THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 14
1965 - In dramatic fashion, the Astros earn their first win since being re-named the Astros, topping the Mets at Shea Stadium, 7-6 in 11 innings. The Astros score 4 runs in the top of the 11th to take a 7-3 lead, and then hold on after the Mets scored 3 in the bottom half of the inning. Houston changed the name of the ballclub from the Colt .45s to the Astros to coincide with the opening of the Astrodome.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros return home tonight to begin a 3-game series vs. the Colorado Rockies...LHP Colton Gordon will make his first start of the season as he takes on Rockies RHP Michael Lorenzen.

HOME-COOKIN: Tonight is the first game of a 6-game homestand for the Astros...on the stand, HOU will host COL (Mon-Wed.) and STL (Fri.-Sun.), respectively...the Astros enter tonight's game on a 5-game home winning streak...HOU is 5-2 overall at Daikin Park in 2026.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY: At 6-11 thus far this season, the Astros have posted a losing record after 17 games for the 6th consecutive season...the last time that HOU had a winning record after 17 games was in 2019 (12-5).

TONIGHT'S ASTROS STARTER: LHP Colton Gordon will make his first start of the season for the Astros tonight...Gordon began the 2026 season with Triple A Sugar Land, where he was 1-1 with a 1.76 ERA (3ER/15.1IP) in three starts while posting an 0.98 WHIP...his last start was on April 8 vs. Tacoma (5.1 IP, 0 ER)...Gordon, who was the Astros 8th pick in the 2021 MLB Draft, made his ML debut last season, appearing in 20 games (14 GS) for the Astros (6-4, 5.34 ERA)...as a result of a rash of injuries, Gordon finished T-3rd on the Astros staff in both starts (14) and innings pitched (86.0)...recorded his 1st ML win on June 6 at CLE (5 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 5 SO)...was a member of Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Astros were defeated by the Mariners in Seattle yesterday afternoon, 6-2...RHP Mike Burrows (1-3) took the loss (6 IP, 6 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO)...RHP J.P. France hurled 2.0 scoreless innings in relief...the Astros offense was held to seven hits, all singles...Isaac Paredes was 2x4.

NEED A WIN: The Astros need a win to snap an 8-game losing streak, which is their longest since ending the 2013 season with a 15-game losing streak (Sept. 14-29).

VS. THE ROCKIES: The Astros were swept by the Rockies last week in a 3-game series at Coors Field (April 6-9)...HOU was 4-2 vs. COL in 2025 and has a 110-90 record vs. the Rockies all-time.

ROCKING THE ROCKIES: Christian Walker has enjoyed facing the Rockies throughout his career, posting a .330 avg. (120x364) vs. them with 28 HR and 75 RBI with a 1.009 OPS...his career avg., RBI and OPS vs. COL are his best vs. any club (min. 10g) while his 28 HR are 2nd to his 29 HR vs. the Dodgers...Walker was 5x13 (.385) with a HR in his three games at Coors Field last week.

REMEMBERING PHIL: Prior to tonight's game, the Astros will play a tribute video followed by a moment of silence for former player/manager Phil Garner...sadly, Garner passed away over the weekend after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer...as manager in 2005, Garner led the Astros to their first World Series appearance, famously rallying that club from a 15-30 start after 45 games.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in several key offensive categories, with most being by wide margins.

ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have added RHP Spencer Arrighetti to the Taxi Squad.

HOT START: Yordan Alvarez is off to a sizzling start for the Astros in 2026...in the AL, he currently ranks first in walks (16), 2nd in OPS (1.201), SLG (.714) and OBP (.487), T-2nd in RBI (14) and 3rd in WAR (1.1)...Alvarez was named AL Player of the Week for March 30-April 5 (4th time to win the award).

MOVIN' ON UP: LF Yordan Alvarez recorded his 175th career home run on Fri. night at SEA...the home run moved him into sole possession of seventh place on the Astros all-time home run list, passing OF George Springer...next up on the Astros all-time list is 3B Alex Bregman (191 HR).

HIT MAN: Jose Altuve enters tonight's game with 2,407 hits, which ranks 2nd among active players behind Freddie Freeman (2,449)...Altuve also ranks second in hits in franchise history behind Craig Biggio's 3,060 career hits.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2017 season, the Astros have made eight postseason appearances in nine seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,047)...HOU's 59-40 (.596) postseason record in that span gives them the most postseason wins of any AL club by a 27-win margin (NYY are next with 32 wins).

AT THE HELM: Manager Joe Espada is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVE: was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land prior to yesterday's game at SEA and will be making his first MLB appearance of the season with tonight's start...has made 3 starts with Triple A Sugar Land this year, going 1-1 with a 1.76 ERA (3ER/15.1IP), a 0.98 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...ranked 6th in the PCL in ERA at the time of his promotion.

GORDO IN '25: is coming off a rookie season in which he made 20 appearances (14 starts) and went 6-4 with a 5.34 ERA (51ER/86IP), 1.42 WHIP and a 3.79 SO/BB ratio...began the year with Triple A Sugar Land but became a regular in the Astros rotation due to injuries, finishing T-3rd on the club in starts and innings pitched...was initially recalled on May 14 and made 5 separate stints with the Astros...went 3-1 with a 3.98 ERA (18ER/40.2IP) over the first 8 starts of his career from May 14-June 25...also made 11 starts for Triple A Sugar Land, posting a 3.38 ERA (21ER/56IP) with 56 strikeouts, 16 walks and a 1.34 WHIP.

ROOKIE LEADERBOARD: among AL rookies in 2025, he ranked 1st in walks per nine innings (1.99) and first in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.79) (min. 80 IP)...was 1 of 4 rookies in Astros history to toss at least 80.0 innings and post a BB/9IP rate of 1.99 or less in a single season, joining **RHP Shane Reynolds** (1.52), **RHP Roy Oswalt** (1.52) and **RHP Chris Devenski** (1.66).

MLB DEBUT: made his big league debut on May 14 at KC (4.1 IP, 7 H, 3 R/ER, 2 BB, 3 SO) and picked up his 1st career strikeout vs. **IF Jonathan India**...recorded his first MLB winning decision on June 6 at CLE (5.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 5 SO).

SAVANT SAYS: the 6-foot-4 lefty averaged 6.8 feet of extension in 2025, ranking in the 84th percentile among MLB pitchers.

ABOUT GORDON: enters his 5th season at the pro level, all spent with the Astros, and will be appearing at the MLB level for the 2nd consecutive season with tonight's start...was selected by the Astros in the 8th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from University of Central Florida...was a Pacific Coast League All-Star in 2024 as a member of Triple A Sugar Land, ranking 1st in the league in opponent batting average (.234) and WHIP (1.22)...has also twice been named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star (2022-23)...was a member of Team Israel for the 2023 World Baseball Classic, logging a start vs. Team Puerto Rico in the Pool Play Round.

LAST APPEARANCE (4/12 at SEA): worked a scoreless 1.0 inning Sunday at SEA while allowing 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout...snapped a streak of 6 consecutive outings in which he allowed a run to open the season...tossed a season-high 27 pitches in the outing (18 strikes).

VS. COL: has struck out 17 batters through 8.1 innings in 9 career appearances vs. the Rockies (1.08 ERA)...his 18.4 SO/9IP vs. the Rockies is his highest vs. an opponent...is also the highest SO/9IP among active players with at least 8.0 IP in their career vs. the Rockies.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in strikeouts (458), 7th in appearances (324) and 11th in innings pitched (334.2)...surpassed **RHP Ryan Pressly** for 11th in innings last Wednesday at COL...is now 2.1 innings from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (337) for 10th on that list.

CAREER: has been one of the most dominant relievers in baseball for the Astros in each of the last 8 seasons (2019-26)...owns a 16-14 record with 17 saves, a 2.85 ERA (106ER/334.2IP) and 458 strikeouts in 334.2 Major League innings.

MULTI-INNING MAN: a starter throughout his minor league career, Blubaugh has 3 appearances of 2.0 or more IP this season.

OPENING DAY FIRE: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season and pitched that day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball...tossed a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**, the hardest pitch thrown in his career.

LAST APPEARANCE (4/12 at SEA): worked a scoreless 1.1 innings Sunday at SEA, tossing 13 pitches (9 strikes) in another efficient outing...has made 4 appearances and pitched every other day for the Astros since his activation off the IL.

SLOW START: was activated off the 15-day IL (right knee strain) on April 6...suffered the knee injury early in camp, which did not get him into an official Spring Training game until March 20...began the season on the IL and made 4 minor league relief appearances, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings, before his activation.

2025 SEASON: was a strong contributor out of the Astros bullpen in the second half after signing an MLB contract on Aug. 7...recorded a 4.03 ERA (10 ER/22.1 IP) and 9.7 SO/9IP through 22 appearances with the Astros in 2025.
