PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-42) vs. WASHINGTON NATIONALS (28-35)

June 15, 2021 at Nationals Park, Washington, DC -- GAME #66/ROAD #34

LHP TYLER ANDERSON (3-6, 4.52 ERA) vs. LHP PATRICK CORBIN (3-5, 6.21 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost a season-high eight games after winning three in a row (lost a season-high straight games last year from 9/9-16)...Have gone 11-31 in their last 42 games after winning three straight games to go above .500 (12-11) on 4/27...Were 30-35 after 65 games in 2019 (30-36 after 66 games).

THE HITS KEEP COMING: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** extended his hitting streak to 11 games with a single in the first inning last night... Hayes enters today tied for the second-longest active hitting streak in MLB along with Colorado's Raimel Tapia and Texas' Isiah Kiner-Falefa...Colorado's Charlie Blackmon has the longest active hit streak coming into today at 13 games.

HEY 19: In addition to his current 11-game hitting streak this season, **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has also hit safely in each of his last 19 games dating back to last year...According to Stats LLC, Hayes' 19-game hitting streak is tied for the longest in Pirates history (since 1900) by a rookie (**Kevin Newman** also hit safely in 19 straight games during the 2019 campaign).

ON THE ROAD: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has reached base safely in each of the first 14 road games of his career...According to Stats LLC, that's the second-longest streak in club history for a rookie behind **Johnny Barrett**, who reached base safely in each of his first 15 career road games in 1942.

SECOND TO ONE: **Adam Frazier** ranks second among all National League second basemen with 201,886 votes in the first balloting update for this year's All-Star Game in Colorado (Atlanta's Ozzie Albies leads the way among NL second basemen with 295,478 votes)...Frazier ranks first in average (.331), hits (82) and doubles (21), second in total bases (113), third in OBP (.395) and fourth in OPS (.851) among all National League second basemen.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: **Tyler Anderson** is making his 13th start of the season tonight in the second game of this three-game series against the Nats....Anderson allowed two runs in 6.0 innings, but lost a 2-1 decision in his last outing Wednesday night against the Dodgers at PNC Park...Tonight is also Anderson's fifth career start against the Nationals...His team has come away victorious in each of his previous four starting assignments (all as a member of the Rockies).

THIS AND THAT ABOUT TYLER: **Tyler Anderson** has limited left-handed hitters to a .177 batting average against (11-for-62)...Anderson has received two runs of support or fewer when he is on the mound in all but two of his starts (he received three runs of support when he was in the game in his April 21 start at Detroit and six runs on May 9 against the Cubs)...His 2.79 run support average is the lowest in all of MLB among qualifying pitchers.

CRUZING ALONG IN JUNE: **Oneil Cruz** will bring a 16-game on-base streak into tonight when Altoona opens a six-game series at Erie...Cruz, who is currently rated as Pittsburgh's fourth-best prospect by MLB Pipeline, is hitting .386 (17-for-44) in 11 games this month, which is the fifth-highest average among all Double-A Northeast League hitters...He enters today ranked fifth in the Double-A Northeast League in slugging (.582) and tied for sixth in extra base hits (16) and home runs (eight).

SLINGIN' SAMMY: **Sam Howard** enters today with the sixth-lowest ERA (2.45) among all National League left-handed relievers...The only five National League southpaw relievers to post a lower earned run average this season are Philadelphia's Ranger Suarez (0.42), Milwaukee's Josh Hader (0.68), Chicago's Andrew Chafin (1.91), Los Angeles' Victor Gonzalez (2.01) and San Diego's Tim Hill (2.03).

ALL OVER THE NL LEADER BOARD: **Bryan Reynolds** enters today ranked eighth in the National League in on-base percentage (.389), tied for fifth in doubles (18), ninth in slugging percentage (.500) and batting average (.286) and seventh in OPS (.889)... Reynolds' .903 OPS as an outfielder ranks sixth in all of MLB, trailing only Cincinnati's Jesse Winker (1.066), Cincinnati's Nick Castellanos (1.038), Atlanta's Ronald Acuna Jr. (.991), St. Louis' Tyler O'Neill (.960) and Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (.921).

AN ALL-STAR SEASON: **Adam Frazier** enters today's action tied for first in all of Major League Baseball in both doubles (23) and hits (85)...He ranks fourth in the National League in batting (.332), fifth in OBP (.394), sixth in total bases (120), 10th in OPS (.863) and tied for ninth in extra base hits (28).

THE MAN BEHIND THE MASK: **Jacob Stallings** recorded his career-high 26th RBI of the season Sunday with a solo home run in the sixth inning off Brewers starter Adrian Houser...Stallings is tied for fourth among all catchers in MLB in RBI, trailing only Oakland's Sean Murphy (32), Kansas City's Salvador Perez (31) and St. Louis' Yadier Molina (28).

NOTHING SHORT OF THE BEST: **Kevin Newman** is the only Major League shortstop without an error this season (min: 45 games played)...He has gone 55 consecutive games without making an error at shortstop; breaking his own club record for most consecutive errorless games at that position in a single season (he went 54 straight games without a miscue in 2019 from May 24 to July 23).

STRATTON HIS STUFF: **Chris Stratton** struck out one of the four batters that he faced while working a scoreless sixth inning in his last outing Monday night at Washington...Since the beginning of last season, Stratton ranks first among all National League relievers in innings pitched (65.2) and eighth in strikeouts (69).

TOMORROW'S STARTER

CHASE DE JONG: The 27-year-old righthander will be making his fourth start of the season in the finale of this three-game series tomorrow afternoon against the Nationals...Allowed two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings while having a no-decision in his last start Friday night in Milwaukee...Made his first start with the Pirates on 5/30 vs. Colorado after being selected from Triple-A Indianapolis earlier in the day; gave up one run in 5.0+ innings and was in line for the win before the Rockies scored twice in the ninth for the victory...Went 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA (20.0ip/8er) in four starts with Indianapolis this season...Was signed as a minor league free agent after going 0-1 in three games (two starts) with Houston in 2020...Made his Major League debut with Seattle in 2017 and picked up his first big league win while pitching with Minnesota on 9/28/18.

vs. WASHINGTON: Has never faced the Nationals.
