BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-day roadtrip (ARI-3, LAA-3) out of the All-Star break this evening when they play the middle game of a three-game series against the Los Angeles Angels in their first series visit to the Big A since 2024...the Cardinals dropped their 2nd consecutive game via walk-off last night to fall to 1-3 on the trip, losing three-straight since winning last Friday at Arizona...with a make-up game slated for this Thu. (July 23) at Busch Stadium vs. Arizona, the Cardinals are scheduled to play 20-straight days before their next open date on August 6.

LITTLE PLAY AT THE BIG A: The Cardinals are making just the fourth series visit in franchise history to Angel Stadium where they have now played 10 games all-time, their fewest among the ballparks that existed at the beginning of Interleague Play in 1997...the Cardinals 10 games in Anaheim will soon again match their fewest road games among all clubs...they have played just 9 games as the visitors against the Yankees in the Bronx, but have a 3-game series coming up in early August.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The Cardinals and Angels are meeting after the All-Star break for the first time, with their previous latest meeting into a season July 2-4, 2013 for a three-game set at Angel Stadium.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 11.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee, and 4.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are currently tied for the final NL Wild Card spot with Miami and Pittsburgh.

GAME TIME IS ON TIME: Beginning with Sunday's series finale in Arizona at 1:10 MT, the Cardinals will not repeat game times for nine consecutive games, playing at 7:10 PT, 6:38 PT and 1:07 PT here in Anaheim, followed by 4:15 CT, 7:15 CT, 6:15 CT, 1:15 CT and 6:45 CT starts when they return home this week.

WALKER STILL STREAKING: 2026 T-Mobile MLB HR Derby Champion & MLB RBI leader (76) **Jordan Walker** brings a career-best 22-game on-base streak & 11-game hitting streak into tonight's action...the on-base streak is tied for longest active streak in MLB...**Walker** is slashing .312/.407/.532 with .939 OPS, 4 HR & 18 RBI during on-base streak that began June 23.

JORDAN'S BLAZING RBI START: Rookie corner infielder **Blaze Jordan** made his 25th career start last night and delivered his 18th RBI via a 2nd inning ground out...**Jordan's** 18 RBI in 1st 25 career games started are the most among Cardinals rookies since **Albert Pujols** had 27 RBI in his 1st 25 starts as a rookie in 2001...including Blaze, there have only been 10 Cardinals rookies to have 18+ RBI in their 1st 25 games started...the last to do so prior to Pujols was **Brian Jordan** (18 in 1992)

BASH & DASH: JJ Wetherholt (14 HR) swiped his 10th stolen base last night to become the 9th Cardinals rookie to have a 10 HR/10 SB season and the 1st since **Masyn Winn** in 2024 (15 HR/11 SB)...**Jordan Walker** (22 HR), who picked up his career-high 14th steal last night, is trying to become the Cardinals 1st 20/20 player since **Tommy Pham** in 2017 (23 HR/25 SB)

Lars Nootbaar was born in and resides in El Segundo, CA...graduated from El Segundo High School...played three years at USC (2016-18).

Michael McGreevy was born in and resides in San Clemente, CA...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the Univ. of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).

JoJo Romero was born in Camarillo, CA...graduated from nearby Oxnard (CA) High School.

Kyle Leahy (May 14, 2024) earned his first MLB win against the Angels at Angel Stadium.

Nathan Church was born in Newport Beach, CA and resides in Coto de Caza, CA...won the California Interscholastic Federation Division I Championship with El Toro High School (Lake Forest, CA) in 2017...played college baseball at the University of California, Irvine (2020-22).

Justin Bruihl made his MLB debut vs. the Angels on Aug. 8, 2021 while with the LA Dodgers...played college baseball at California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

Gordon Graceffo and **Sam Aldegheri** were teammates on Team Italy in the 2026 WBC.

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Third Base Coach **Ron "Pop" Warner** was born in Alhambra, Calif...graduated from Redlands HS.

Reid Detmers was born in Nokomis, Ill...graduated from Glenwood III. High School...grew up a Cardinals fan...father **Kris Detmers** pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (1994-99), where he was teammates with **Stubby Clapp** and **Pop Warner**.

OF/Baserunning/QC Coach **Jon Jay** played in 5 games for LAA in 2021 in his final pro season.

Assistant Hitting Coach **Casey Chenoweth** played baseball at the MLB Urban Youth Academy in Compton, CA while attending Compton College from 2012-13.

Angels Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** served as the Cardinals pitching coach from 2018-22.

Angels Assistant Hitting Coach **John Mabry** played in 748 games for St. Louis from 1994-98, 2001, 04-05...served as the Cardinals assistant hitting coach in 2012 before being promoted to hitting coach from 2013-18...resides in St. Louis.

Hall of Famer **Tony La Russa** served as an executive with the Angels (2019-20).

Cardinals 2026 Hall of Fame inductee & Angels Special Assistant to the Club **Albert Pujols** played in 1,814 games for St. Louis from 2001-11, 2022, winning the World Series in 2006 & 2011, NL Rookie of the Year in 2001, and NL MVP in 2005, 08-09.

Cardenales broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played in eight seasons with the Angels (1998-2004) & won 2002 World Series...originally signed by the Angels as an non-drafted free agent (May 23, 1993).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** was born in Diamond Bar, CA...drafted by the Angels in the 7th round in 1988 ...played seven seasons with the Angels (1993-99), winning two Gold Gloves (1997-98) and was a 1995 AL All-Star...became a Cardinal via trade with the Angels (March 23, 2000), exchanged for **Kent Bottenfield** and **Adam Kennedy**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** is a Pomona, CA native...graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, CA and played college baseball at USC...resides in Southern California.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** graduated from Savanna High School in Anaheim...played college baseball at Fullerton (Calif.) College.

Former Cardinals personnel now with the Angels include **Phil Plantier**, **Joey Prebyski**, **Tony Ferreira**, **Dann Bilardello**, **Joe Kruzel**, **Chris Carpenter**, **Jobel Jimenez**, **Mike Gallego**, and **Matt Swanson**.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his team-leading 20th start of the season tonight. It marks his 140th career Major League appearance and his 73rd career start.
- Since May 1, ranks 1st among Cardinals pitchers & 7th among NL southpaws with 69 strikeouts. He ranks 2nd among NL qualifying LHP's with his 9.81 K/9 IP rate over that period among NL port-siders.
- Tied for 4th in the National League with three pick-offs; most by a Cardinals pitcher since **Lance Lynn** (4 in 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5 in 2005).
- Is the third Cardinals lefty with 21+ wins since 2000, joining **Jamie Garcia** (62-45) and **Mark Mulder** (22-18). His next win ties **Alex Jackson** (1966-67), **Jerry Reuss** (1969-71), **Ferdie Shupp** (1919-21), and **Mulder** (2005-08) for 34th all-time among Cardinals left-handed pitchers.
- According to *Baseball Savant*, Libby's curveball spin ranks in the 96th percentile. Opponents are hitting .141 (7-41) off his curveball this season. Boasts a 30.0% whiff on his curve (11th-best in MLB) and boasts an MLB-leading 51.1% K% on his curve.
- Sports a 5-6 record, but the Cardinals are 12-7 in his 19 starts this season, including a 7-3 mark in starts at Busch Stadium
- The Cardinals are 19-16 in his 35 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 13-11 with a 4.02 ERA (176.2 IP/79 ER) with 11 quality starts (all 11 starts with 6.0 IP or more).

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, July 11 vs. Atlanta): W, 4-1; 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 6 SO, 0 HR - 71 pitches

- Spun 6.0 scoreless frames while scattering four hits in a 4-1 win over the Braves at Busch Stadium.
- Recorded his 4th quality start and first since May 7 at San Diego, and it marked his first scoreless start of 6.0+ IP since June 29, 2025 at Cleveland (6.0).

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

JUST PEACHY: Fanned 9 batters, one shy of his career high, in a 5-3 win at Truist Park to earn his 20th career win on 6/30 at ATL.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Had his deepest start (5.1 IP) since a 6.0 inning effort on 5/7 at SD and led the Cardinals to a series win over the Cubs on NBC Sunday Night Baseball in his 5-1 win vs Chicago on 5/31.

K-CLUB: Libby notched single-game career highs for strikeouts in consecutive starts when he fanned 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and then he bettered that with 10 K's on Memorial Day (5/25) at MIL; He and Brewers starter Jacob Misorowski (12) combined for 22 strikeouts in the 5/25 game.

LIBBY & LEFTY: Recorded 38 strikeouts in May, the most by a Cardinals lefty in the month of May since Hall of Famer **Steve "Lefty" Carlton** fanned 52 in May, 1970.

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning Nick Castellanos in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win. Also allowed 3 HR's in his 6/13 start vs. the Twins at Target Field.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 18-27 with a 4.91 ERA (346.2 IP) in his 72 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

- Is making his 3rd career appearance and start against the Angels. **Owns a career mark of 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA (9.1 IP) and five strikeouts vs. the Halos.**
- Tossed a quality start on April 1, 2025 at Busch in a 9-7 loss to the Angels in 11 innings (6.0 IP, 3 R).
- Worked 3.1 IP at Angel Stadium in a start on May 13, 2024 and took a no-decision in the Cardinals 10-5 win.
- Owns a career mark of 6-14, 6.07 ERA in 38 career games (26 starts) in Interleague games
- Has a 4-14 mark in 26 career Interleague starts, although three wins have come on the road at Cleveland (2025), Chicago White Sox (2025), and Tampa Bay (2023).
