BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a nine-game road trip tonight against the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (1-0, 2 to play), and Rockies (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays...The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and 2.0 games behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

👉 Last night, **Coby Mayo** recorded his first career go-ahead RBI in the extra-innings, putting the Birds ahead, 3-2, with a two-out single...He has an RBI in a career-high-tying three straight games (3x, last: 4/21-24/26).

👉 **Colton Cowser** entered the game as a pinch-hitter in the sixth inning and doubled, extending his hitting streak to a season-high five straight games...He is 8-for-14 (.571) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, and two walks against two strikeouts during that period after going 2-for-15 (.133) with a homer in his previous six games.

👉 The Birds saw their 15-game home run streak come to an end...It was Baltimore's longest run since going deep in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024.

👉 Baltimore scored four runs in the victory, snapping a seven-game stretch against the Athletics of plating three runs or fewer...Four of the last five games between the clubs have been decided by one run.

👉 After losing seven straight extra-inning affairs to the A's from August 26, 2003-June 6, 2014, the Birds are 5-2 over the Athletics in extra innings since August 5, 2015.

'PEN PALS: Yesterday, **Alex Hoppe** secured his first career save, allowing an unearned run on one hit with one strikeout...He became the 10th Oriole to record a save in 2026, matching the franchise record (since 1954) shared with the 1987 club...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

👉 Hoppe has yet to allow an earned run in nine appearances (8.1 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5.

👉 **Yennier Cano** has gone 45 consecutive appearances (34.0 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (60 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (51 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (47 G).

👉 In 26 appearances since June 24, **Andrew Kittredge** has posted a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP) and six saves.

👉 Over the last eight games since August 20, Oriole relievers have pitched to a 1.04 ERA (3 ER/26.0 IP).

TWO-OUT TENDENCIES: Since beginning the current road trip on Tuesday, Baltimore is 16-for-51 (.314) with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, and five walks with two outs.

👉 The Birds have produced 75 two-out hits this month, tied for fifth most in the MLB behind the Astros/Diamondbacks (both 83) and Cubs/Rays (both 80).

👉 **Pete Alonso** and **Coby Mayo** are both 9-for-25 (.360) with five RBI with two outs this month...**Christian Encarnacion-Strand** has a team-best eight two-out RBI in August.

POLAR BEAR ROARING: **Pete Alonso** enters play today with 91 RBI, tied for the AL lead with HOU's Yordan Alvarez...Alonso looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

👉 Through 25 games in August, Alonso is slashing .358/.419/.674 (34-for-95) with three doubles, nine home runs, 22 RBI, and a 1.093 OPS...The .358 batting average would tie his highest in any month of his career (min. 25 AB in month), joining April 2025 (.358, 34-for-95)...His career high for hits in a month came in August 2025 (36).

A+ GRADES: In 25 career games against the Athletics, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .344/.410/.600 (31-for-90) with seven doubles, two triples, four home runs, 19 runs, 13 RBI, seven walks, five steals, and three hit-by-pitches.

👉 Despite a current 1-for-24 (.042) skid against the A's over his last six games, **Pete Alonso** owns a 1.090 OPS in 16 career games against the club...He reached base safely in each of his first 10 career games opposite the Athletics, going 18-for-39 (.462) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 runs, and 17 RBI.

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 30 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (33).

👉 The O's have hit multiple home runs in eight of their last 12 road games (22 HR total).

👉 **Pete Alonso's** nine home runs since August 9 lead MLB, ahead of CHC's Alex Bregman, CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong, PHI's Kyle Schwarber, and SD Fernando Tatis Jr. (all 7).

ROAD TRIPPING: Since the All-Star Break, the O's are averaging 5.48 run per game on the road, the second-highest figure in the majors behind the Cubs (6.42)...Prior to the break, the Birds averaged 4.32 runs per game away from Camden Yards, ranking 18th in the majors.

👉 Among all qualified MLB hitters following the All-Star Break, **Pete Alonso's** 1.067 OPS on the road is third highest behind CHC's Alex Bregman (1.130) and SEA's Dominic Canzone (1.070), while **Christian Encarnacion-Strand's** .991 OPS ranks sixth.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 43-46 (.483) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the fourth-most such games in the league this season and 20th in winning percentage in those situations this year.

👉 Despite owning a 15-19 (.441) in one-run affairs this season, the Birds have won three straight and are 5-1 in their last six such games since August 14.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 34 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least six pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).

👉 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.

👉 The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 27th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on August 23 vs. Tampa Bay after tossing 5.2 innings of three-run ball, scattering five hits and three walks with three strikeouts...Threw 96 pitches, 54 strikes.

⚡ Left the outing with two runners on and two outs in the sixth inning...**Grant Wolfram** came on allowed a single to Chandler Simpson, scoring Junior Caminero.

⚡ Entering play today, his 14 losses are tied for the most in MLB along with CLE's Tanner Bibee...The 14 losses are the most by an Oriole since Jorge López and Matt Harvey both lost 14 games in 2021...The last Oriole with 15 losses was Dylan Bundy (16) in 2018.

WEST COAST VIBES: Baz has made three career starts against the Athletics, going 1-2 with a 4.10 ERA (12 ER/26.1 IP)...Took the loss earlier this year at Camden Yards on May 9 (4.2 IP, 5 H, 5 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 5 K).

⚡ Struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters vs. the A's on July 1, 2025, joining his 11 punchouts on April 14, 2025 vs. Boston.

MANIFESTING THE TURNAROUND: Despite posting a 4.02 ERA (31 ER/69.1 IP) over his last 12 starts since June 18, he is 0-8 in those outings, with the Orioles going 1-11 in his starts.

⚡ The Birds have lost 20 of his 26 starts this season.

⚡ Tonight, Baz looks for his first victory since June 12 vs. San Diego.

⚡ He is on a career-high-tying eight decision losing streak, joining June 15, 2021-April 22, 2022.

HELP WANTED: Baz has received 15 runs of support over his 12 starts since June 18...Five of those runs came on July 20 at Boston, while four came in his outing on August 12 at Minnesota...He has received zero runs of support in six of his outings during this period.

⚡ Among all 108 MLB hurlers who have thrown at least 50.0 innings since June 18, Baz's 1.95 run support average is the lowest in MLB, with the next closest being LAA's Reid Detmers (2.01).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 32 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted 11 home runs over 179.2 innings (0.55 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 32 outings, the third-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind STL's Andre Pailante (37 G) and LAD's Kris Bubic (35 G).

⚡ Baz is the only Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 26 starts with the team, surpassing the previous record held by Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).

⚡ His 0.65 home runs per nine innings this season signal the lowest mark by an Orioles starter (min. 20 GS) since Kevin Gausman (0.56 HR/9.0 IP) in 2014.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 41 doubles, ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (38)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

KNUCKLE SANDWICH: After holding the opposition to a .184 (9-for-49) clip on his knuckle curveball in May, opponents hit .283 (15-for-53) against the offering in June and 13-for-37 (.351) off it in July.

⚡ Through his five starts in August, opponents are 8-for-29 (.276) with two doubles and 13 strikeouts off the pitch.

👉 Has completed exactly 0.1 inning in three straight outings for the first time in his career...Has not completed at least 1.0 inning in a career-high-tying five straight games (also 6/17-29/26)
