**NATIVE AMERICAN RECOGNITION DAY:** Sunday’s Native American Recognition Day kicks off the 25th annual D-backs Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament, both presented by Talking Stick Resort, and features pregame parade 1,100 young baseball and softball players, Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community President Martin Harvier throwing the ceremonial first pitch, recognitions of Arizona’s Tribal Royalty Contingent, former Miss Salt River Isabella Dockerty singing the National Anthem and the Salt River Fire Department Honor Guard serving as Color Guard along with extravagant performances from drum groups, dancers and vocalists as well as art displays and educational exhibits.

**INTER-TRIBAL BASEBALL & SOFTBALL TOURNEY:** The D-backs one-of-a-kind 25th Annual Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament presented by Talking Stick Resort, and generously supported by Resolution Copper and Nike, is Monday, June 2-Thursday, June 5 at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick.

- The only tournament of its kind in Major League Baseball brings emerging talent from rural tribal communities to the big stage as 1,100 athletes across 75 teams representing 20 tribes spanning across Arizona, New Mexico, California and Oklahoma compete over 4 days.

**CITY CONNECT FRIDAY:** The D-backs are wearing their new Nike City Connect Serpientes uniforms for the fifth time tonight. . .the cutting-edge re-design represents the iconic Diamondbacks jerseys over the years, focusing on vibrant colors and reimagining traditional patterning to create something unmistakably Arizona.

**B-I-N-GENO:** This morning, **Eugenio Suárez** and **Ryan Thompson** visited Phoenix Children’s as Bingo game hosts. . .they gave out various D-backs prizes, interacted with kids, took photos and signed autographs.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 10-1 vs. Pirates Wednesday.

- **Tim Tawa** hit a solo homer (6)...appeared at his fifth different position (3B)...has also played at second base (22), center field (8), left (2), first (1).
- **Josh Naylor** went 2-for-4 and has a 7-game hitting streak.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has a 6-game hitting streak and hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs selected RHP Jeff Brigham (No. 34) from Triple-A Reno, signed INF Ildemaro Vargas (No. 6) as a Major League free agent, optioned RHP Kevin Ginkel to Reno, optioned INF Jordan Lawlar to Reno following Wednesday’s game and designated LHP Joe Mantipty for assignment.

**VS. NATS:** The D-backs are 9-3 in their last 12 games since June 6, 2023, slashing a combined .325/.379/.493 and outscoring them 76-40.

- At home, are 5-1 in their last 6 games and 7-2 in their last 9 games.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in 15 career games, is hitting .408 (20-for-49)/1.366 OPS, with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 11 RBI, 9 walks and 4 stolen bases., including an 8-game hitting streak (May 5, 2023-June 19, 2024).
- **Ketel Marte** has a 5-game hitting streak (.444; 8-for-18, 1.167 OPS) and in his last 11 games, is hitting .378 (17-for-45)/1.085 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers and 11 RBI.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his last 12 games, is batting .404 (19-for-47)/1.089 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 10 games, is batting .382 (13-for-34)/.934 OPS with 3 doubles, 6 RBI, 6 walks and 3 stolen bases.
- **Alek Thomas**, in 11 career games, is batting .353 (12-for-34)/.977 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 triples and 7 RBI.

**SNAKES POWER TANDEM:** The D-backs are the only team in the Majors with multiple players with 15+ homers in **Corbin Carroll** (16) and **Eugenio Suárez** (15).

- Carroll and Suárez are the third duo in franchise history with 15+ homers in the team’s first 56 games to start a season [also: 2001-Luis Gonzalez (21) and Reggie Sanders (15); 1999-Jay Bell (16) and Matt Williams (16)].
- Carroll is the first D-back (8th all time) with 16+ homers in the team’s first 56 games since Paul Goldschmidt in 2015 (16).

**1 THRU 4:** D-backs' 1-4 batters combined .480 SLG and .830 OPS rank fourth in the Majors, behind the Dodgers (.571 SLG/.960 OPS), Yankees (.523 SLG/.897 OPS) and Cubs (.483 SLG/.836 OPS).

**MAY-JORS LEADERS:** Among all teams in May, the D-backs rank in extra-base hits (1st, 90), total bases (1st, 407), SLG (1st, .454), hits (1st, 232), OPS (2nd, .786), homers (T-2nd, 37) and sacrifice flies (T-4th, 4).

**MAY MASHER:** **Ketel Marte** has hit a career-high 8 homers in May, also his most for any career month (prev: 7 in May 2019; 7 in June 2019, 2023, 2024; 7 in July 2024).

- Marte is tied for fourth in May homers in the NL (also: Matt Olson/ATL and Gavin Sheets/SD), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (13), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (10) and Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (9).

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (7-3, 3.90)

- His 7 wins are tied for most in MLB (also: 4 others).
- Is 4-0 in his last 4 home starts with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER in 24.1 IP), 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.
- Won his last start @ Nationals on April 4 (W; 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 0 BB, 4 K).
