**RAYS REPORT**—The Rays continue a brief three-game home swing vs. the Dodgers (0-1, two to play) today...will begin a 12-game, 14-day, West Coast trip against the Angels (3G), Mariners (3G), Athletics (3G) and Giants (3G) Monday, continuing a stretch of 19 road games in a 22-game span from July 25–Aug. 17...are three games below .500 for the first time since entering play on May 23 (23-26)...were last four games under entering play on May 21 (22-26)...have dropped four straight games, the longest active skid in the AL, and eight of nine, 10 of 12, 14 of 18, 18 of 24 and 22 of their last 30 games...started 21-26, went an MLB-best 25-9 from May 20–June 26 and are an MLB-worst 8-22 since June 27...are fourth in the AL East for the 22nd consecutive day, a season-high-tying 10.0 GB the division-leading Blue Jays and 5.0 GB the Mariners for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 52 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays were blanked, 5-0, in last night's series opener, mustering six hits, all singles...it was their second time this season recording no extra-base hits or walks, joining July 12 at BOS, and first time at home since June 8, 2024 vs. BAL.
- ★ Since the All-Star break, Tampa Bay has recorded the AL's lowest slugging pct. (.352) and fewest extra-base hits (32, tied with Seattle).
- ★ Rays pitching fanned 15 batters, their fourth time this season reaching the mark (last: July 2 vs. ATH, 17SO)...the staff has 9 SO or more in nine of its last 12 games since July 20, generating a 25.9 pct. strikeout rate, second in MLB behind the Rangers (26.9%).
- ★ Despite the plethora of strikeouts, the Rays have allowed five runs or more in a season-high-tying four straight games (also: May 4-8)...their last longer streak was six games from May 19-25, 2024.
- ★ Tampa Bay is 20-11 (.645) at Steinbrenner Field since May 20, the AL's third-best home record in that span behind Toronto (24-6/.800) and Boston (22-10/.688).
- ★ The Rays are looking to snap a seven-game skid in games vs. left-handed starting pitchers...their last such win came on June 24 vs. KC (**Kris Bubic**).
- ★ Under **Kevin Cash** (2015–pres.), the Rays are 164-109 (.601) in August, second in the majors, trailing only the Dodgers (186-91/.671).
- ★ The Rays need to win the next two games to avoid their ninth loss in their last 10 series...they are looking to snap a four-game losing streak in Interleague play, their longest since Sept. 1-11, 2024 (4G)...their last longer skid was July 4-8, 2023 (5G).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—RHP **Adrian Houser** (No. 37) officially reported today...to make room on the active roster, RHP **Kevin Kelly** was optioned to Triple-A Durham.

**GOOSE EGGS**—The Rays were shut out for the ninth time last night, fifth most in the AL behind four clubs tied at 11: the Guardians, Orioles, Rangers and Royals...it marks their most shutout losses since 2022 (10G)...six of those shutouts have come at home, tied with the Guardians and Pirates for second most in the majors behind the Royals (7G) and the Rays most in a season since 2018 (6)...entering the year, they were shut out at home seven times across the last two seasons (2023-24).

**THE WRONG KIND OF STREAK**—The Rays current four-game skid is their sixth this season of four games or longer, tied with the White Sox for second most in the majors, trailing only the Rockies (9)...it marks their most four-game skids in a season since 2016 (7).

**FROM THEN TO LOWE**—**Brandon Lowe** appeared in his 700th career game last night, all with the Rays...he became the ninth player to reach the milestone in a Tampa Bay uniform, joining **Evan Longoria** (1,435G), **Carl Crawford** (1,235G), **Ben Zobrist** (1,064G), **B.J. Upton** (966G), **Kevin Kiermaier** (914G), **Aubrey Huff** (799G), **Yandy Diaz** (771G) and **Carlos Peña** (726G)...he is the only player in franchise history to appear in eight seasons with the Rays without suiting up for another club...Lowe is the sixth player to appear exclusively for Tampa Bay over the first eight seasons of his career, joining Kiermaier (10), Longoria (10), Crawford (9), Zobrist (9) and Upton (8).

**GO, JONNNY, GO**—**Jonny DeLuca** has hit safely in a career-high nine straight starts, going 14-for-33 (.424) with 2 3B, 4 RBI, 4 R and 5 SB in those games...the streak began March 30 vs. COL before he was sidelined for 94 games with a right shoulder strain...last night, he tallied his fourth multi-hit game of the campaign, first since April 5 at TEX (2-for-4)...**DeLuca** (.400/.16-for-40) is the sixth player in Rays history to hit .400 or better through his first 15 games of a season (min. 30AB), joining **Jonathan Aranda** (2025, .413), **Jason Tyner** (2003, .406), **Kevin Stocker** (1999, .417), **Bob Smith** (1998, .408) and **Fred McGriff** (1998, .400).

★ He is a combined 15-for-35 (.429) in at-bats ending with fastballs or breaking pitches.

★ DeLuca is one hit shy of 100 for his career.

**MILESTONE WATCH**—**Yandy Diaz** is one hit away from 900 and five runs from tying **Kevin Kiermaier** (410R) for fifth on the Rays all-time list...his 64 three-hit games are one shy of **Aubrey Huff** (65G) for third...**Christopher Morel** is 4 RBI away from 200...**Junior Caminero** and **Nick Fortes** are both 4 RBI shy of 100...**Josh Lowe** needs 1 SB to surpass **Miguel Cairo** for sole possession of 10th in franchise history...**Pete Fairbanks** needs 3 SO to tie **Grant Balfour** (291SSO) for third most by a reliever in club history and four saves to match **Fernando Rodney** (85SV) for third in Rays history.

**TURN THE PAGE**—The Rays went 7-18 (.280) in July, the lowest winning pct. in the majors and their lowest in a calendar month since **Kevin Cash** took the helm in 2015...it marked the fifth-worst winning pct. in a month in team history (min. .6G), ahead of only July 2007 (7-20/.259), July 2002 (7-20), May 2001 (7-20) and June 2003 (5-21/.192)...Rays hitters had the AL's lowest OPS (.677) while averaging the fewest runs per game (.392)...on the mound, their 4.43 ERA (215.1IP, 106ER) ranked 19th in the majors, but the bullpen led MLB with nine blown saves, tying the club record for a single month (5x, last: Sept. 2023)...the Rays led in 11 of their 18 defeats, their most blown lead losses in a month since May 2017 (11) and tied for second most in a month in franchise history (8x), trailing only August 2006 (14).

- ★ According to FanGraphs, the Rays postseason probability dropped by 66.7 pct. entering play on July 1 through the month's end, going from 75.6 pct. to 8.9 pct.

**BLUE CREW IN THE BAY**—The Rays and Dodgers meet for their lone series of 2025 this weekend in Tampa...the Rays are 2-3-4 in series play vs. Los Angeles (2-1-2 at home) with the lone wins coming from May 26-28, 2023 and June 22-24, 2007, both at Tropicana Field...last season, they dropped two of three games at Dodger Stadium from Aug. 23-25, falling on a **Shohei Ohtani** walk-off grand slam in the opener before taking the second game in 10 innings, 9-8, thanks to a pair of clutch homers by **José Caballero** (go-ahead 2R HR in 10th inn.) and **Junior Caminero** (game-tying solo HR in 9th)...they dropped the rubber match, 3-1, after **Mookie Betts** hit a go-ahead two-run homer in 8th.

- ★ **Blake Snell** is scheduled to start for the Dodgers today in his return from the injured list...the southpaw began his MLB career with the Rays (2016-20), helping the club to a World Series appearance in 2020...in 2018, he became the second pitcher in franchise history to win an AL Cy Young Award, joining **David Price** (2012).
- ★ **Jonny DeLuca** is 7-for-15 (.467) 1 HR, 3 RBI, 2 BB and 2 R in four career games against the Dodgers, who he began his MLB career with in 2023.

**TODAY'S START**—Drew Rasmussen will toe the rubber for his 22nd start of the campaign and 14th at home...marks the 72nd start (121G) of his career and 35th at home (61G)...marks his first career start/third appearance opposite the Dodgers...min. 100.0 IP, ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (8th, 1.04), opp. OPS (8th, .607), ERA (10th) and opp. average (10th, .218)...the Rays are 10-3 in his last 13 starts...is 12 strikeouts shy of 400 for his career...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

**LAST TIME OUT**—On the day after his 30th birthday, he picked up his eighth win after spinning five innings of two-run ball in a series-opening, 4-2 win on July 28 at NYY (W, 5.OIP, 4H, 2ER, 2BB, 5SO)...both runs came in the opening frame, when he retired the first two batters before yielding three consecutive singles followed by back-to-back bases-loaded walks...escaped the jam with an infield pop-up...entering the outing, he had issued one bases-loaded walk in his previous 119 career appearances (70GS)...allowed only one baserunner the rest of the way, retiring 12 straight after the second bases-loaded walk and 13 of his final 14 batters faced, permitting only a two-out single in his 5th and final inning of work.

- ✦ He threw 81 pitches (53 strikes), his eighth time in 21 starts reaching the 80-pitch mark and his most since logging a season-high 92 on June 19 vs. BAL.
- ✦ Rasmussen has allowed three runs or fewer in 18 of 21 starts this season and one or zero runs in 11 of 21.

**DODGER, DODGER**—Rasmussen will be making his first career start against Los Angeles, most recently throwing scoreless 6th and 7th frames in a 3-1 loss on Aug. 25, 2024 at Dodger Stadium (2.OIP, H, OR, 2BB, 3SO)...he has not registered a decision in six career appearances (2GS) against NL West competition, turning in a 4.73 ERA (13.1IP, 7ER)...he has posted a 5.14 ERA (7.OIP, 4ER) in the two starts despite a 0.86 WHIP.

- ✦ He is 3-2 with a 3.48 ERA (41.1IP, 16ER) in eight Interleague starts this season...the Rays have won each of his last three starts against NL opponents.

**HOME COOKING**—The Rays have won five of Rasmussen's last seven home starts after going 1-5 across his first six...he is 3-1 with a 2.55 ERA (35.1IP, 10ER), a 0.93 WHIP, 31 SO and 9 BB while holding opponents to a .197/.261/.254 (24-for-122) line with 1 HR (0.25 HR/9.OIP)...min. 30.0 IP, his .254 opp. slugging pct. and .515 opp. OPS at home in that span (since May 23) both rank second in the AL behind CLE Gavin Williams (.245 SLG/.505 OPS), and the 0.93 WHIP is seventh.

- ✦ He has yielded three runs or fewer in 12 of his 13 starts at Steinbrenner Field...min. 60.0 IP, his 2.76 ERA (65.1IP, 20ER) at home ranks 11th in the AL.

**SLUG STOPPER**—Rasmussen has allowed only two extra-base hits (2 2B) across his last three starts, holding opponents to a .286 slugging pct. ...his last outing on July 28 at NYY was his MLB-leading ninth of 5.0 IP or more with no extra-base hits allowed, tying David Price (2012) for the most by a Ray in a single season in franchise history...min. 100.0 IP, his .331 opp. slugging pct. on the season ranks seventh in the AL.

**DREW DAY**—He is 3-1 with a 2.48 ERA (40.OIP, 11ER) and a 0.95 WHIP in eight daytime starts, allowing three runs or fewer in seven of those outings and one or zero runs in five of them...this includes a 2.05 ERA (22.OIP, 5ER) and 0.86 WHIP in four day starts at Steinbrener Field...the Rays have won each of his last five day starts after losing his first three.

**FROZE HIM**—Rasmussen is tied with BOS Garret Crochet for sixth in the AL with 36 called strikeouts behind NYY Will Warren (45), CLE Tanner Bibee (41), HOU Hunter Brown (39), ATH Luis Severino (38) and TOR José Berrios (37)...in his last 13 starts, 21 of his 52 strikeouts have been looking.

**HEAT CHECK**—Rasmussen throws fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 89.5 pct. of the time, the highest rate among major league starters (min. 500 pitches thrown in starts)...among all hurlers with 500 pitches thrown or more this season, only NYY Tim Hill (95.3%) and LAA Kenley Jansen (91.0%) have a higher usage rate on heaters than Rasmussen.

- ✦ Opponents are hitting .220 (74-for-327) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .187 (20-for-107) clip against his cutter...min. 100 AB ending with cutters, it signals the second-lowest mark in the majors behind Jansen (.179).

**GOING STREAKING**—Rasmussen's 23.0 scoreless inning streak from May 17–June 3 was tied for the fifth-longest single-season run in club history, trailing runs by J.P. Howell (27.1IP, 2012), Alex Cobb (24.2IP, 2014), Kevin Kelly (24.1, 2024) and Taj Bradley (24.OIP, 2024)...only Cobb's and Bradley's streaks came as starting pitchers...Rasmussen tallied five scoreless innings or more in a franchise-record four consecutive starts during the streak.

**BEST OF THE BEST**—Min. 350.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.77 ERA (373.2IP, 115ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks third in the majors behind NYY Max Fried (2.70) and SD Michael King (2.77)...under the same parameter, he also leads the AL in opp. OPS (.590) and opp. slugging pct. (.323), is second in WHIP (1.03) and opp. on-base pct. (.267), and ninth in opp. average (.219).

- ✦ Rasmussen (2.96) is one of 12 active major league pitchers with 400.0 IP or more and an ERA of 3.00 or lower in his career...he is one of four to accomplish the feat while starting in at least half of his appearances, joining TEX Jacob DeGrom (2.52), LAD Clayton Kershaw (2.52) and LAD Shohei Ohtani (2.99).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP JOE BOYLE (1-1, 2.82)

**LAST OUTING**—Making his first start as a regular member of the Rays rotation, he was tagged for a season-high six runs in a 7-5 loss on July 29 at NYY (L, 3.1IP, 4H, 6R-4ER, 3BB, 6SO)...marked his first loss since Aug. 24, 2024 vs. MIL.

**vs. DODGERS**—He will be making his first career start/appearance opposite Los Angeles...Boyle had made one previous appearances vs. the NL West, working three scoreless frames in relief on Sept. 17, 2023 vs. SD as a member of Oakland (3.OIP, H, OR, 2BB, 4SO).
