BIRDLAND BITES: Today, Baltimore continues a stretch of 13 games in 13 days, including a road trip through Boston and Toronto (each 3 G) before returning home with sets against Seattle (4 G) and San Diego (3 G)...The Birds have won eight of their last 12 games since May 22 and enter play today 1.5 games out of a Wild Card spot and 8.5 games back of the Rays in the AL East.

⚾ **Adley Rutschman's** RBI-triple in the seventh inning prevented the Orioles from suffering their first shutout of the 2026 campaign...Baltimore is the only club in the majors that has yet to be shut out this season...The 62 straight games to start the season scoring at least one run marks the fourth-longest such streak in franchise history (since 1954) trailing O's clubs from 2007 (133 G), 1978 (77 G), and 1996 (66 G).

⚾ Despite last night's defeat, the Orioles are 16-14 (.533) against the Red Sox on the road over the last five seasons since 2022...The .533 road winning percentage is the highest vs. any single AL East opponent over that span.

⚾ Baltimore has 26 homers over its last 17 games since May 16, tied with Houston for second most in the majors behind Seattle (29).

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: Trevor Rogers has made three career starts at Fenway Park, going 1-1 with a 1.40 ERA (3 ER/19.1 IP) and 18 strikeouts against one walk while posting a 0.83 WHIP...In two starts at Fenway in 2025, Rogers permitted one run across 13.1 innings while limiting Red Sox hitters to a .136 (6-for-44) batting average.

MR. BLUE SKY: The O's are 7-2 in their last nine daytime affairs since May 10, including winners of four straight since May 24 (G1)...Overall, the Birds' 29 daytime games this season are tied for third most in MLB behind the Nationals (31) and Twins (30).

⚾ Baltimore has dropped six of its last seven daytime games opposite Boston since April 3, 2025.

GUNNAR RIGHT AT HOME: Gunnar Henderson has reached base safely in each of his first 24 career games at Fenway Park, slashing .272/.402/.565 (25-for-92) with nine doubles, three triples, four home runs, 19 runs, 11 RBI, and 19 walks against 25 strikeouts.

⚾ His current 24-game run is the eighth-longest career-opening on-base streak by any player at Fenway Park in MLB history, including the longest since Tony Clark's 27-game stretch from September 25, 1995-September 21, 2001.

⚾ It is the longest such streak by an Oriole in team history (since 1954), outpacing 11-game runs by Matt Wieters (7/24/09-9/21/10) and Don Baylor (5/23/72-6/23 [G2]/73).

⚾ His .967 career OPS at Fenway Park is fourth highest among all active players (min. 100 PA) behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (1.138), PHI's Kyle Schwarber (1.128), and TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (1.018).

⚾ He is slashing .318/.400/.727 (7-for-22) with three doubles, two home runs, and three walks off Brayan Bello.

ON-BASE ADLEY: Adley Rutschman has reached base safely in a season-high 14 straight games since May 18, his longest streak since a 14-game stretch from March 27-April 13, 2025...He last reached base safely in 15 straight games during a career-best 16-game run from June 12-29, 2024.

⚾ Despite recording a .235 (12-for-51) batting average during this period, he owns a .385 on-base percentage and .777 OPS, recording three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven runs, six RBI, and 13 walks against six strikeouts...Prior to his current 14-game streak, Rutschman had two walks and 12 strikeouts over his previous 14 games from May 1-16.

POLAR BEAR PETE: Pete Alonso has hit safely in each of his last seven games since May 27, and is slashing .313/.360/.522 (21-for-67) with two doubles, four home runs, and 15 RBI over his last 17 games since May 16.

⚾ Seven of Alonso's 12 home runs this season have gone to the opposite field, the second-most such long balls in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (9).

⚾ He has registered five Outs Above Average at first base, tied with CHC's Michael Busch and SD's Ty France for second most in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (6 OAA).

'PEN PALS: Rico Garcia ranks among all qualified MLB relievers in opponent average (1st, .083), opponent on-base percentage (1st, .172), opponent OPS (1st, .327), hits per nine innings (1st, 2.39), base runners per nine innings (1st, 5.47), WHIP (1st, 0.61), and ERA (4th, 0.68).

⚾ Garcia's 40.2 percent whiff rate is third highest among all MLB pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) behind SD's Mason Miller (52.2%) and TOR's Jeff Hoffman (41.9%).

⚾ Andrew Kittredge has made five straight scoreless appearances since May 18, holding opponents to a 1-for-14 (.071) clip with six strikeouts against one walk.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: Samuel Basallo is slashing .349/.397/.606 (38-for-109) with eight doubles, one triple, six homers, 17 runs scored, 21 RBI, and 10 walks in 34 games since April 20.

⚾ Among players with at least 100 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (3rd), OPS (3rd, 1.002), and slugging percentage (4th).

⚾ Basallo ranks among all qualified MLB rookies in slugging percentage (2nd, .500), OPS (2nd, .841), home runs (T-4th, 9), triples (T-5th, 1), batting average (7th, .277), extra-base hits (7th, 18), total bases (8th, 83), RBI (T-8th, 25), on-base percentage (9th, .341), walks (T-9th, 17), and hits (10th, 46).

BLAZING THE TRAIL: Blaze Alexander is slashing .353/.384/.485 (24-for-68) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, seven runs scored, 14 RBI, four walks (1 IBB), and four stolen bases in 27 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

⚾ His batting average since May 1 ranks third in MLB (min. 60 AB) behind PHI's Brandon Marsh (.367) and WSH's Keibert Ruiz (.354).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 55) and times on base (6th, 112).

⚾ His four games with at least three walks are tied for the MLB lead with ATH's Nick Kurtz and LAA's Mike Trout...He is the first Oriole to have four such games in a season since Mark Reynolds (also 4 G) in 2012...The last to have five was Nick Markakis (6, 2008).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,216 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,241)...He has seen 426 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, second in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (466).

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 11th start of the season and 113th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on May 29 vs. Toronto after allowing four runs on six hits (2 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts over 6.0 innings...Threw 84 pitches, 61 strikes.

🕒 After allowing a one-out triple to Daulton Varsho in the second inning, retired 12 straight batters before Brandon Valenzuela's one-out double in the sixth...Allowed four straight hits to open the seventh frame, including a Vladimir Guerrero Jr. single, a Kazuma Okamoto home run, a Varsho double, and a Charles McAdoo homer.

IF THE SOX FIT: Rogers has made six career starts vs. Boston, going 1-3 with a 3.00 ERA (9 ER/27.0 IP).

🕒 Has made 21 career starts against AL East opponents, going 4-7 with a 4.38 ERA (48 ER/98.2 IP)...Is on a four-decision losing streak against the division dating back to September 26, 2025, over which he holds a 12.76 ERA (26 ER/18.1 IP).

STREAK ENDS TODAY: Rogers is on a six-decision losing streak since April 14... During this seven-start stretch, he owns a 10.01 ERA (33 ER/29.2 IP), .333 (43-for-129) opponent average, and 1.89 WHIP...In his first three starts of the season, Rogers went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP), .214 (15-for-70) opponent average, and 1.05 WHIP.

🕒 His 10.01 ERA since April 14 is the second highest in the majors (min. 20.0 IP), ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (10.86).

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, and 21 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

🕒 His .970 opponent OPS with two outs is fifth highest in MLB (min. 70 BF) ahead of AZ's Merrill Kelly (1.040), CIN's Brady Singer (1.017), TOR's Patrick Corbin (.985), and WSH's Zack Littell (.978).

LEFT-SIDE STORY: Opposing left-handed hitters are 8-for-25 (.320) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, and six RBI off Rogers over his last four starts after going a combined 2-for-22 (.091) with two doubles over his first six outings.

BOTTOMS UP: Nine-hole hitters are 8-for-18 (.444) with two doubles off Rogers...His 1.056 opponent OPS by nine-hole hitters is sixth highest in MLB (min. 20 BF) ahead of DET's Jack Flaherty (1.370), TOR's Simeon Woods Richardson (1.336), COL's Chase Dollander (1.138), COL's Kyle Freeland (1.095), and CHC's Edward Cabrera (1.070).

🕒 Rogers has also had troubles with opposing leadoff men, with them hitting .407 (11-for-27) with two homers, compared to a .115 (3-for-26) clip by two-hole hitters.

MIXING IT UP: Opponents are hitting .280 (21-for-75) with five doubles, one triple, and five home runs off Rogers' four-seam fastball, while going 19-for-60 (.317) with two doubles, one triple, and one homer off his changeup.

🕒 Last season, he limited the opposition to a .158 (22-for-139) clip with two doubles, one triple, and three home runs off the four-seamer and 23-for-114 (.202) with three doubles, one triple, and one home run off the changeup.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).
