (144) and RBI (431) and third in OPS (.862).

TODAY GAMES: The Braves and Nationals today conclude a four-game mid-week series with the 10th of 13 matchups between the teams this season...The two clubs are set to play seven times in a span of 10 days, including a three-game series at Truist Park in Atlanta next week.

- Atlanta swept a pair of games in yesterday's doubleheader, and have won all three games in this series...The Braves are 6-3 in nine total games between the two clubs this season.
- A No team in baseball beat the Braves more last season than the Nationals, when Atlanta went 5-8 in 13 total games between the clubs...The Braves had not lost even six games to the Nationals since 2019 when it went 11-8 in 19 games, and had not dropped the season set since going 9-10 in 2017.
- After yesterday's wins Atlanta is now 35-15 (.700) over its last 50 games here at Nationals Park since the start of the 2019 season...The Braves have outscored the Nationals, 298-189 (+109), here over those seven years.
- RH Hurston Waldrep is set today to make the 10th start and 11th appearance of his major league career, and his second versus Washington...The 6-foot-2, 210-pound Georgia native made his major league debut here at Nationals Park last June, and allowed four hits, four walks and seven runs over just 3.2 innings in the loss...The righthander took his only loss of the season in his last turn, last Friday vs. Houston, after allowing a career-most eight runs over 4.2 innings.
- A RH Brad Lord has made three career relief appearances against Atlanta, and is slated tonight to make his first start against the club...The 6-foot-3, 210-pound Floridian allowed two runs and fanned eight over 5.0 innings (3.60 ERA) in his three games in relief, all of which came this May...The rookie right-hander has made each of his last 10 appearances this season fromt the rotation, and is 3-3 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER/50.1 IP) in that

FOUR-GAME SWEEP?: Atlanta has won each of the first three games of this series, and will play for the four-game sweep this afternoon...The Braves have not swept a four-game set since taking all four from the Rockies in June of 2023.

- The Braves have never swept the Nationals/Expos franchise in a four-game series...Atlanta has won four games in a series against the club once, going 4-1 in a five-game set in 1996.
- Atlanta has won four straight games overall after a victory over Houston in the final game of that series on Sunday...The Braves have just one longer winning streak this season, playing to five consecutive wins from August 13 to August 17.
- The Braves have outscored the Nationals, 22-6, over these three games, and have a +21 run differential (30-9) over the four straight wins.

STREAK WEEK: Several Braves enter today's game riding notable streaks.

- Matt Olson has at least one extra-base hit and at least one RBI in five consecutive games, both of which are the longest such runs in baseball...He has not had longer streaks of either since concurrent seven-game runs last August.
- Tyler Kinley tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in Game 2 last night, and his 17.1 consecutive scoreless frames stand as the longest active scoreless streak in baseball...It is the longest scoreless streak of his
- Ozzie Albies has gone 29 consecutive at-bats without going down on strikes, tied with Vladimir Guerrero Jr. for the longest at-bat streak without a strikeout in baseball.
- Raisel Iglesias converted his 15th consecutive save in Game 1 yesterday afternoon, the longest active saves streak in the majors.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Came off the bench and delivered a pinch-hit, go-ahead double in last night's 10th inning to plate the game's first run...The run would stand as the game-winning RBI.

- Per TruMedia, Baldwin now has 11 RBI this season in either game-tying or go-ahead plate appearance opportunities in the seventh inning or later, the most by a rookie in baseball.
- Baldwin's 69 total RBI are the most by a rookie in the NL this season...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, just seven rookies have plated more in their debut seasons - Earl Williams (87 in 1971), Chipper Jones (86 in 1995), David Justice (78 in 1990), Dusty Baker (76 in 1972), Freddie Freeman (76 in 2011), Jason Heyward (72 in 2010) and Andruw Jones (70 in 1997).
- Baldwin leads all NL rookies (min. 200 at-bats) in RBI, ranks second in homers (16) and slugging percentage (.437), and fourth in average (.266) and total bases (159).

TWO-FIFTY FOR IGGY: Raisel Iglesias pitched a scoreless ninth inning in Game 1 yesterday afternoon to record his 15th consecutive save, his 26th of the season and the 250th of his career.

- Iglesias became just the 40th pitcher in history to convert at least 250 saves, and just the fifth active to do so...He joined Kenley Jansen (474), Craig Kimbrel (440), Aroldis Chapman (365) and Edwin Díaz (251).
- Since assuming Atlanta's primary closer role in 2023, Iglesias' 93 saves are most in the National League and fourth most in all of baseball.
- Iglesias owns a 1.40 ERA (6 ER/38.2 IP) over his last 40 games dating to June 9, and has lowered his ERA in this span by 3.30 points for the season. (6.75 to 3.45)...His 1.4 fWAR since that date is best in the NL.

 - A Since 1963, only five other Braves have finished their fourth game with a 0.73 ERA or lower (min. 20 IP): Greg Maddux (1998, 2001), Tim Hudson (2007), Aaron Harang (2014), Max Fried (2023) and Reynaldo López (2024).
- Waldrep went 4-0 with a 0.90 ERA in his first five outings of the season...Joined Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux as the only Atlanta-era hurlers to earn four wins, pitch at least 30.0 innings and have a sub-1.00 ERA in the first five outings of a season... Maddux posted a 0.88 ERA in his first five starts of the 1994 season.
- Struck out a career-most nine hitters against Philadelphia on August 31.
- Began 4-0 with with a 1.33 ERA in six starts and one long relief appearance with the Braves this season...Snapped his four-game winning streak on September 12 against Houston.
- ⚠ His 1.33 ERA was the lowest ERA by a Braves rookie in franchise history in a single season with at least seven appearances and six starts
 - A His 1.01 ERA was the lowest in the month of August by an Atlanta-era starter (min. 35.0 innings pitched) since Kris Medlen also went 4-0 while posting a 0.50 ERA in 2012.
