ANOTHER SATURDAY NIGHT

- Washington's off day on Monday will be its first since July 24, ending a stretch of 17 games in 17 days...The Nationals are also on a run of 39 games in 41 days from July 24 through Sept. 2.
- This series features the top two players in Major League Baseball in RBI: **CJ Abrams** (1st, 88) and **Sal Stewart** (2nd, 87)...The Nationals (1st, 170) and Reds (5th, 153) both rank in the top five in MLB in home runs.

REDS KILLER

- He's produced multi-hit efforts in three of the four games against them this season...Five of the seven hits have gone for extra bases (2B, 4 HR).

ALIEN ENCOUNTERS

- He is hitting .336/.392/.682 with six doubles, one triple and 10 home runs in his last 28 games.
- It should be noted that Abams ranks third in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with 12 career leadoff home runs behind **Trea Turner** (14) and **James Wood** (13).

HOMER HAPPY

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 170 home runs, six ahead of the New York Yankees (164).

- The Nationals have clubbed 133 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 20 more than the Astros and Mets (113)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB.
- **Andrew Pinkney's** first career hit came via the long ball on Thursday at Philadelphia...In doing so, he joined **Justin Maxwell** (9/11/07), **Tommy Milone** (9/3/11), **Corey Brown** (7/28/12), **Juan Soto** (5/15/18), **Carter Kieboom** (4/26/19) and **Joey Meneses** (8/2/22) as players in Nationals history to homer for their first MLB hit.

BORN TO RUN

- **Nasim Nuñez** leads MLB with 40 stolen bases, nine ahead of **Bobby Witt Jr.** (31).
- He is seven stolen bases shy of tying **CJ Abrams'** Nationals record (2005-pres.) of 47 stolen bases in 2023... He is one of four players in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to steal at least 40 bases joining **Alfonso Soriano** (2006, 41), **Trea Turner** (2017, 43 and 2017, 46) and **CJ Abrams** (2023, 47).

NICE ABS

The Nationals rank second in MLB with a 62.3% (33-for-53) in ABS challenge success rate since July 12.

- Washington's hitters are 9-for-16 (56.3%), while the catchers are 24-for-37 (64.9%) over this stretch...The 24 successful challenges by the catchers are the most in Major League Baseball since July 12.
- **Keibert Ruiz's** 14 successful challenges are tied for second among MLB catchers since July 12, while **Harry Ford** is 9-for-14 (64.3%) on challenges in eight games since being recalled on July 17.

SLUGGIN' YOUNG

Jacob Young is slugging .526 with a 1.098 OPS over his last 11 games...He's recorded three doubles and one triple while hitting .393 (11-for-28) during this stretch...He's walked eight times against just four strikeouts.

- Over his last 18 games, Young has walked 11 times against just seven strikeouts in 67 plate appearances.

OUR DIAMOND, OUR DISTRICT

- The District Blueprint cap and jersey patch both feature a new stylized block W, which surrounds the outline of the Capitol Dome...The W is flanked on either side by the District's iconic cherry blossoms.
- On the patch, the W sits on a tile background, reminiscent of some of the city's most recognizable architectural features like the Capitol rotunda, Library of Congress and brutalist Metro stations.
- The interlocking DC on the chest, which was worn by the Nationals from 2006-10, receives a 3D treatment in a nod to the 1956 Washington Senators logo.
- A mosaic detail trims the white pants, representing the diverse makeup of Washington, D.C., and how its residents come together to form a work of art.

CAREER

Washington's 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year made his Major League debut in 2025.

- Is the 30th starting pitcher originally signed or drafted and developed by the Nationals to start a game for the team (since 2005).
- Ranked 12th in Minor League Baseball with 468.2 innings pitched from 2022 through the end of the 2025 season.

LAST APPEARANCE

Alvarez tossed a season-high 6.1 innings, allowing two earned runs on three hits with five strikeouts...He took a no-decision in the 6-3 loss to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 3.

vs. CINCINNATI

Alvarez is set to make his first career appearance against the Cincinnati Reds.

STINGY WITH THE LONG BALL

Alvarez has not allowed a home run in 46.1 consecutive innings pitched, the second-longest active streak among MLB starting pitchers...The last home run allowed came off the bat of Miami's **Esteury Ruiz** on June 3 in the top of the second inning...That home run hit the left field foul pole.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Opposing batters are hitting .188 (16-for-85) with five extra-base hits off Alvarez's curveball...He's fanned 39 batters with the curve this season, the most of any of his pitches.

2025

Tall left-hander ranked second in Washington's system (4th in all of Triple-A) with 123.0 innings and third in the organizaton (10th in Triple-A) with 114 strikeouts at the time of his Major League debut.

- Pitched to a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in his first three career starts...Only Tanner Roark (0.95) produced a lower ERA in his first three career starts in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
- Matched the Major League record for a starting pitcher in his first five career games by not allowing a run in three of his first five games (22nd overall)...He was the first National (2005-pres.) to do so.
- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 1 vs. Miami (5.0 IP, H, 4 SO, 2 BB)...Struck out Joey Weimer in the third inning for his first Major League strikeout...Earned the win, becoming the sixth pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to do so in his Major League debut.
- Became the first pitcher in Nationals' history (2005-pres.) to throw 5.0 shutout innings in his Major League debut.
- Went 3-7 with a 4.10 ERA with 114 strikeouts and 52 walks in 25 starts this season for Triple-A Rochester before he was called up.
- In six starts prior to his callup, he went 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER/30.1 IP) with 39 strikeouts and a .170 opponents' average.
