BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles open their longest homestand of the year, a 10-game stretch against the Detroit Tigers (3 G), Tampa Bay Rays (3 G), and Toronto Blue Jays (4 G), tonight at Camden Yards...Baltimore went 1-5 on the last road trip at Washington (1-2) and Tampa Bay (0-3).

⚾ Baltimore led 3-1 entering the eighth inning before the Rays scored four runs to rally for the sweep...The Birds have been swept three times this year (also 5/1-4 at NYY & 4/3-5 at PIT).

⚾ **Shane Baz** allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings...He faced the minimum over his final four frames, including retiring the final 11 batters in a row.

⚾ **Pete Alonso** broke a 1-1 tie in the sixth inning with his ninth home run of the year...Later in the same frame, **Samuel Basallo** ripped his seventh homer of the season.

⚾ The Orioles have fallen a season-high eight games under .500.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .375/.412/.638 (30-for-80) with seven doubles, one triple, four homers, 13 runs scored, 14 RBI, and five walks in 23 games since April 20...Among players with at least 85 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in OPS (2nd, 1.050), batting average (3rd), slugging percentage (3rd), and on-base percentage (9th).

⚾ He's hit safely in 18 of his 21 games since April 22, including a career-high 10 straight from May 1-17...He's also scored a run in nine of 12 games since May 5.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (2nd, 47), times on base (3rd, 93), on-base percentage (3rd, .415), and doubles (T-3rd, 15).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ His 93 times on base are the third most in a players' first 49 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing Roberto Alomar (107 in 1996) and Frank Robinson (100 in 1966).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,011 total pitches this season, most in the majors ahead of WSH's James Wood (1,000) and NYY's Aaron Judge (975)...370 of those pitches have come in a 3-2 count, tied with LAA's Mike Trout for the most in the majors.

POLAR PETE: **Pete Alonso** is batting .274/.316/.548 (20-for-73) with five doubles, five home runs, 11 runs, 15 RBI, five walks, and one steal in 19 games this month...He entered May hitting .198/.306/.362 (23-for-116) with seven doubles, four homers, 17 runs, 13 RBI, 17 walks, and one steal in 31 games.

⚾ Alonso's four defensive runs saved are tied for the second most among MLB first basemen with ATL's Matt Olson and SD's Ty France, trailing MIN's Kody Clemens (5)...Last year, his -9 defensive runs saved ranked last among MLB first basemen.

⚾ He has three outs above average, tied for fourth among first basemen...He posted -9 outs above average in 2025, second worst in the majors by a first baseman ahead of COL's Michael Toglia (-10).

HOME COOKING: Baltimore is 12-12 at Oriole Park this season...Fourteen of the team's 24 home games have been decided by three runs or less with the O's going 6-8 in those...The Orioles have split all four homestands this season.

⚾ The Birds have hit .023 points better, slugged .046 higher, and have an OPS .064 points better at home this season compared to the road...All three of those differences rank 10th in the majors, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

LOUD CONTACT: In six games since May 15, the O's have recorded 52 batted balls hit at 100.0+ mph, tied for second most in the majors during that time with the Braves and Mets, trailing the Nationals (59)...**Pete Alonso**, **Jeremiah Jackson**, and **Gunnar Henderson** each have nine such batted balls during that period, tied for seventh in MLB.

⚾ Baltimore's 90.0 mph average exit velocity is tied with Texas for the second-best mark in the majors this season behind New York-AL (90.5 mph).

TERRIBLE TWOS: Oriole pitching has allowed opponents to slash .261/.360/.426 (148-for-566) and a .786 OPS with two outs...The batting average is second worst in the majors ahead of the Angels (.269), the on-base percentage is third worst in MLB ahead of the Angels (.369) and Astros (.365), and the .786 OPS is the second highest in the majors ahead of the Astros (.797).

⚾ Baltimore hurlers own a .555 opponent OPS with two strikes, the fourth-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.585), Houston (.579), and Washington (.573).

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: Oriole pitching has allowed opposing right-handed hitters to bat .287, the highest clip in MLB, with the next closest club being the Rockies (.271)...Opposing righties have also posted an .819 OPS, the highest mark in the majors with the next closest being the Astros (.779).

TAKING ON THE TIGERS: The Orioles and Tigers are meeting for their first of two series this season...Baltimore travels to Comerica Park for a three-game set from July 27-29.

⚾ The Birds have lost seven of the last eight games against the Tigers dating to September 21, 2024...Since the beginning of 2022, the O's are 10-15 (.400) against Detroit, the lowest winning percentage against an AL opponent during that time...Baltimore last won a series against the Tigers in 2023, when the club won three of four at Comerica Park from April 27-30 and swept a three-game set at Camden Yards from April 21-23.

⚾ **Keegan Akin** grew up a Tigers fan and attended Game 3 of the 2014 ALDS at Comerica Park when the Orioles completed the sweep.

⚾ **Trevor Rogers'** cousin, Cody Ross, was originally selected by Detroit in the fourth round of the 1999 First-Year Player Draft and made his MLB debut with the Tigers on July 4, 2003...Ross won the 2010 World Series with the Giants and was the NLCS MVP that year.

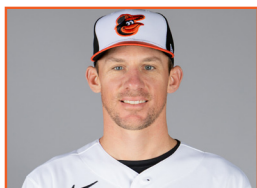

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his 10th appearance of the season and the 242nd of his career tonight...Reached 10 years of major-league service time earlier this month...Signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...He is one of seven major league pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons (2022-25)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Bassitt suffered his third loss of the season on May 16 at Washington after allowing four runs in 5.0 innings, scattering six hits (1 HR), one hit batter, and one walk with four strikeouts...Threw 82 pitches, 50 strikes...Marked his first career loss to the Nationals after earning the win in his previous three starts vs. the club (21.0 IP).

- 🔪 Snapped his season-high, three-game winning streak, which was his longest since a four-gamer from July 3-23, 2025.
- 🔪 Has allowed eight walks over his last five games (27.0 IP) since April 22 after yielding 11 over his first four games (16.0 IP) of the season.

DETROIT ROCK CITY: Bassitt is scheduled to make his 11th career start vs. Detroit, having gone 4-4 with a 3.88 ERA (26 ER/60.1 IP)...Has reached 6.0 innings in six of his last seven starts against the Tigers but hasn't faced them since July 19, 2024 (L, 6.2 IP, 5 R, 7 H, 2 HR, BB, HB, 6 K)...Has lost his last two decisions vs. the club following a three-game winning streak from June 27, 2018-September 7, 2019.

- 🔪 Is 14-12 with a 3.69 ERA (102 ER/249.0 IP) over 46 career games (43 GS) opposite the AL Central, including a 1-0 mark with a 4.35 ERA (5 ER/10.1 IP) in two starts this season...The 3.69 ERA is his lowest mark against any American League division.

WEAK CONTACT: Only five of Bassitt's 146 batted balls (3.4%) have been barreled this season...The 3.4 percent barrel rate is the lowest mark of his career (since tracking began in 2015) and ranks in the 90st percentile of MLB.

- 🔪 All five of his barreled balls have come on the road, including two on May 16 at Washington, two on April 22 at Kansas City, and one on April 5 at Pittsburgh.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: Bassitt holds a 9.4 percent walk rate this season, which is up 2.3 percent from 2025 (7.1%)...His 14.9 percent strikeout rate is also the lowest mark of his career and ranks in the bottom 10 percent of MLB...He owned a 22.6 percent strikeout rate last season, a 7.7 percent increase from this year.

- 🔪 However, owns a 6.7 percent walk rate and 19.3 percent strikeout rate over his last five games since April 22.

SINK OR SWIM: Opponents have gone 27-for-71 (.380) with three doubles and two home runs off his sinker, while whiffing at the offering only 14.4 percent of the time...The .380 opponent average on his sinker is the highest mark in MLB (min. 50 AB ending in pitch) ahead of STL's Matt Swanson (.367, 22-for-60).

- 🔪 Last season, the opposition hit .297 (86-for-290) with 18 doubles, seven home runs, and an 18.7 percent whiff rate on his sinker.

TO THE LEFT: Bassitt has allowed all 12 of his extra-base hits (8 2B, 4 HR) to lefties, who are slugging .529 against him compared to a .282 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP BRANDON YOUNG (3-1, 4.25)

LAST TIME OUT: Young didn't factor into the decision of a 7-3 O's win on May 17 at Washington after tossing a season-low 3.2 innings, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts...Left with the bases loaded in the fourth, after which **Anthony Nunez** recorded a strikeout to end the frame...Threw 70 pitches, 41 strikes.

vs. DETROIT: Young has made one career start opposite Detroit on April 26, 2025, and suffered the loss after allowing three runs on four hits and five walks in 4.2 innings pitched with six strikeouts...Is 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA (6 ER/14.0 IP) over three career starts vs. the AL Central, including a win at Chicago-AL on April 6 (5.0 IP, 0 R, 2 H, 2 BB, 2 K).

- Pitched in consecutive games for the first time this season from 5/4-5, his first two hitless outings of the year
- Has not thrown more than 1.0 inning this season...14 of his 64 appearances in 2025 were more than 1.0 inning, including five of 2.0 innings
