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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip tonight through Toronto (1-2) and New York-NL (2-0, 1 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-5 homestand, having been swept in a four-game set by the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Guardians...Baltimore is 3.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Texas (1.5 GB) and Toronto (2.0 GB) also in the mix.

- 🦅 **Coby Mayo** broke a 4-4 tie in the 11th inning with a three-run inside-the-park home run, the 26th such home run in franchise history (since 1954), including the first since Jorge Mateo on August 20, 2023 at Oakland...Mayo became the second Oriole to hit an inside-the-park home run in extra-innings, joining Austin Hays, who broke an 8-8 tie in the 10th inning at Philadelphia on August 11, 2020.
- 🦅 Oriole relievers combined to throw 7.0 innings in yesterday's victory, allowing two unearned runs...It marked the first time the O's bullpen covered at least 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run since April 3, 2023 at Texas (7.1 IP, 0 R)...Baltimore relievers have posted a 2.45 ERA since August 18, tied for the lowest mark in the majors during that period along with Cleveland.
- 🦅 Baltimore earned the victory despite striking out a season-high-tying 17 times (also 9/6 vs. BOS)...The O's have 10+ strikeouts in a season-high-tying six straight games (also 7/11-20)...They last did so in seven straight during a franchise-record 10-game stretch from August 30-September 10, 2025.
- 🦅 The Birds have won a franchise-record-tying four straight games against the Mets, joining August 19, 2015-August 14, 2018, and are 15-9 against New York since August 19, 2015, after losing nine straight from June 11, 2010-August 18, 2015.

- MR. 300:** Last night, **Pete Alonso** became one of 19 active players in the majors to reach 300 career home runs, led by NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (456) and LAA's Mike Trout (425).
- 🦅 According to *STATS Perform*, Alonso became the 10th fastest player to reach 300 career home runs at 1,160 games, trailing Aaron Judge (955 G), Ralph Kiner (1,087 G), Ryan Howard (1,093 G), Juan Gonzalez (1,096), Shohei Ohtani/Alex Rodriguez (both 1,117 G), Giancarlo Stanton (1,119 G), Harmon Killebrew (1,137 G), and Mark McGwire (1,148 G).
 - 🦅 Only Ralph Kiner (329) and Albert Pujols (319) have hit more home runs than Alonso through their first eight seasons in MLB history.
 - 🦅 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Alonso became the 20th player in MLB history to hit his 300th career home run against his former club...Andrew McCutchen was the last to accomplish the feat, homering at Philadelphia during his second stint with Pittsburgh on April 14, 2024.
 - 🦅 Alonso's 36 home runs this year are the sixth most by an Oriole in their first season with the club, trailing Frank Robinson (49, 1966), Mark Trumbo (47, 2016), Nelson Cruz (40, 2014), Mark Reynolds (37, 2011), and Albert Belle (37, 1999).

- COBY BEEF:** **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 19 straight games, slashing .290/.355/.609 (20-for-69) with one double, seven home runs, 14 runs, 16 RBI, and six walks.
- 🦅 It is the second-longest on-base streak by an Oriole this season, trailing Taylor Ward's 20-game run from July 1-27.
 - 🦅 Mayo's .573 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is second highest in the AL (min. 100 AB) behind TB's Victor Mesa Jr. (.593).
 - 🦅 Since August 31, he is 8-for-30 (.267) with four home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.
 - 🦅 Mayo is batting .324/.386/.734 (45-for-139) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.119) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole trailing Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

- MORE ON THE POLAR BEAR:** **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 101), total bases (3rd, 284), home runs (4th, 36), OPS (5th, .861), slugging percentage (5th, .499), extra-base hits (T-6th, 60), hits (7th, 152), and runs (8th, 90).
- 🦅 Alonso has started all 152 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with ATL's Matt Olson...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
 - 🦅 He's played in 568 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (934 G).
 - 🦅 Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (98) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
 - 🦅 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

- 'PEN PALS:** **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 18 games (16.0 IP) since August 6...The last Oriole to do so in 19 straight games in a single season was Zack Britton, who had a franchise-record-tying 25-game stretch from June 22-August 22, 2016.
- 🦅 Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

- PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 558 walks this season behind the Cubs (640 BB), Brewers (626 BB), and Dodgers (583 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 551 free passes.
- 🦅 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Birds look to lead the AL in walks for the seventh time in franchise history (since 1954), including for the first time since 1990.
 - 🦅 Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.

- NIP AND TUCK:** The Orioles are 50-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors with the Guardians...Their .495 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.
- 🦅 Baltimore is 17-22 in one-run games this year, but the O's are 7-4 in their last 11 such contests since August 14.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his 17th start (19th appearance) of the season...Signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.
⚡ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (low back discomfort) on June 8, retroactive to June 5, and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 17...Reinstated from the 60-day IL on August 14.
⚡ Reached 10 years of major-league service time in May.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on September 11 at Toronto after tossing 5.0 innings of two-run ball on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with five strikeouts...Threw 95 pitches, 64 strikes.
⚡ Has picked up the win in three of his last four games since August 25, the lone exception coming on September 5 vs. Boston (L).
⚡ Has allowed at least three walks in a career-high-tying three straight starts (3x, last: 4/24-5/5/23).

FAMILIAR FOE: Has made three career starts against New York-NL, going 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER/20.1 IP)...Has recorded a quality start in each of those outings with at least eight strikeouts.
⚡ As a member of the Mets in 2022, he went 6-6 with a 2.95 ERA (33 ER/100.2 IP) over 16 starts at Citi Field, 10 of which were quality starts...Hasn't allowed a run in two starts (14.1 IP) as a visitor.
⚡ His 0.44 ERA against the Mets is the lowest mark among active MLB pitchers (min. 20.0 IP) ahead of DET's Kyle Finnegan (1.32).

ATALE OF TWO PITCH TYPES: Hitters are slashing .198/.293/.293 (23-for-116) with five doubles, two homers, 10 walks, and 28 strikeouts off Bassitt's breaking balls (curve, sweeper, slider) compared to .343/.408/.500 (81-for-236) with 13 doubles, eight homers, 25 walks, and 38 strikeouts on his fastballs (sinker, cutter, four seamer).
⚡ Opponents are batting .125 (1-for-8) on his curveball with zero extra-base hits over two starts this month after hitting .292 (7-for-24) off it with two doubles and one home run over four starts in August.

TO THE LEFT: Bassitt has allowed 21 of his 29 extra-base hits (19 2B, 10 HR) this season to lefties, who are slugging .495 against him compared to a .344 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.
⚡ However, allowed two extra-base hits (2B, HR) to righties in his last start on September 11 at Toronto...Since August 30, right-handed hitters are slashing .325/.425/.559 (11-for-34) with four XBH (2 2B, 2 HR) off Bassitt after batting .248/.315/.282 with four doubles in 15 games (13 GS) from March 30-August 25.

WEAK CONTACT: Only 15 of Bassitt's 301 batted balls (5.0%) have been barreled this season...The 5.0 percent barrel rate is the second-lowest mark of his career (4.7%, 2015) and ranks in the 87th percentile of MLB.
⚡ His 87.7 mph average exit velocity ranks in the 72nd percentile of MLB while his 35.9 percent hard-hit rate ranks 71st.

U TURN: Over four road starts since returning from the Injured List, Bassitt is 3-0 with a 3.97 ERA (10 ER/22.2 IP).
⚡ He posted an 8.14 ERA (22 ER/24.1 IP) across his first six road starts of the season, allowing opponents to slash .353/.451/.569 (36-for-103) with seven doubles and five home runs.

MAKING THE ADJUSTMENT: The first time through the lineup, opponents are batting .326 (45-for-138) with eight doubles, five home runs, 18 walks, and a .906 OPS.
⚡ Those figures drop to .282 (40-for-142) with eight doubles, four home runs, 11 walks, and a .760 OPS the second time through, and .277 (23-for-83) with three doubles, one home run, seven walks, and a .704 OPS the third time around.

TIME OF THE SEASON: Bassitt is 30-20 with a 3.23 ERA (168 ER/468.0 IP) over 87 career appearances (79 GS) in the months of August and September compared to 60-49 with a 3.95 ERA (392 ER/892.1 IP) in 161 career games (153 GS) from March-July...He holds a 4.24 ERA (16 ER/34.0 IP) in six starts since August 14 after pitching to a 5.27 ERA (33 ER/56.1 IP) over his first 12 games (10 GS) of the year.
⚡ Held a 4.24 ERA (58 ER/123.0 IP) with a .274 opponent average (135-for-492) in his first 23 games (22 GS) last season from March-July...Recorded a 3.23 ERA (17 ER/47.1 IP) and .223 opponent average (39-for-175) in nine starts from August-September.
