## Detroit Tigers (23-13) at Colorado Rockies (6-29)

**ALTHOUGH WE'VE COME, TO THE...:** The Detroit Tigers this afternoon and into this evening close out their stay in Denver with a traditional doubleheader vs. the Colorado Rockies, a fitting end to the club's longest road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game, three-city trip that began in Houston (1-2) and continued at the Los Angeles Angels (3-1) ... the Tigers are 5-3 through the first eight games of this trip that seemingly began during the Eisenhower administration.

- Following last night's 8-6 victory, the Tigers have reached 10 games above .500 for the first time this season and begin the day with the best record in the A.L. ... at 23-13, they have their best record to start a season through 36 games in 11 years when they began 24-12 in 2014 on their way to their most-recent A.L. Central title.
- The Tigers have gone 23-10, a .697 winning percentage, in their last 33 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 23-10 record starting March 31 is the best record in all of baseball in that span.
- This road trip touched the Central, Pacific and Mountain time zones and is bookended by a pair of Eastern time zone series in Detroit ... this marks the first time in Tigers history that they played four consecutive series in each of the four different time zones in the continental U.S.
- This is Detroit's second doubleheader of the season, as they swept the Baltimore Orioles in a split doubleheader on Saturday, April 26 near the end of the club's most-recent homestand.
- After today's action, the Tigers will return home for a two-team, six-game homestand starting tomorrow with the first of three games against the Texas Rangers and concluding next week with three games against the Boston Red Sox (Monday-Wednesday).

**DO GET ME STARTED:** A year after a season filled with openers and the like, the Tigers last night finally saw their first start of less than 4.0 innings this year when Jackson Jobe tossed 3.2 frames in the club's 36th game ... Detroit's 35-game run of 4.0 innings or more from their starter in 2025 marked the farthest the Tigers had ever gone into a season with every starting pitcher tossing at least 4.0 innings each game in 125 years of franchise history ... the club's closest season-opening streaks to this year came in 1905 and 1907 (first 32 games) and in 1943 (first 31 games).

- All 29 other major league teams had had at least one start of less than 4.0 innings before the Tigers joined the club last night.
- Last year, the Tigers had 43 starts of less than 4.0 innings pitched, many by design.

**EL MAGO IS BACK!:** Javier Báez yesterday went 2-for-5 with a pair of two-run singles to extend his hitting streak to eight games, his longest hitting streak in more than two years ... Báez now has a pair of four-RBI games in his last five games, plus a four-run-scored game in that stretch ... Báez is now batting a team-leading .313 (31-for-99) with an .827 OPS, easily his best early season numbers since his N.L. MVP runner-up campaign of 2018 with the Cubs ... he now has six extra-base hits (3 2B, 3 HR), 10 runs scored and 13 RBI in his last seven games starting April 27.

- Báez's eight-game hitting streak is tied for the sixth-longest active streak in all of baseball and tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the American League.

**D'OH! NO HOMER:** The Tigers yesterday did not hit a home run to snap their streak at seven games in a row with a blast ... the Tigers had homered in seven-consecutive road games (all part of the same road trip) for the first time since July 19-25, 2024.

**HE MANAGES JUST FINE:** A.J. Hinch last night became the 75th manager in major league history to reach 900 career wins ... Hinch is one of five active managers to reach the mark, a list that includes Colorado's Bud Black, who is fourth among active managers and 47th overall with 1,192 wins.

**THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE:** The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the A.L. on the strength of a +65 overall run differential this year, the best mark in all of baseball, just ahead of the Yankees (+61) ... the Tigers have a +79 run edge on the Cleveland Guardians (-14), occupants of second place in the A.L. Central.

**POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ:** Including 6.1 scoreless innings last night in Colorado, the Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.43 ERA (33 ER/122.0 IP) this season, the lowest relief ERA in the A.L. and the third-lowest mark in all of baseball, barely behind only San Francisco (2.33) and San Diego (2.42).

**HE'S JUST THE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Riley Greene soared into this series as the reigning American League Player of the Week after he batted .464 (13-for-28) with four homers and eight RBI in seven games last week, recording at least one hit in every game ... Greene made major league history on Friday in Los Angeles when he became the first player to ever hit two home runs in the ninth inning of a game ... this is the first weekly honor of Greene's career and the first by a Tiger since Keider Montero in September of last season and the first position player since Miguel Cabrera in 2022.

**AND FINALLY:** The Tigers last night improved to 10-2 in series openers this season, the best record in the majors ... the Tigers are 8-3 in their 11 series into today's doubleheader.

- Became the first Tigers pitcher to win four games in April since Jordan Zimmerman won five games in 2016...went 4-1 with a 2.12 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) in five starts in April.
- Began the 2025 season with a perfect 2-0 record and a 0.77 ERA (1 ER/11.2 IP) through his first two starts.
- Held a 1.89 ERA in six games (four starts) over Spring Training this year...led the team with 25 strikeouts, including seven over 3.0 innings in his final outing on March 25.
- In his first MLB action since 2022, Mize appeared in 22 games (20 starts) and posted a 2-6 record with a 4.49 ERA (51ER/102.1IP) and 78 strikeouts last season.

- Placed on the 15-day injured list on April 18 with right ankle inflammation...activated by Detroit on May 3.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster in 2025
- Pitched in 46 games (12 starts) for the Tigers in 2024, finishing with a 4-5 record, 3.59 ERA (27ER/67.2IP) and 69 strikeouts...set career-best marks in strikeouts, wins, holds (6), opponent batting average (.224), slugging percentage (.354) and OPS (.664).
- Started on Sept. 13 and 14 vs. Baltimore last season, becoming the first Tigers pitcher to start back-to-back team games, which were on consecutive days, since George Uhle on Aug. 4-5, 1929.
- Pitched in six games during the playoffs, combining for a 0-1 record, two saves, 1.50 ERA (1ER/6.0IP) and six strikeouts.
- Made his postseason debut on Oct. 1 at Houston, walking one in a scoreless two-thirds of an inning to pick up the save...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first pitcher in franchise history to record a save in his first career playoff game.
- Started his postseason career with 5.1 no-hit innings with two walks and six strikeouts in his first four outings.

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
