YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles beat the Guardians, 4-2, to snap a five-game losing streak Cedric Mullins hit a go-ahead solo home run in the seventh inning...Gunnar Henderson and Ryan O'Hearn also homered...Grayson Rodriguez became the fifth MLB pitcher with at least nine wins this season after allowing two runs, both on solo homers, over 7.0 innings...Last night was the 23rd game this year in which the 0's hit at least three home runs in a game, eight more than any other team.

ALL-STAR VOTING: MLB announced the second balloting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game this past Monday...The 2024 MLB All-Star Ballot is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App, and the MLB Ballpark App...Voting for Phase 1 concluded today at 12 p.m. ET...The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6 p.m. tonight, and will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who starts for each league...As of the second update, an MLB-high-tying six Orioles are on pace to advance to Phase 2 (see box at right), while three are leading their positions; the Orioles have not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014.

- Adley Rutschman leads AL catchers and ranks third in the AL with 1,638,425 votes; seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment; would become the third 0's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry Kennedy in 1987; Matt Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury). Gunnar Henderson leads AL shortstops with 1,551,124 votes; vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since Manny Machado in 2018. Rvan Mountcastle leads AL first basemen with 1,602,777 votes having.
- **Ryan Mountcastle** leads AL first basemen with 1,400,373 votes, having overtaken Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (1,338,688) since the first update; seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first 0's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Chris Davis**
- Jordan Westburg ranks second among AL third basemen with 846,352 votes, trailing Cleveland's Jose Ramírez (1,426,755); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.

  Anthony Santander and Colton Cowser are each seeking their first All-Star selections;
- Santander ranks fifth among AL outfielders with 808,100 votes, while Cowser ranks sixth with 649,710 votes.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 132 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (118) and Dodgers (111)...The Birds have homered in 24 of the last 25 games, including a club-record 22 consecutive games from June 1-23.

The 132 homers are the most through 80 games in team history; Baltimore is the 11th team since at least 1901 with 132+ home runs in the first 80 games of a season and the first since

- Atlanta hit 147 last season.
- Atlanta nit 14/1 ast season. The 0's are 43-20 this year when homering, 34-6 when hitting multiple home runs, 18-5 when hitting at least three, and 4-2 when hitting four. Baltimore has an MLB-best seven players with at least 10 home runs: Gunnar Henderson (26), Anthony Santander (21), Adley Rutschman (14), Jordan Westburg (13), Ryan Mountcastle (11), and Colton Cowser and Ryan O'Hearn (10); no other team has more than five such players this season.
- Henderson and Santander are one of two duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this
- renterestrial danical read are one of two duos in NLB with a teast 20 homers each so fail this season (CLE's José Ramírez and Josh Naylor).

  The O's lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

- TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks second in MLB with 26 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (30)...He's among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

  O>> Henderson owns a career-best 33-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an O's batter since Nick Markakis' 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009, and the longest by a batter 23 years old or younger in Orioles history.

  O>> He leads MLB with 70 runs scored this season; that is the most runs through the first 80 team games of a season in O's history.

  - games of a season in 0's history.

    Through 80 team games, he's the third-fastest in 0's history to 26 home runs in a season behind **Chris Davis** (73 G, 2013) and **Brady Anderson** (73 G, 1996).

    Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an 0's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

SUMMER SLUGGER: Anthony Santander leads MLB with 12 home runs this month, tied for the in the month of June in Orioles history with **Boog Powell** (1964), **Rafael Palmeiro** (1998), **Albert Belle** (2000), and **Chris Davis** (2013)...He is the first Oriole with at least 12 home runs in a month since **Manny Machado** in August of 2017 (also 12)...Trails only **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961), **Nelson Cruz** (13 in May 2014), and **Frank Robinson** (13 in July 1966) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Orioles

Santander's 82 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Álvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (129).

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles need one win in their next four games to clinch a winning record in June... With a 17-9 record in May, the 0's have been above .500 in eight consecutive full months since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the team (min. 10 games played in the month) since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors; Atlanta had its streak of 11 straight winning months since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand with the four-game series opener against the Rangers...The final two games will be nationally televised, with Saturday on FOX's Baseball Night in America and Sunday on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, this will be Baltimore's 35th appearance on Sunday Night Baseball (15-19).

AGAINST TEXAS: The Orioles and Rangers meet for the first time since the 2023 ALDS this weekend with four games at Oriole Park...Baltimore travels to Texas for a three-game series immediately after the All-Star break from July 19-21...Since the start of 2021, the 0's are 13-6 against the Rangers, including a perfect 6-0 in 2022...Texas swept the ALDS in three games against the 0's last year, winning the first two games at Oriole Park, on the way to the franchise's first World Series title.

SCORING CHANGE: In the top of the fifth inning on June 20 at New York-AL, Jordan Westburg reached base on what was originally ruled an error on second baseman Gleyber Torres...This has been changed to a single, giving the 0's their 42<sup>nd</sup> 20-hit game in team history (since 1954) and the first since July 6, 2023 at New York-AL.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the 0's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 365 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 17th start of the season tonight against the Rangers...Texas is the only team Burnes has never faced in his career... Burnes' 2.35 ERA (26 ER/99.2 IP) is the 11th lowest for an Orioles starting pitcher through his first 16 starts to begin a season and the lowest since Jim Palmer in 1978 (1.81)...His ERA is the second lowest by an 0's starting pitcher through his first 15 starts to begin his Orioles career in team history (since 1954)...The Orioles are 11-5 in his starts this year...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Dealt the loss on June 22 at Houston after allowing a season-high four runs on five hits (2 HR) with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings...The two home runs are his most surrendered since September 4, 2023 at Pittsburgh (w/MIL)...Did not allow a walk for the first time since April 3 vs. Kansas City... Tossed 7.0 innings for the fifth time this year...Snapped his five-game winning streak and his career-high streak of 10 consecutive quality starts...Threw 90 pitches, 61 strikes.

AGAINST THE RANGERS AND THE AL WEST: Slated to make his first career appearance against the Rangers...Will be making his eighth career start against the AL West and fifth of the season; had faced the division a total of four times prior to this year...Has made a start against every AL West opponent but Texas this season...Owns a lifetime 4-2 record with a 2.98 ERA (14 ER/42.1 IP) across eight appearances (7 GS) against the division...AL West opponents are slashing .172/.207/.368 (15-for-87) off him this year.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest streak in the majors this year and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 12 quality starts on the season are tied for the third most in MLB and his 51 quality starts since the start of 2022 are the second most...His 13 games of at least 6.0 innings are two behind the MLB lead entering today.

<u>NEW BEGINNINGS:</u> Burnes began his Orioles career with 15 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings and three-or-fewer runs allowed...The 15 consecutive outings was the longest such streak to begin a pitcher's career with the Orioles all-time.

**EARLY STRUGGLES:** After allowing five first-inning runs across his first six starts to open the season, Burnes has not allowed one since his outing on April 26 vs. Oakland...Four of those first inning runs have come via solo home runs; the four first-inning homers allowed are tied for the ninth most in MLB.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 36 strikeouts away from 1,000.

**INNINGS EATER:** The 662.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank second in MLB behind Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (680.1 IP)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
