**TONIGHT ON FOX:** Tonight's game vs. Cardinals will be exclusively televised on FOX with Jason Benetti and Eric Karros on the call from Chase Field.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 7-3 last night vs. Cardinals for their second straight win.

- 8 of the 9 D-backs starters recorded a hit.
- **Brandon Pfaadt** (0 ER in 7.0 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 6 K) tossed his third scoreless start and second straight without a walk...he is the first D-back with 10+ wins in the first 20 starts of a season since Zac Gallen in 2023 (11 W).
- **Jose Herrera** extended his hitting streak to a career-high 5 games and has a RBI in 4 straight games.
- **Adrian Del Castillo**, in his first game of the season, went 3-for-4 with 1 RBI for his third career 3-hit game.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had his fifth game with 2+ hits and 2+ RBI, including his second triple.
- **Andrew Saalfrank** tossed 1.0 scoreless inning in his first home appearance since April 29, 2024 vs. Dodgers.

**SNAKEBITES:** D-backs' hitters vs. right-handed pitching have combined for an MLB-best .459 SLG [league AVG: .406], ahead of the Yankees (.451), Cubs (.451) and Dodgers (.441), while their 255 extra-base hits also lead the Majors, ahead of the Athletics (251) and Cubs (246).

- **Corbin Carroll**, when ahead in the count, has an MLB-best 1.950 OPS [league AVG: 1.108], ahead of James Wood/WSH (1.818), Aaron Judge/NYY (1.782), Bryce Harper/PHI (1.781), Cal Raleigh/SEA (1.776) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (1.598).
- **Eugenio Suarez**, when behind in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2) has an MLB-best 12 homers [league AVG: 2.3], ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (11), Francisco Lindor/NYM (10), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (10) and Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (10).
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, when behind in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2) has reached 58 times [league AVG: 17.4], tied for the most in the Majors with Luis Arráez/SD and Bobby Witt Jr/KC.

**VS. CARDINALS:** **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 9 games vs. Cardinals, has hit .333 (9-for-27)/.455 OBP/.519 SLG/.973 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 3 RBI and 4 walks.

- **Randal Grichuk**, in his 3 games @ Cardinals this season, hit .500 (3-for-6)/1.167 SLG with 1 double, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 1 walk.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 4 straight games... in his last 9 games, has hit .333 (13-for-39) with 1 double, 1 homer and 6 RBI.
- **Jake McCarthy**, in his last 6 games, has hit .389 (7-for-18) with 1 double, 1 RBI and 2 walks.

**RECENT 'PEN:** D-backs relievers, in their last 11 games since July 4, are fifth in the Majors with a 2.65 ERA (10 ER in 34.0 IP) and are scoreless in 7 of the 11 games.

- The D-backs bullpen's 3.14 ERA is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87).

**STARTING PITCHING TREND:** Since July 7 (8 G), D-backs' starting pitchers combined 3.52 ERA (18 ER in 46.0 IP) is fifth lowest in the NL, behind the Brewers (1.42), Cubs (2.59), Phillies (2.95) and Padres (3.51).

- **VS. OPPOSING STARTERS:** Opposing starting pitchers have lasted fewer than 6.0 innings vs. D-backs in 5 straight games, tied for the second longest active MLB streak with the Tigers, Braves and Guardians, behind the Angels (6).
- In those 5 games vs. starters, the D-backs are hitting .317 (33-for-104)/.906 OPS with 10 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 12 walks (15 K).
- Since July 1, the D-backs' offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among the NL in runs (1st, 40), times on base (1st, 108), walks (1st, 38), pitches seen (1st, 1,245), doubles (T-1st, 18 with Braves), OBP (2nd, .329), extra-base hits (2nd, 30), SLG (3rd, .423) and OPS (3rd, .752).

**AFTER ONE TIME THRU:** From the second time thru the order on, the D-backs lead the Majors in SLG (.461), OPS (.799) and homers (114), and are second in runs (413).

**NO PLACE LIKE CHASE:** **Josh Naylor** has reached base safely in 23 of his last 25 home games since May 8, hitting .333 (31-for-93)/.906 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 19 RBI, 8 walks (9 K) and 2 stolen bases.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in a season-long 8 straight home games (since June 29), batting .281 (9-for-32)/.917 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 5 RBI.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 11 straight home games (since June 27), hitting .385 (15-for-39)/.520 OBP/.538 SLG/1.058 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 9 walks (5 K).
- **Jake McCarthy** has reached base safely in 11 straight home games (since April 9), hitting .286 (10-for-35)/.543 SLG/.902 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers, 7 RBI, 3 walks, 1 hit-by-pitch and 2 stolen bases.

**HOW HE STARTED:** D-backs’ second-round pick (No. 56) in the 2019 draft.

- Named D-backs’ 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1 IP) with 163 strikeouts (T-4th in MiLB) over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo.
- Attended the University of Oregon...as a junior in 2019, was First-Team All-Pac-12, led the conference with 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Making his 11th start (sixth @ home).

- In his last 6 starts, is 3-0 (team is 5-1) with a 2.43 ERA (10 R-9 ER in 33.1 IP), opponent .203 AVG/.339 SLG, 1.02 WHIP and 27 strikeouts.
- In 5 home starts, is 3-1 with a 1.52 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 29.2 IP), opponent .208 AVG, 0.91 WHIP, 5 walks and 21 strikeouts.
- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 8 of his 10 starts.
- Dating back to July 31, 2023 in 8 July starts (5 quality), has gone 4-0 with a 2.88 ERA (16 ER in 50.0 IP), opponent .216 AVG, 1.04 WHIP and 37 strikeouts...the D-backs are 7-1 in those starts and have outscored their opponents 60-23.
- Since 2022, his 16 starts of 6.0+ innings with 90 pitches or fewer are the most by a D-back starter.

**LAST START:** Took a no decision on July 11 @ Angels (4 ER in 4.0 IP).

**VS. CARDINALS:** Third career start (all @ Chase Field).

- Posted a quality start in his last start on April 13, 2024, allowing just 1 run on 7 hits over 6.0 innings with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.
- In 2 career starts, is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER in 12.0 IP), 4 walks and 5 strikeouts.

**VS. NL CENTRAL @ HOME:** in his last 2 home starts, is 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER in 12.2 IP), opponent .224 AVG, 0.95 WHIP, 1 walk and 8 strikeouts.

- In 4 career starts (team is 3-1), is 2-0 with a 3.27 ERA (8 ER in 22.0 IP), 7 walks and 12 strikeouts.

**FREE PASSES ARE LIMITED:** Has not allowed a walk in 3 of his 5 home starts (112 BF).
