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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore opened the post-All-Star schedule last night with the first of six games on the road at Houston (1-0, 2 to play) and Boston (3 to play)...The Orioles have won five games in a row and eight of 11...The club is 10.0 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 2.0 games back in the Wild Card.

- 🦅 The O's have won five games in a row for the first time since September 1-6, 2025...The team has not won six in a row since May 30-June 5, 2025.
- 🦅 Baltimore won last night when trailing through seven innings for the sixth time this year, tied for second in the AL and tied for fifth in MLB...Colorado leads the majors with nine such wins, while Detroit paces the AL with eight.
- 🦅 **Taylor Ward** hit a go-ahead two-run home run in the eighth inning with the team trailing yesterday...It was the ninth go-ahead homer in the seventh inning or later by the Orioles this season, fourth most in the majors behind the Yankees (11), Padres and White Sox (both 10)...It's the second such home run by the O's in the last four games, joining **Samuel Basallo's** two-run home run in the eighth on July 10 vs. Kansas City and the first with the club trailing since **Colton Cowser's** walk-off three-run home run on May 24 (G1) vs. Detroit...For Ward, it was the ninth go-ahead blast in the seventh inning or later and his first since a walk-off three-run homer on August 3, 2025 vs. Chicago-AL.
- 🦅 The bullpen tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in the win, matching a season high, joining June 11 vs. Seattle and May 12 vs. New York-AL.
- 🦅 **Cam Sanders** earned his first MLB win after retiring the final two batters of the seventh inning while stranding the bases loaded...He's the 84th Oriole (since 1954) to win his team debut and the first since Tucker Davidson on September 28, 2024 at Minnesota.

BOOTH'S A BIRD: The Orioles have signed **Eric Booth Jr.**, the No. 7 overall pick in the 2026 First-Year Player Draft...Booth, who attended Oak Grove High School in Mississippi, was ranked by Baseball America and MLB Pipeline as the No. 6 draft prospect.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: When he made his MLB debut on July 17, 2023, **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** set the standard for the longest full name (27 characters) in major league history, according to [Sarah Langs](#)...Seranthony Dominguez (19 characters) is the longest full name for a player to appear for the Orioles (since 1954), while Encarnacion-Strand's last name (18 characters) will surpass Asher Wojciechowski (13 characters) for the longest last name in club history, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.56 ERA since May 24, the fourth-best ERA in the majors during that time behind the Tigers (3.22), Red Sox (3.36), and Yankees (3.46).
🦅 The rotation has posted a 3.65 ERA in 47 games during that period, the fourth-best starter ERA in the AL and seventh best in the majors.

CATCH THIS: The Orioles have received 71 RBI from players at catcher, the most by a team in the majors this year ahead of the Brewers (63) and Royals (62)...The club's catchers have combined to rank among all MLB team's catchers in hits (3rd, 95), slugging percentage (3rd, .482), doubles (T-3rd, 21), home runs (T-3rd, 19), and batting average (4th, .259).
🦅 Defensively, the O's lead the majors with 23 catcher caught stealings while posting a 69.2 percent stolen base percentage against (no pitcher CS) behind the Brewers (66.7%).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 89 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Pirates (51 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in a season-high 18 straight games, their longest run since a 21-game stretch from July 20-August 10, 2024.
🦅 **Taylor Ward** has drawn a free pass in each of his last seven games, tied with MIL's Jake Bauers for the longest active streak in MLB...He drew two walks in the final game before the break, matching his career high of 75 set last year in 157 games...His 75 free passes are the most by an Oriole before the All-Star break in team history (since 1954), surpassing Ken Singleton (70 BB, 1975)...The only other Orioles with 60+ walks prior to the All-Star break are Randy Milligan (69 BB, 1990), Bobby Grich (67 BB, 1973), and Albert Belle (66, 1999)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the O's with 62 free passes last year and with 78 in 2024.
🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).
🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 375 walks.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** is tied for third in the AL and is tied for eighth in the majors with 66 RBI...He is batting .274/.363/.520 (68-for-248) with 10 doubles, 17 homers, 42 runs, 53 RBI, 34 walks, and three hit-by-pitches in 67 games since May 1.
🦅 Alonso became the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024.
🦅 He also became the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...His 65 RBI pre-break were the most by an Oriole since Manny Machado (65) in 2018.
🦅 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and has played 514 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (878 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

PHILLY PHILLY: **Adley Rutschman** was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024)...He entered in the seventh inning as a defensive replacement, grounding out in the eighth inning in his only at-bat.
🦅 Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).
🦅 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodriguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).
🦅 First baseman/outfielder **Ike Irish** and left-handed pitcher **Joseph Dzierwa** represented the Orioles in the Futures Game...Irish batted seventh as the designated hitter and went 0-for-1 with a walk...Dzierwa threw two pitches, getting the first out of the seventh inning.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 18th start of the season and 120th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 9 vs. Chicago-NL after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering five hits (1 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts...Threw 89 pitches, 60 strikes.

- His lone run allowed came via a Seiya Suzuki solo homer with one out in the sixth inning.
- Has thrown 6.0+ innings in four of his last five starts after doing so in four of his first 12 outings of the season.

INTO ORBIT: Rogers is set to make his third career start opposite the Astros, having gone 1-0 with a 2.19 ERA (3 ER/12.1 IP).

- Last faced Houston on August 24, 2025 at Camden Yards and earned the win after throwing 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits and three walks with nine strikeouts.
- Made his lone start at Daikin Park on July 9, 2024 and did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits and two walks with five strikeouts over 5.1 innings.

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT: Over his last five starts since June 14, Rogers is 3-1 with a 1.19 ERA (4 ER/30.1 IP), .171 (18-for-105) opponent average, and 0.96 WHIP.

- Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 30.0 innings since June 14, his 1.19 ERA is fourth lowest behind SF's Robbie Ray (1.08), WSH's Foster Griffin (1.11), and BOS' Jake Bennett (1.17).
- He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

SUPPORT WELCOMED: Rogers has received three runs of support or fewer in each of his last six outings (11 runs total), including one run in three of the outings.

- He received 32 runs of support over his first 11 starts of 2026, including a season-high-tying eight runs on April 1 vs. Texas and June 4 at Boston.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past four starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .077 (2-for-26) clip with one double and nine strikeouts.

- Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.
- Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .325/.388/.453 (38-for-117) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 28 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

- Opponents are slashing .442/.520/.674 (19-for-43) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.

ORDER OF OPERATIONS: Rogers has held the opposition to a .188 (27-for-144) batting average the first time through the order... However, they are hitting .298 (39-for-131) the second time through and .288 (21-for-73) the third time around.

- Nine-hole hitters are slashing .344/.382/.438 (11-for-32) with three doubles off Rogers.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

- His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP).

His 61.1 percent ground ball rate is sixth lowest in MLB (min. 30.0 IP)

His 33 total bases allowed are tied for third fewest among all AL relievers (min. 30 G) with BOS' Aroldis Chapman and CLE's Erik Sabrowski behind CLE's Colin Holderman (25 TB) and TB's Bryan Baker (31 TB)
