**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants look to carry momentum from their getaway day win yesterday afternoon in Cincinnati into this three-game series with the Nationals that begins tonight in the District.

- ▶ This is the third and last stop on the Giants three-city, 11-day road trip through the east coast...SF is 2-4 on the trip so far having gone 1-2 in both Baltimore (last weekend) and Cincinnati (earlier this week).
- ▶ SF avoided a sweep yesterday in Cincinnati with a 3-0 win over the Reds in a game that saw multiple instances of the benches clearing but no real altercations.
- ▶ Giants pitching held the Reds to just one hit after starter **RHP Landen Roupp** no-hit Cincinnati through the first 5.0 innings before C PJ Higgins singled off Roupp to start the sixth...SF's 'pen tossed the final 3.0 scoreless, hitless innings to seal up the win...**LHP Erik Miller** recorded the first save of his young career.
- ▶ It was the first time Giants pitching held an opponent to one or no hits since **LHP Blake Snell's** no-hitter at Cincinnati on August 2, 2024...overall, the Giants have played 116 games decided by three or fewer runs since the start of 2025 (most in the National League over that span).

**WEBBCAST:** **RHP Logan Webb** looks to get back on track in the nation's capital tonight following his loss in Baltimore last Saturday.

- ▶ Webb permitted four runs over 6.0 innings in the Giants' 6-2 defeat at Oriole Park...he struck out six, allowed five hits and walked three in the 98-pitch effort.
- ▶ The Giants as a team are 1-3 in Webb's four starts this year with the club's only win coming in San Diego on March 31...SF's offense has given Webb four total runs of support in the three losses combined.
- ▶ He's familiar with this ballpark having pitched here three previous times from 2022-2024 and going 2-1 with a 6.59 ERA (10er, 13.2ip)...his last outing against the Nats came here on August 5, 2024 in a 4-1 Giants victory (5.2ip, 4h, r, er, 3bb, 4k).

**WHERE CAN WE FIND A LIVE CHICKEN?:** Three runs proved to be enough for the Giants yesterday afternoon in Cincinnati...it was, however, the fifth consecutive game they were held to three or fewer runs (SF is 1-4 in those five) and the 13th time in 19 games this year.

- ▶ The Giants enter today with the lowest runs per game in the Majors (3.05)...they also rank inside MLB's bottom five in on-base percentage (.286, 29th), OPS (.633, 27th), walks (38, 30th) and home runs (nine, 30th).
- ▶ SF used three, two-out RBI in the 7th inning yesterday to take the lead...it was a good sign for the Giants who have had trouble with relief pitching for much of the early season...during SF's four-game losing streak that ended with yesterday's win, opposing relievers had thrown a combined 12 innings against the Giants while allowing only one run.
- ▶ Through 19 games the Giants have slashed .211/.258/.309 and scored 23 runs off opposing relievers...against starters they have slashed .259/.304/.372 with 35 runs scored.

**EVENING OUT:** SF's bullpen threw 10.0 scoreless innings during the Reds series, allowing just three hits, three walks and 13 strikeouts.

- ▶ Over the last eight games dating to April 7 the 'pen has a 2.25 ERA (6er, 24.0ip) with 29 strikeouts, 11 walks allowed and two home runs permitted (.205 BAA with a .588 OPS).

**LA REGADERA: IF Luis Arraez** has hit safely in each of his 11 career games here at Nationals Park, going 24-for-48 (.500) with three homers, 10 RBI and 13 runs scored.

- ▶ Furthermore, Arraez has reached base safely in 19 consecutive games against the Nationals regardless of venue...that streak started on August 27, 2023 when he played for Miami...he's slashing .392/.429/.529 against them during the run.

**JHL DELIVERY UPDATE: OF Jung Hoo Lee** logged his second three-hit game of the year in yesterday's getaway day win in Cincinnati...since debuting in the Majors in 2024, Lee's 15 career games with three or more hits are tied for second-most on the Giants with **IF Matt Chapman**...**OF Heliot Ramos** leads the team in that category (16) (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ Through the first six games of this trip, Lee has recorded four multi-hit games and is slashing .435/.458/.696 (1.154 OPS) with three doubles, a homer, three RBI and three runs scored.
- ▶ When this trip began, Lee was slashing .143/.224/.214 through his first 13 games...he enters today slashing .246/.301/.385, raising his batting average over 100 points.

**WEBBMASTER:** Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the loss last Saturday in Baltimore in the Giants' 6-2 defeat...surrendered four runs over 6.0 innings on five hits (one homer) and three walks while striking out six...the homer was the first he'd allowed this season and the first since September 11 of last year...when the runs were allowed against the O's proved extra costly for SF...after the Giants took the 1-0 lead in the second Webb gave the run right back...when SF tied the game at two in the top of the 4th inning he allowed two more O's runs in the bottom half for a lead they did not relinquish.

**VS. WASHINGTON:** Is facing the Nationals for a seventh time in his career and his fourth time here at Nationals Park...the Giants are 5-1 in Webb's six career starts against the Nats and Webb himself is 4-1 with a 4.25 ERA (14er, 29.2ip)...his lone loss has come here in DC back on July 22, 2023 when he allowed six runs on five hits in 1.1 innings...he last faced the Nationals in 2024 here in DC, picking up the win with 5.2 innings of one-run ball while striking out four on August 5.

**HE POSTS:** Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 844.0 innings...the next closest pitcher is Detroit's Framer Valdez, who has logged 791.2 innings...Webb's 87 quality starts since 2022 are also tops in the Majors ahead of Valdez' 86...lastly, his 136 starts in that span are most in MLB ahead of TOR's Dylan Cease (134).

**DO IT FOR WEBBY:** The Giants were only 18-16 in Webb's 34 starts last year, which was actually an improvement over them going 16-17 in his 33 starts in 2024...they are 1-3 in his four starts this year...since 2022, SF as a team is 68-68 in Webb's 136 starts yet his 3.27 ERA in that time is 10th-best in MLB among starters who have made at least 80 starts...his 2.95 FIP in that span is tied for first in the NL with LAD's Blake Snell and tied for second in the Majors behind only Tarik Skubal (2.51).

**COMPARE AND CONTRAST:** Looking at Webb's pitch mix through four starts compared to his 34 starts year a season ago, you see that his sinker usage is up almost 7% from last season while his sweeper usage is down roughly 6% from a season ago...Webb's whiff rate on his sweeper through four starts this year is 17.4%...a season ago it was 29.0%...batters are 4-for-14 (.286) off it in the early going this year, which is in line with what opposing hitters did against it last year (52-for-182, .286) but he's getting much less swing through on the offering to start 2026.

**STARS & STRIPES:** Suited up for USA in the WBC and made two terrific starts in their win over Brazil plus their quarterfinal win over Canada...in the two outings, Webb was 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1er, 8.2ip) with five hits allowed, one walk and 11 strikeouts...Webb was one of two Giants named to the WBC All-Tournament Team (also **Luis Arraez** at 1B for champion Venezuela).

**EVERYONE HAS A POD THESE DAYS...:** Last Friday in Baltimore Webb debuted his new show *Logan's Webb* on MLB Network Radio with co-host Ryan Spilborghs...Webb will do the show twice a month during the season...you can find the first episode by clicking [here](#).

**LET'S LOOK BACK:** The Rocklin, CA native finished fourth in the NL Cy Young Award voting in 2025 after leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) and the National League in strikeouts (224) while going 15-11 with a 3.22 ERA...*the last Giant prior to Webb to lead the NL in both innings pitched and strikeouts was Bill Voiselle in 1944*...Webb garnered his second All-Star selection, eclipsed the 200-inning threshold for a third straight season, made a career-best 34 starts and set a career-high with his 224 strikeouts...you can see Webb's National League rankings from last season below.

- ▶ Allowed four runs on five hits and two walks over 4.2 innings at Baltimore during his last start on April 12.
- ▶ Despite zero wins in six career games (four starts) vs. the Nats, his 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip) is his best vs. any team that he's started three or more games against.
- ▶ Has an ERA of 1.50 (2er, 12.0ip), a 0.83 WHIP, three XBH hits allowed and a .485 opposing OPS in innings 1-4 this season...in the 5th and 6th inning, he has a 15.75 ERA (7er, 4.0ip), 3.75 WHIP, five XBH allowed and a 1.276 OPS.

### #47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 4/15 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-13 (.154) with two walks and four strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (69-for-382) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-14 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/15 at CIN; 2.0ip, 2h, bb, 2k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's first 19 games and tossed 2.0 innings three times.
- ▶ Has allowed runs in one of his eight games and has issued at least one walk in six of eight contests (eight walks in 10.1ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-25 (.360) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-12 (.083).
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 0.2ip, h, r, er, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ With his win on April 8, at age 33 years and 56 days old, he became the oldest pitcher in the San Francisco era (since 1958) to earn their first career MLB win as a member of the Giants.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's 19 games, tossing 7.1-innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 41.0 innings dating to June 11, 2023, which is the ninth-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts and four walks in eight games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

### #60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/16 at CIN; SV, 1.0ip, bb, 3k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Struck out three batters in the 9th yesterday at Cincinnati to record his first career save.
- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's 19 games, allowing four runs in 6.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 51.1 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fifth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

### #46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/15 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in four of his five outings (2er, 7.0ip) and posted a 0.86 WHIP.
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/16 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's first 19 games.
- ▶ Batters are 2-for-14 in ABs that end with his slider and 4-for-13 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider last season.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/16 at CIN; 1.0ip, 2k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Seven of his nine appearances this year have been scoreless.
