also homered...Grayson Rodriguez became the fifth MLB pitcher with at least nine wins this season after allowing two runs, both on solo homers, over 7.0 innings...Last night was the $23^{\text {rd }}$ game this year in which the O's hit at least three home runs in a game, eight more than any other team.

ALL-STAR VOTING: MLB announced the second balloting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game this past Monday...The 2024 MLB All-Star Ballot is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App, and the MLB Ballpark App...Voting for Phase concluded today at 12 p.m. ET...The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6 p.m. tonight, and will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who starts for each league....As of the second update, an MLB-high
tying six Orioles are on pace to advance to Phase 2 (see box at right) while three are leading the positions; the Orioles have not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014
$\theta_{s}$ Adley Rutschman leads AL catchers and ranks third in the AL with $1,638,425$ votes: seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment; would become the third 0's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry Kennedy in 1987; Matt Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).
O. Gunnar Henderson leads AL shortstops with $1,551,124$ votes; vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since Manny Machado in 2018
O. Ryan Mountcastle leads AL first basemen with $1,400,373$ votes, having overtaken Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. $(1,338,688)$ since the first update; seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Chris Davis

oran Westburg ranks second among AL third basemen with 846,352 votes, trailing Ceveland's Jose Ramirez (1,426,755); seeking his first All-Star nod and would b
Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016 .
O. Anthony Santander and Colton Cowser are each seeking their first All-Star selections; Santander ranks fifth among AL outfielders with 808,100 votes, while Cowser ranks sixth with 649,710 votes.
WHAT'S TRENDING: At $50-30(.625)$, the Birds own the fourth-best record in MLB, behind the Yankees (.634, 52-30), Guardians (.654, 51-27), and Phillies (.663, 53-27)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 151-91(.624), the best winning percentage and tied for the most wins in the majors with the Dodgers... MLB behind the Astros (.584, 236-168), Braves (.619, 249-153), and Dodgers (.645, 262-144).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 132 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (118) and Dodgers (111)...The Birds have

. The O's lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; Gunnar Henderson has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with Cedric Mullins (2021), trailing only Brady Anderson (12, 1996).
TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks second in MLB with 26 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (30)...He's among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

Henderson owns a career-best 33-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an O's batter since Nick Markakis' 38younger in Orioles history.
$\theta$. He leads MLB with 70 runs scored this season; that is the most runs through the first 80 team games of a season in O's history.

SUMMER SLUGGER: Anthony Santander leads MLB with 12 home runs this month, tied for the most in the month of June in Orioles history with Boog Powell (1964), Rafael Palmeiro (1998), Albert Belle (2000), and Chris Davis (2013)...He is the first Oriole with at least 12 home runs in a month since Manny
Machado in August of 2017 (also 12)...Trails only Jim Gentile (15 in August 1961), Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014), and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Orioles
 $A L$, and $11^{\text {th }}$ in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (129).

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles need one win in their next four games to clinch a winning record in June...With a 17-9 record in May, the O's have been above . 500 in eight consecutive full months since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the team (min. 10 games played in the month) since May 1982
through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors; Atlanta had its streak of 11 straight winning months since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand with the four-game series opener against the Rangers...The final two games will be nationally televised, with Saturday on FOX's

winning the first two games at Oriole Park, on the way to the franchise's first World Series title.

SCORING CHANGE: In the top of the fifth inning on June 20 at New York-AL, Jordan Westburg reached base on what was originally ruled an error on second baseman Gleyber Torres...This has been changed to a single, giving the O's their $42^{\text {nd }} 20$-hit game in team history (since 1954) and the first since July 6, 2023 at New York-AL.

OUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his $17^{\text {th }}$ start of the season tonight against the Rangers...Texas is the only team Burnes has never faced in his career... Burnes 2.35 ERA(26 ER/99.2 IP) is the 11 lowest for an Orioles starting pitche through his first 16 starts to begin a season and the lowest since Jim Palmer in 1978 (1.81)... His ERA is the second lowest by an O's starting pitcher through his first 15 starts to begin his Orioles career in team history (since 1954)...The Orioles are 11-5 in his starts this year...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).
LAST TIME OUT: Dealt the loss on June 22 at Houston after allowing a seasonhigh four runs on five hits (2 HR) with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings...The two home runs are his most surrendered since September 4, 2023 at Pittsburgh (w/MIL)...Did not allow a walk for the first time since April 3 vs. Kansas City... Tossed 7.0 innings for the fifth time this year...Snapped his five-game winning streak and his career-high streak of 10 consecutive quality starts...Threw 90 pitches, 61 strikes.

AGAINST THE RANGERS AND THE AL WEST: Slated to make his first career appearance against the Rangers...Will be making his eighth career start against the AL West and fifth of the season; had faced the division a total of four times prior to this year...Has made a start against every AL West opponent but Texas this season...Owns a lifetime 4-2 record with a 2.98 ERA (14 ER/42.1 IP) across eight appearances ( 7 GS ) against the division...AL West opponents are slashing .172/.207/.368(15-for-87) off him this year.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest streak in the majors this year and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 12 quality starts on the season are tied for the third most in MLB and his 51 quality starts since the start of 2022 are the second most... His 13 games of at least 6.0 innings are two behind the MLB lead entering today.

NEW BEGINNINGS: Burnes began his Orioles career with 15 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings and three-or-fewer runs allowed...The 15 consecutive outings was the longest such streak to begin a pitcher's career with the Orioles all-time

EARLY STRUGGLES: After allowing five first-inning runs across his first six starts to open the season, Burnes has not allowed one since his outing on April 26 vs. Oakland...Four of those first inning runs have come via solo home runs; the four first-inning homers allowed are tied for the ninth most in MLB.
RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 36 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 662.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank second in MLB behind Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (680.1 IP)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts... He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2
GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA ( 6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six GS)...In those games, he

Was dealt the loss his last time out on June 23 at Houston after allowing five runs on 10 hits ( 1 HR ) and three walks with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings; the 10 hits surrendered are a career high and the five runs allowed tie a career high ( $7 / 20 / 16$ at BOS w/SF)...
