TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Royals play the final game of this three-game series...SF is 9-15 all-time against the Royals during regular season play, and secured just their second series victory in nine sets with a win last night (other series win: June 13-15, 2022, won series 2-1)...these teams are meeting at Kauffman Stadium for the first time since April 2017.

- ▶ The Giants earned their 10th shutout win of the season last night and second in their last five games.
- ▶ SF has won three of their last five series.

GOING FOR THE SWEEP: The Giants can sweep the Royals with a win today after taking the first two games of this three-game series...the Giants have never swept the Royals in a series in their brief head-to-head history.

- ▶ The last time the Giants swept any series of three games or more from an American League opponent came back in 2022 when they took a three-game set from the Cleveland Guardians from April 15-17 at Progressive Field.
- ▶ SF is trying to sweep its third series of the season...the only two sweeps the Giants have completed this year have both come against the Rockies (a three-game set at Oracle in May and a four-game set at Oracle in July).

LAST LEG COMING UP: SF is 4-1 to begin their final road trip of the year, a nine-game stretch at Baltimore (2-1), Kansas City (2-0) and Arizona.

- ▶ Following this series against the Royals, the Giants will travel to Arizona for a three-game series against the Diamondbacks starting tomorrow night...it'll be SF's final three road games of the season before wrapping up the 2024 campaign with three at home against the St. Louis Cardinals.
- ▶ The Giants enter today having won six of their last seven road games.

TELL IT GOODBYE!: Last night, **OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** and **IF Matt Chapman** became the first set of Giants teammates with multiple home runs in a game since June 11, 2023 vs. Chicago-NL (Thairo Estrada and Joc Pederson).

- ▶ Wade recorded his second career multi-homer game while Chapman did it for the 12th time in his career.

ROAD CHALLENGES: The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter today with a 35-42 (.455) road record...the .455 road winning percentage is 20th of 30 MLB clubs and is the fifth-lowest in the NL ahead of Colorado (.300), Miami (.360), Washington (.413) and Pittsburgh (.442).

- ▶ However, SF has won each of its last three road series which have all come against teams currently in playoff position...the Giants took two-of-three from San Diego September 6-8, secured a series win at Baltimore to begin this nine-game road trip and have taken the first two games of this series against the Royals.

TODAY'S STARTER: **LHP Blake Snell** will make his 20th start of the season today...Snell was 0-3 with a 9.51 ERA (25er, 23.2ip) in his first six starts of the season, however since then he's been the best pitcher in baseball, logging a 4-0 record with a 1.33 ERA (11er, 74.1ip) and 105 strikeouts in his last 13 starts since July 9.

- ▶ Snell's 1.33 ERA over his last 13 starts is the best ERA for any pitcher in a 13-start span this season (*Sports Info Solutions*).
- ▶ The last Giants starter to have a 13-start run with that low an ERA was **Kevin Gausman** in 2021 (1.32) (*Sports Info Solutions*).

STARTING STRONG: Giants starting pitchers have limited opponents to three earned runs or fewer in each of their last 13 games, posting a 2.47 ERA (18er, 65.2ip) in that stretch.

- ▶ Opponents are just 18-for-113 (.159) vs. the Giants' starters over the last six games.
- ▶ SF starters have not allowed a run in their last 11.2 innings.

WALK THE LINE: **RHP Ryan Walker** suffered his fourth loss of the season Thursday after allowing a walkoff two-run home run to Baltimore's Anthony Santander in the 9th inning...it was the first home run Walker had allowed on the road ALL season and the first earned runs he'd allowed in a game since July 27.

- ▶ Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, Walker has converted all eight of his save opportunities while allowing just three runs (2er) in 16.2 innings...he's struck out 27 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .153 (9-for-59).
- ▶ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed four earned runs in 26.2 innings for a 1.35 ERA in 25 games...his 1.35 ERA since the break is tied for the sixth-best among relievers.

GOING FOR 20: With a stolen base today, **IF Tyler Fitzgerald** will have 20 stolen bases and 15 home runs (currently has 16) in the first 100 games of his career...the only shortstops to achieve that feat in the modern era are Bobby Witt Jr. and Fernando Tatis Jr. (*Stats, LLC*).

CITY BY THE BLAKE: The reigning NL Cy Young will make his 20th start for SF...Snell joined SF late in the spring on a two-year, \$62 million contract (includes an opt out after the 2024 season).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win in as many outings, tossing 6.0 innings of shutout ball with just one hit and two walks allowed while striking out 12...it was Snell's fifth double-digit strikeout game of the season and the 35th of his career.

VS. KANSAS CITY: Snell will make his fifth career start against the Royals, and his first since 2019...this is only the second time in his career he's pitching here at Kauffman Stadium (also 5/1/19).

- He is 1-3 with a 7.27 ERA (14er, 17.1ip) in four starts with a .347 opposing batting average, 1.85 WHIP, 18 strikeouts and a .988 opposing OPS.

- Two Royals have 10+ at-bats vs. Snell in their careers (including Postseason)...IF Yuli Guerriel is 7-for-24 (.292) with three doubles, two RBI and four strikeouts vs. Snell while IF Garrett Hampson is 2-for-16 (.125) with six strikeouts and a triple.

A NEW MAN: Since returning from the IL on July 9, Snell is 4-0 with a 1.33 ERA (11er, 74.1ip), 105 strikeouts, a 0.81 WHIP and a .124 opposing batting average over that span...prior to this stretch, Snell was 0-3 with a 9.51 ERA (25er, 23.2ip), 31 strikeouts and a 1.94 WHIP in six starts.

- His 1.33 ERA over his last 13 games is the lowest ERA by a Giant in a 13-game span since **RHP Kevin Gausman** had a 1.32 ERA from April 19-June 29, 2021 (min. 70.0ip).

- Snell has 90 strikeouts over his last 10 starts (since July 27), which is the most by a Giant since **RHP Tim Lincecum** struck out 93 from June 23-August 12, 2009.

- Below is a chart of where Snell ranks in MLB since July 1.

GOTTA GET AHEAD: Opponents are slashing .124/.199/.183 with a .382 OPS in at-bats in which he gets ahead 0-1 in the count...when Snell falls behind 1-0, opponents are slashing .272/.403/.447 with an .850 OPS.

SOFT CONTACT: Snell's has an opposing hard-hit rate of 28.1%, which is in the top 1% of the Majors...when bringing the filter to a minimum of 200 batted ball events, Snell's 28.1% hard hit rate is the lowest in MLB.

CURVE IT: Opponents are hitting .119 (14x118) against Snell's curveball with 63 strikeouts this season...Snell has thrown 340 curveballs since returning from the IL on July 9, holding opponents 11-for-94 (.117) with 50 strikeouts and 84 swing and misses...the Royals have a .515 OPS against left-handed curveballs, which is 26th in MLB.

CHANGE IT UP: The lefty's changeup has been very good over the last month, with 11 strikeouts and one hit in 14 at-bats across his last two outings...over Snell's last four starts, opponents are 2-for-25 (.080) with 14 strikeouts and zero extra-base hits against his changeup...the Royals have a .719 OPS against left-handed changeups, which is seventh-best in MLB.

FAST TIMES: Snell's four-seam fastball, which he's thrown 46.3% of the time, has a .197 opposing batting average (27x137) with 41 strikeouts and a .307 slugging percentage...in his last 13 starts, however, opponents are 10-for-96 (.104) with one extra-base hit (a double) and 32 strikeouts.

BLAKKKKKKKE: His five double-digit strikeout games this year are tied for fourth-most in the Majors...ATL's Chris Sale, CWS' Garrett Crochet and LAD's Tyler Glasnow are all tied for first with six...Snell's 35 career 10+ strikeout games are ninth-most among active players

NO-NO REVISTED: His no-hitter on August 2 was the 18th in Giants franchise history and first since **RHP Chris Heston** tossed one on June 9, 2015 at the Mets.

- Snell is the fifth left-handed pitcher to throw a no-no in Giants history joining **George Wiltse**, **Rube Marquard**, **Carl Hubbell** and **Jonathan Sánchez**.

- According to *Sarah Langs* via *Elias*, Snell became the fifth reigning Cy Young winner to throw a no-hitter...the other four are Jake Arrieta (2016), Clayton Kershaw (2014), Bob Gibson (1971) and Sandy Koufax (1964).
