FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals are playing the second of a three-game series against the Houston Astros tonight at Minute Maid Park. The Cardinals are coming to the end of a season-long nine-game/10-day road trip through Cincinnati (2-1), Philadelphia (1-2) and Houston (0-1). Following tomorrow afternoon's matinee, the team will fly back to St. Louis to begin a seven-game homestand against the Colorado Rockies (June 6-9) and Pittsburgh Pirates (June 11-13).

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals fell to the Houston Astros 7-4 last night in their first game at Minute Maid Park since 2016. St. Louis held leads of 3-2 and 4-3, but Houston rallied with two home runs in the 8th inning and four runs total. **Nolan Gorman** hit a pair of home runs (#13) and **Alec Burleson** homered for the second time in as many games (#7). St. Louis has lost three of their last four games, but are 3-4 on this current road trip and are currently tied for 2nd place in the National League Central with the Chicago Cubs (29-31) with a .483 winning percentage.

LOUTOS OPTIONED; ROYCROFT RECALLED: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals optioned RHP **Ryan Loutos** to Memphis (AAA) and recalled RHP **Chris Roycroft** from Memphis. Roycroft will be making his 3rd trip to St. Louis this season and was 1-0 with an 0.98 ERA and two saves in 14 appearances down in the delta.

STORMIN' NOLAN GORMAN: Cardinals second baseman **Nolan Gorman** has been on a tear this road trip smacking five home runs over six games. The torrid start began in Cincinnati and continued on through Houston last night where he connected for his 8th career multi-home run game and his 2nd of the season (Apr. 7 vs. Miami). The 24-year old slugger with 13 home runs, 8th in the league in slugging (.494) and 2nd in AB/HR (13.69). Gorman is tied with Astros' third baseman **Alex Bregman** to lead all of MLB with five home runs since May 28.

CLUSTER BOMBS: Cardinals **Alec Burleson** and **Nolan Gorman** have each homered on consecutive days for the Cardinals marking the first time this season that has happened and the first time since May 14-15, 2023 when **Nolan Arenado** and **Andrew Knizner** each homered in Boston at Fenway Park on May 14 and at home vs. Milwaukee on May 15. -Orf

OPENING WHACKED: The Cardinals homered twice in the 1st inning last night for the first time since Aug. 15, 2023, when **Nolan Arenado** and **Jordan Walker** homered in the opening frame against Oakland at Busch Stadium.

NATURE IS A MOTHER: Since a win over Milwaukee on Mother's Day, May 12, the St. Louis Cardinals own the best record in the National League at 13-6 and have only lost consecutive games once, three days ago in Philadelphia (May 31-June 1). St. Louis has also smacked the most home runs in the National League over that period with 27, trailing only the Yankees (38), Astros (32) and Orioles (29) among American League teams.

ANDRE'S A GIANT: Entering tonight's start, pitcher **Andre Pallante** has run off 17.0 consecutive scoreless innings as a starting pitcher dating back to July 26, 2022 in Toronto. Pallante allowed three runs in the first inning of a start against the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre, then threw three scoreless innings to finish that outing. Five days later on July 31, 2022, he hurled a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings at Nationals Park against Washington and last Wednesday, held the Reds scoreless through 6.0 innings. Pallante made 90 relief appearances between starts in Washington and Cincinnati (6-3, 4.50 ERA, 104 IP).

CRAWFORD STREET: Entering tonight's game, Cardinals shortstop **Brandon Crawford** holds the longest active hit streak against the Astros among current players. Crawford is currently on a 14-game hit streak against the 'Stros dating back to May 12, 2015, with his last game against them on August 1, 2021. **Ryan Klesko** holds the all-time longest hitting streak against the Astros, hitting safely in 29 straight games from 1999-2002 with the Braves and Padres. The Cardinals record is held by **Lou Brock** with 20 games from 1968-69, 6th longest in history.

GOLD-RUSH: **Paul Goldschmidt** extended his on-base streak to 20 games last night with a 3rd inning double inning single. The 20-game streak is currently the 6th-longest active in MLB. Goldschmidt is five shy of the Cardinals mark for this season with 25 held by **Nolan Arenado**. The career-long for Goldschmidt is 46 games with the Cardinals in 2022. This is currently the 9th-longest of his career and 3rd-longest as a Cardinal.

HOUSTON CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt graduated from The Woodlands (Tex.) High School...grew up a fan of **Jeff Bagwell** and **Craig Biggio**...as a high school senior, was seated in the center field upper deck at Minute Maid Park when **Albert Pujols** hit the famous home run off Astros closer **Brad Lidge** in Game 5 of the 2005 NLCS...played college baseball at Texas State University (2007-09) in San Marcos, Tex. where he left as the school's all-time leader in home runs (36) and RBI (178)...his No. 37 was retired in Feb. 2015, becoming the first TSU baseball player to have his jersey retired.

Paul Goldschmidt and **Nolan Arenado** were teammates with **Alex Bregman** on the gold-winning USA squad in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Kyle Tucker and **Ryan Pressly** were teammates with Goldschmidt, Arenado, **Miles Mikolas**, and **Adam Wainwright** on the USA squad in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Matt Carpenter was born in Galveston, Tex... graduated from Elkins High School in Prosper, Tex... played college baseball at Texas Christian University...resides in Glen Rose, Tex.

Masyn Winn was born in Katy, Tex...graduated from Kingwood (Tex.) High School in 2020...resides in Kingwood, Tex.

John King was born in Laredo, Tex...graduated from Clements (Tex.) High School...played college baseball at Angelina College in Lufkin, Tex. before transferring to the University of Houston...resides in Grand Prairie, Tex.

First Base Coach **Stubby Clapp** worked five seasons (2007-12) in the Astros organization, serving as hitting coach for A-Lexington for three seasons (2007-09), one season as hitting coach for Double-A Corpus Christi (2010), and taking on his first managerial role with short-season Tri-City for two seasons (2011-12).

Giovanny Gallegos made his MLB debut (with the Yankees) against Houston on May 12, 2017 at Yankee Stadium...his first strikeout victim was Houston's Brian McCann (swinging) on May 14, 2017.

Astros Quality Assurance Coach **Jason Bell** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Parkway Central High School...earned college baseball at Saint Louis Univ. and the Univ. of Central Missouri.

Astros Manager **Joe Espada** played in eight games for Triple-A Memphis in 2003.

Jeremy Peña is the son of **Gerónimo Peña**, who played six seasons with the Cardinals (1990-95).

Asst. Hitting Coach **Brandon Allen** was born in Conroe, Tex...graduated from Montgomery (Tex.) High School...earned football scholarship to Rice University as a linebacker/defensive end and a baseball scholarship at the University of Houston.

Astros Community Outreach Exec. **José Cruz** played five seasons with St. Louis (1970-74).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Making his 2nd start of the season and 12th career. It's his 1st career start against the Astros and his 1st career appearance at Minute Maid Park.
- Has a 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter dating back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP last Wed. (5/29) in start at CIN.
- Is 4-3, 3.58 ERA in 11 career starts (60.1 IP/24 ER) and 2-2, 3.73 ERA (31.1 IP/13 ER) in six career road starts.
- Was recalled 5/26 from Memphis (AAA), and last Wed. (5/29), made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington.
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option on April 21.
- Has recorded a 62.3% ground ball percentage in 2024 in Major Leagues, 2nd only to John King (63.6%-4th NL) among Cardinals pitchers, and 7th in NL (min. 15.0 IP).
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Since his 7/31/22 start at WSH, was 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA over 90 relief appearances with 19 Holds and 63 strikeouts over 104.0 innings pitched. Leads Cardinals with 90 appearances since his 7/31/22 start at WSH. Giovanni Gallegos ranks 2nd with 89.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 100 vs. PHI on July 10, 2022.
- Has been known as a reverse split pitcher holding left-handed batters to a .236 opponent BA as opposed to .320 vs. right-handed batters. Continuing that trend in 2024 with lefties batting .200 (8-40, 1 XBH) and .391 vs. righties (9-23, HR).

LAST TIME OUT

- Making his 1st MLB start since 2022, threw 6.0 scoreless innings last Wed. (5/29) against the Reds at Great American Ball Park for a 5-3 win. Threw a season-high 86 pitches (both Memphis & St. Louis) and did not allow a hit until the 4th inning.

- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Was the only player from the Cardinals non-roster invite list to make the Opening Day roster in 2022. Made the Opening Day roster in St. Louis each year from 2022-24.
- Pitched over 50.0 innings as both a starting pitcher and relief pitcher during the 2022 season, making him one of two pitchers in MLB to do so in that season along with Nick Martinez (SD). Was the first Cardinals rookie pitcher since John Urrea in 1977 to accomplish the feat and the first rookie in MLB since Hisanori Takahashi for the New York Mets in 2010.
- Ranked 3rd among National League rookies with 108.0 innings in 2022.
- Led all MLB rookies with 17 ground into double plays in 2022.
- Finished the 2021 Arizona Fall League season with 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings. Named an Arizona Fall League All-Star with a 1.29 ERA, 2nd in the league.

2024

- Made nine relief appearances in St. Louis after making the Opening Day roster before getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Took his only loss on 4/10 vs. PHI while not recording an out, the only time in his 118 career appearances in which he did not record an out.
- Recorded his one Hold of the season at LAD (3/31) allowing a home run (his only home run allowed this season) to Teoscar Hernandez, as the Cardinals fell to the Dodgers, 5-4.
