**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY  
JUNE 12**

**2019** - The Astros set a franchise record with 24 strikeouts in a 14-inning, 6-3, loss to the Brewers in Houston...the game is played in a crisp four hours and 16 minutes...**RHP Justin Verlander** does most of the work, striking out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 innings pitched...this start was one of many excellent starts for Verlander in 2019 en route to earning his second career Cy Young.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros continue a six-game road trip with the first game of a three-game series against the Kansas City Royals tonight at Kauffman Stadium...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** will be on the mound for the Astros, opposite **RHP Luinder Avila** and the Royals.

**ABOUT IMAI:** **RHP Tatsuya Imai** is set to make his ninth career Major League start tonight and his fifth since returning from the IL after a bout with right arm fatigue...he's performed better since his return, particularly in his last four starts in which he's posted a 2.91 ERA (7ER/21.2IP) with a .176 (13x74) opponent average and a 1.02 WHIP...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

**ABOUT THE NO-NO:** On May 25 at TEX, **RHP Tatsuya Imai** started the Astros 17th regular season no-hitter and their 18th no-hitter overall in club history...Imai worked the first 6.0 hitless innings before giving way to **LHP Steven Okert** (1IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2IP)...the no-hitter was the Astros seventh since 2019, which is the most in the Majors in that span...additionally, the Astros 18 no-hitters overall are the most in the Majors since the franchise was born in 1962.

**ROAD TRIP:** The Astros traveled to Kansas City on Wednesday night after facing the Los Angeles for a three-game series...the Astros went 1-2 in Anaheim...the Astros will continue their six-game road trip tonight with the first game of a three-game series against the Royals...the Astros are 15-20 on the road this season and went 7-3 on their last road trip.

**PEN PALS:** Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has recorded a 2.53 ERA (24ER/85.1IP) with 82 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .169 opponent batting average...among AL teams since May 15, the Astros bullpen ranks first in opponent batting average, first in WHIP and first in ERA...the Astros are also 14-11 during since May 15.

**WEDNESDAY NIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros were defeated by the Angels, 3-2, in 10 innings due to a walk-off RBI single by **CF Jose Siri**...**RHP Peter Lambert** (6.1 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 6 K) recorded another solid start for the Astros...**RF Cam Smith** (1x4, HR, RBI) and **SS-3B Shay Whitcomb** (1x4, HR, RBI) each recorded a solo home run.

**HIT PAREDES:** **IF Isaac Paredes** is one double away from recording his 100th career double...is looking to become just the 4th Mexican-born player in MLB history with 500 career hits, 100 doubles and 100 home runs, joining **IF Vinny Castilla**, **IF Jorge Orta** and **IF Aurelio Rodriguez**.

**ON THE MEND:** **RHP Hunter Brown** allowed two runs (one earned run) on three hits and two walks with seven strikeouts in five innings on Wed. night in a rehab start with Triple A Sugar Land...**C Yainer Diaz** went 0x3 with a walk and caught seven innings last night in a rehab appearance with Triple A Sugar Land.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** Following Wed. night's game, the Astros optioned **IF Shay Whitcomb** to Triple A Sugar Land...to take his place on the active roster, the Astros selected **IF Raynel Delgado** (#29) to the Major League roster today...to make room for Delgado on the 40-man roster, the Astros designated **RHP Ryan Weiss** for assignment today.

**VOTING COMMENCES:** MLB launched the 2026 Konami eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot last week...the Astros on the ballot: **1B Christian Walker**, **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Isaac Paredes**, **SS Jeremy Peña**, **C Yainer Diaz**, **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **OF Brice Matthews**, **OF Jake Meyers** and **OF Cam Smith**.

**MAKING THE PLAYS:** The Astros are tied for the fewest errors in the AL (28) with the Athletics...Houston has posted the best fielding percentage (.988) in the AL, topping the Athletics (.988), Royals (.988) and Mariners (.988) by a few percentage points.

**VS. THE ROYALS:** The Astros and Royals are facing each other for the first time this season...the Astros went 3-3 against the Royals last season, including a 1-2 record at Kauffman Stadium...the Astros own a 58-49 record all-time record against the Royals, including a 29-24 record at Kauffman Stadium.

**ON THE LEADERBOARD:** **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OPS (1.066), SLG (.636) and total bases (157) and leads the AL in home runs (22)...also in the AL, he ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (35), second in OBP (.430), second in batting average (.316), tied for third in RBI (48), third in hits (78), fourth in walks (46) and tied for fifth in runs (46).

**ON BASE MACHINE:** **OF Yordan Alvarez** is on a 18-game on-base streak...during the streak, he's batting .355 (22x62) with 16 runs, two doubles, seven home runs, 17 RBI, 15 walks and a 1.207 OPS...it is his second-longest on-base streak this season, behind a 22-game on-base streak from April 4-28.

**AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** On Monday, **OF Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Week for the week of June 1-7...for the week, he batted .476 (10x21) with six runs, one double, two HR, nine RBI, five walks and a 1.386 OPS.

**WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER:** **1B Christian Walker** ranks tied for third in the AL in RBI with teammate **DH Yordan Alvarez** (48)...Walker also ranks tied for fifth in the AL in extra-base hits (30), tied for sixth in total bases (127), tied for seventh in home runs (16) and 11th in SLG (.494)...in the field, Walker has not committed an error in 68 games.

**MOVIN' ON UP:** **RHP Bryan Abreu** recorded his 343rd career appearance on Wed. night at LAA surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342g) for the sixth-most relief appearances in Astros franchise history...Abreu is five appearances shy of tying **LHP Joe Sambito** (348g) for the fifth-most relief appearances in franchise history.

**ASTROS TV:** Tonight's game will be televised locally by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas** and **Geoff Blum** on the call...also, **Lauren Callendar** will fill-in for **Julia Morales** for the entire road trip.

**LAST START, JUNE 6 vs. ATH:** Picked up the win after allowing 2 runs in 5.0 innings while striking out 8...worked around traffic, as he allowed 5 hits, 3 walks and a HBP.

**ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY):** Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 8 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...tonight is his 6th start since returning from the IL...has posted a 2.91 ERA (7ER/21.2IP), a .176 (13x74) opponent batting average and a 1.02 WHIP over his last 4 starts, lowering his season ERA from 9.24 to 5.24 in that span.

**IMAI'S ARSENAL:** Has thrown 44.7% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (41.3%) and sinkers (9.3%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, has heavily featured his four-seamer over his last 4 starts, throwing the pitch 174 times compared to just 11 sinkers...has also worked in select split fingers (2%), changeups (1.8%), and curveballs (0.9%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 4.2 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

**KEEP IT 100:** Tossed a career-high 110 pitches on May 31 vs. MIL, which ties as the 3rd most pitches thrown by any MLB starter in a game this season...are the most pitches thrown by an Astro since **LHP Framber Valdez** threw 114 pitches on Aug. 25, 2023 at DET.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Has gone 2-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6ER/16.2IP) in his 4 road starts...started the Astros no-hitter in his last road start on May 25 at TEX.

**A NO-HITTER!** On May 25 at TEX, Imai tossed the first 6.0 innings of the 18th no-hitter in Astros franchise history, the 5th combined no-hitter...navigated 6.0 scoreless, hitless innings despite walking 4 batters, including the first 2 batters of the game and 3 total walks in the 1st inning...retired 15 of the next 16 batters he faced to finish the outing, striking out 2...was relieved in the no-hitter by **LHP Steven Okert** (1 IP) and **RHP Alimber Santa** (2 IP), with Santa making his MLB debut in the outing...marked the Astros first combined no-hitter since **RHP Cristian Javier**, **RHP Bryan Abreu**, **RHP Rafael Montero** and **RHP Ryan Pressly** combined to no-hit the Phillies in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series at Citizens Bank Park.

**NO HITTER HISTORY:** Imai became the 4th Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to start a no-hitter, joining **RHP Hideo Nomo** (1996, 2001), **RHP Hisashi Iwakuma** (2015) and **LHP Shota Imanaga** (2024)...both of Nomo's no-hitters and Iwakuma's no-hitter were complete-game efforts...the Astros no-hitter ended a 630-day drought between the last no-hitter thrown in the Majors when the Cubs tossed a combined no-hitter vs. the Pirates on Sept. 4, 2024...coincidentally, that no-hitter was started by Imanaga, who was relieved by **RHP Porter Hodge** and Imai's current Astros teammate, **RHP Nate Pearson**...was the longest no-hitter drought in the Majors since a span of 841 days between the 2004-06 seasons.

**2025 RECAP:** Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

**JAPANESE CAREER:** Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

**JAPAN CONNECTION:** Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

**LAST APPEARANCE (6/10 vs. LAA):** Came in the 10th inning in Wednesday's series finale at LAA and surrendered the winning run (unearned) on an RBI single...did not record an out after giving up 2 hits...tossed only 7 pitches (5 strikes) in the outing...recorded the save in his previous outing in the 10th inning on June 8, marking his 4th save of the season (4 opportunities).

**TURNING THE PAGE:** Has gone 2-1 with 3 saves and a 2.77 ERA (4ER/13IP) in his last 15 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

**VS. KC:** In 12 career regular season games against the Royals, owns 1-0 record with a 3.60 ERA (4ER/10.0IP), 6 walks and 10 strikeouts...has averaged a 9.00 K/9...has not allowed a run in his last 3 appearances vs. the Royals (since August 30, 2024)...excluding back-to-back appearances vs. the Royals from April 11-August 29, 2024 where he surrendered a combined 4 runs on 4 hits with a walk, has not allowed an earned run to the Royals.

**ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS:** Made his 343rd career appearance last night, which overtook RHP Ryan Pressly (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...now directly trails LHP Joe Sambito (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (479) and 10th in innings pitched (352.0).
