WE SHALL NOT FORGET: Today, on the 20th anniversary of the tragic events of Sept. 11, 2001, the D-backs and Major League Baseball honor those whose lives were lost or affected, pay tribute to the men and women who serve or served our country and communities, and remember how baseball came together to help our communities heal and rebuild after the terrorist attacks.



HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are on a 9-game, 11-day road trip @ Mariners (0-1), Dodgers and Astros with their fifth visit to Seattle (1999, 2001, '09, '15).

- ◆ **Humberto Castellanos** started vs. Mariners on Sept. 4 (5 ER in 3.2 IP)...in 3 career starts, is 1-0 with a 4.15 ERA (6 ER in 13.0 IP)...first career road start (12 relief appearances).
- ◆ **David Peralta** has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 starts, including 11 straight to begin this stretch dating back to Aug. 19, batting .354 (17-for-48)/.955 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 5 RBI and 2 walks.

ON THE INTERLEAGUE ROAD AGAIN: **Pavin Smith** has reached base via hit or walk in 7 of 9 road interleague games, hitting .281 (9-for-32)/.638 OPS with 1 triple, 3 RBI and 1 walk.

- ◆ **David Peralta**, in 21 road interleague games since 2019, is hitting .316 (24-for-76)/.883 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 6 walks.

CHEERS!!!! **Seth Beer** debuted with a pinch-hit, solo homer in the eighth inning off Diego Castillo in his first career plate appearance last night @ Mariners, becoming the fourth D-back to homer in his first career plate appearance:

AT A GLANCE: Is in his first season with Arizona...claimed off waivers from the Astros on Jan. 29.

- Pronounced: uhm-BAIR-toh kah-stay-AH-nohs.
- Born and resides in Tepatitlán, Jalisco, Mexico.
- Signed by the Astros as non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2015.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Is 1-0 with a 4.15 ERA (6 ER in 13.0 IP) in his 3 career starts (all in 2021).

- Is making the first road start of his Major League career.
- Recalled from Triple-A Reno on Sept. 4...was 6-1 with a 4.99 ERA (32 ER in 57.2 IP) in 12 starts with the Aces.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on Sept. 4 vs. Mariners...surrendered 5 runs on 7 hits over 3.2 frames, including a 3-run homer by Kyle Seager in the first inning.

VS. MARINERS: Will be making his second consecutive career start (SEE LAST START).

VIVA MÉXICO: Was the D-backs' 13th Mexico-born player (11th pitcher) when he made his debut on June 4 @ Brewers.

- Was the sixth Mexico-born pitcher to start for Arizona (also: Armando Reynoso, Elmer Dessens, Édgar González, Rodrigo López and Óscar Villarreal).

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: Opponents are 4-for-34 (.118) off his curveball and 4-for-19 (.211) off his 4-seamer this season.

- Is limiting hitters to a combined .211 average (8-for-38) in innning 3 through 5.

2020 REVIEW: Went 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA and 12 strikeouts in 8 games over 4 stints with the Astros.

- Had made only 5 appearances above Single-A Adv. prior to the season.

DEBUT VS. D-BACKS: Made his MLB debut on Aug. 4, 2020 @ Chase Field, pitching a perfect ninth inning with the Astros.
