### Storied Series

Atlanta and New York tonight open a three-game series at Yankee Stadium. Dating to the 1990 season, a span of over 33 years, the Yankees and Braves are the two winningest franchises in Major League Baseball.

New York's 3,094-2,318 (.572) record is best in the majors, while Atlanta's 3,029-2,379 (.560) ranks second. They are the only two teams in baseball with over 3,000 wins in that span.

The two have combined for 6,123 wins, 36 division titles, 13 pennants and seven World Series championships since 1990.

New York (51-26, .662) enters tonight with the best record in baseball, while Atlanta (41-31, .569) ranks eighth.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Yankees tonight open a three-game weekend series in what is the only scheduled meetings between the teams this season...The two are playing for the second consecutive season after meeting at Truist Park last year.

*A* Atlanta swept its first ever series against New York last year, winning all three games and outscoring the Yankees, 18-3, in the set.

*A* The Braves' current three-game winning streak against the Yankees is their longest in history...They had won back-to-back games five times previously.

*A* Atlanta is just 19-26 (.422) all-time against New York since the advent of interleague play in 1997, its worst record against any AL team in that span... The Braves and Yankees have met four times in the World Series, with Atlanta going 1-3 in these sets...The Milwaukee Braves won the title in 1957, before the Yankees won in 1958, 1996 and 1999.

*A* Despite the losing record overall, Atlanta is an even 12-12 all-time here in New York...The Braves last played here in 2021 and split a pair of games, and Atlanta last won a series here in 2012 (2-1)...The club is 4-3-2 in nine total series here all-time.

*A* Tonight's starters Chris Sale and Carlos Rodón ranked tied for third in baseball with nine wins each...Only Seth Lugo (KC) and Ranger Suárez (PHI), both with 10, have more.

*A* LH Chris Sale has made 19 starts and pitched 22 total games against the Yankees in his career, and is 6-9 with a 3.12 ERA (42 ER/121.1 IP) and 157 strikeouts...The 6-foot-6, 180-pound native of Lakeland, FL, has last each of his last five starts against New York dating to July of 2022, going 0-5 with a 10.45 ERA (24 ER/20.2 IP)...The left-hander has eight starts of at least 7.0 innings this season, the second-most such starts in baseball.

*A* LH Carlos Rodón has pitched against Atlanta just twice in his career, making a pair of starts versus the Braves while with the Giants in 2022...The 6-foot-2, 255-pound native of Miami, FL, allowed just two runs, one earned, over 12.0 combined innings in those starts, allowing seven total baserunners and fanning 18...The left-hander is 7-1 in his last eight starts this season dating to May 8, pitching to a 2.98 ERA (16 ER/48.1 IP).

**INTERLEAGUE WIN:** Atlanta blanked Detroit on Wednesday afternoon, 7-0, to sweep the three-game set from the Tigers...The sweep was the Braves fifth of the season and their first since May 7-8 vs. Boston.

*A* The series this weekend in New York features the two best interleague records in baseball...The Braves (20-10) and Yankees (12-6) have identical .667 winning percentages in interleague play, highest in the majors.

*A* The Braves are 6-1 in their last seven interleague games, and only Milwaukee (21-14, .600) has more wins against the opposing league than Atlanta's 20.

**PITCHING:** Atlanta shut out Detroit on Wednesday afternoon, its major league-leading 10th shutout of the season...No other team has thrown more than eight.

*A* Of the club's 10 shutouts, eight have come at Truist Park...Since the venue opened in 2017, that matches the season-high for team shutouts, done first in 2021 and then matched in 2023.

*A* Atlanta combined to allow just two total runs in its three-game series versus Detroit, allowing single runs on Monday and Tuesday before the shutout on Wednesday...The Braves last allowed no more than two runs over a three-game series from April 17-19 of last season, when they did so against the Padres.

*A* The Braves' 3.59 ERA (255 ER/639.0 IP) on the season ranks eighth in baseball and third in the National League...Atlanta's 3.70 FIP for the season though trails just Philadelphia (3.43), Baltimore (3.66) and Boston (3.68).

*A* Atlanta's bullpen pitched 10.2 scoreless innings in its series versus Detroit, and the Braves' 3.26 ERA (86 ER/237.1 IP) in relief is fifth best in baseball.

**HOMERS:** Atlanta hit three more home runs Wednesday afternoon, and clubbed 13 homers over its six-game homestand...No team in baseball has more homers since that homestand started on June 14.

*A* The Braves' 13 homers over their last six games match their total from the previous 17 contests, May 27 to June 14...Atlanta ranks 14th in the majors with 79 homers on the season, one year after leading baseball and tying the single-season major league record with 307 homers in 2023.

*A* Eight different Braves homered on the homestand, with Austin Riley (3), Jarred Kelenic (2), Sean Murphy (2), Marcell Ozuna (2), Ozzie Albies, Travis d'Arnaud, Ramón Laureano and Matt Olson all going deep.

*A* Per Baseball Savant, Yankee Stadium is ranked as the seventh most homer-friendly park in the majors with a home run mark of 112, meaning that of batters and pitchers who played at both Yankee Stadium and elsewhere, 12% more home runs occurred in New York...Conversely, Atlanta's Truist Park ranked 23rd with a home run mark of just 88.

**HARD-HIT SERIES:** Atlanta (90.3 miles per hour) and New York (89.8 mph) rank second and third, respectively, in average exit velocity this season, and second (43.5%) and fifth (41.9%) in hard-hit percentage.

*A* No team in baseball has barreled more balls than New York's 200 such batted ball events, while Atlanta ranks fourth with 175...The Braves have made 68 outs on barreled balls this year, tops in baseball, while the Yankees rank second with 64.

*A* Aaron Judge (51 barrels, 1st), Juan Soto (41, 3rd) and Marcell Ozuna (38, 4th) all rank in the top four in barrels this season...Judge (96.8 mph, 1st), Soto (94.6, 4th), Giancarlo Stanton (94.1, 7th), Ozuna (92.8, 16th) and Matt Olson (92.2, 25th) all rank in the top 25 in average exit velocity.

### Today's Game

- ⚡ Scheduled to make his 14th start of the season and 20th of his career against New York.
  - ⚡ His last win against the Yankees came in 2018 with the Red Sox.
  - ⚡ Needs one strikeout to reach 100 on the season...Needs 12 to reach 2,300 on his career.
- ⚡ Recorded his second consecutive quality start in his last start while facing Tampa Bay, allowing five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings pitched with seven strikeouts.
- ⚡ His eight games with at least 7.0 innings pitched are the second most in the majors.
- ⚡ Has struckout at least 10 hitters in a game 83 times...Needs one more to tie to Hall-of-Famer Steve Carlton who ranks eighth on the leaderboard.
- ⚡ His nine wins are tied for the third most in the majors...among qualified starters in the National League, Sale ranks first in FIP (2.45), second in BB/9 (1.45), third in WHIP (0.94), fifth in strikeouts (99) and ninth in ERA (3.01).
  - ⚡ His seven wins at home are the most in baseball.
- ⚡ Through 13 starts this season, Sale has only issued two free passes or more in three of his starts.
  - ⚡ Walked three hitters on April 13, since then he is averaging 9.88 strikeouts to walks; the highest rate in the NL in that span.
- ⚡ Hitters are chasing 35.9% of of his pitches out of the strike zone this season; it's the highest rate in the majors among qualified starters.
  - ⚡ Recording strikes on 68.8% of pitches thrown this year; it is the fourth highest rate in the majors among qualifiers.
- ⚡ Sporting an 11.06 strikeout per nine innings rate through his career; the highest rate among active pitchers (min. 1,500 IP).
- ⚡ Opposing hitters are averaging 85.2 mph on balls in play against Sale; the third lowest mark in the majors among qualified starters.

### 2024 Recap

- ⚡ Sale's eight wins in the span of 10 games to start the season are the most by a Braves pitcher since Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz won nine of his fist 10 in 1996...Smoltz won the Cy Young Award the same year.
- ⚡ Snapped his streak of consecutive games with nine strikeouts at four games on June 1...The streak was tied for the longest on the season with Tyler Glasnow at the time.
- ⚡ LH Chris Sale was named as the National League Pitcher of the Month for May... He went a perfect 5-0 with a 0.56 ERA (2 ER/32.0 IP) across five starts, walking just two and fanning 45.
  - ⚡ The award was Sale's fifth career Pitcher of the Month honor, and his first since winning back-to-back awards in June and July of 2018 while with Boston.
  - ⚡ His 0.56 ERA is the lowest in baseball during the month of May since Tommy Greene pitched to a 0.29 ERA in six starts with Philadelphia in 1991...Greene struck out 30 in 31.0 frames while Sale fanned 45 hitters in 32.0 innings pitched.
- ⚡ Sale's ERA is the lowest in a calendar month by an Atlanta starter with at least five outings since Kris Medlen pitched to a 0.50 ERA in August, 2012.
  - ⚡ Per Baseball Reference...since 1910, it's the lowest ERA by a Braves starter in a calendar month who had at least 45 strikeouts and 30.0 innings pitched.
- ⚡ Sale is one of 18 pitchers in history with at least five monthly awards and the eighth left-hander of the group... He is the first Brave to win the award since teammate Max Fried did so in September 2021.
- ⚡ The 35-year-old led the majors in ERA in May, ranked second among NL pitchers in strikeouts and WHIP, and tied for seventh in opponents' average.
- ⚡ Between April 19 and May 26, Sale had won each of his seven outings going a perfect 7-0 with a 1.17 ERA (6 ER/46.0 IP) with 58 strikeouts and just four walks.
  - ⚡ His wins in seven consecutive turns was the longest streak by a Braves starter since Russ Ortiz won eight straight outings in 2003...No Atlanta starter has a longer streak of consecutive starts with a win since Ortiz.
- ⚡ Is 8-2 on the season and 6-0 at Truist Park.
- ⚡ Scattered four hits over 7.0 innings of one-run ball while fanning eight Pittsburgh hitters and collecting his eighth win of the season on May 26.
- ⚡ His 83 career games with 10 or more strikeous are the ninth most in baseball history (dating to 1901)...Needs one more to tie Hall-of-Famer Steve Carlton.
- ⚡ Morton and Chris Sale become the first pair of teammates to have each made an Opening Day start and record the last out of a World Series since Hall-of-Famer Dennis Eckersley and Cy Young award-winner Bret Saberhagen with Boston in 1998... Research courtesy of Elias Sports Bureau.
  - ⚡ Morton was the Opening Day starter for Tampa Bay in 2020 and induced a groundout from Corey Seager for the final out in Game 7 of the 2017 World Series with Houston.
  - ⚡ Sale was the Opening Day starter for the Red Sox (2018-'19) and the White Sox (2013, '14 & '16)...He struck out Manny Machado in Game 5 as the final out of the '18 Fall Classic with Boston.
- ⚡ Pitching to a 4.50 ERA in the first frame while sporting a 2.73 ERA in all other innings.

- ⚡ Surrendered a leadoff home run in consecutive games on 4/19 and 4/26 for the first time in his career.
- ⚡ Prior to this season, he had only allowed three leadoff home runs in his career (2014, '16, '19), but has now doubled his career total in just five starts this year.
- ⚡ Was acquired via trade from the Red Sox in exchange for INF Vaughn Grissom and cash considerations on December 30, 2023...signed a two-year contract with the Braves on January 4.

### Career Recap

- ⚡ **Awards:** AL All-Star (7x, 2012-18), World Series Champion (2018).
- ⚡ Entering his 15th major league season, Sale was been selected to seven consecutive AL All-Star teams from 2012-2018, and has seven career Top 10 finishes in Cy Young voting.
- ⚡ He is the only player in major league history to record at least 200 strikeouts with 50 or fewer walks issued in seven separate seasons.
- ⚡ Hall-of-Famers Pedro Martínez and Roy Halladay are the next closest pitchers with five such seasons.

- **Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...Is one of two pitchers in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed...Also Justin Martinez (ARI).**
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 59.2% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 94th percentile.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .059 (2-for-34) off him, which leads Major League Baseball (min. 30 BF with RISP).**
- **Is carrying an active scoreless streak of 13.1 innings...Among relievers, it's the second-longest active in the majors (2024 only)...Pedro Avila (CLE, 14.0 IP) leads him.**
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.78) ranks seventh behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63), Mike Remlinger (2.74) and Luis Avilán (2.77).
- By Run Value, Chavez owns the fourth most valuable cutter (8 RV, tied) in baseball among both starters and relievers...Corbin Burnes (BAL, 12), Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 11) and Garrett Crochet (CWS, 10) are the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 54% of his offerings.
- Among the 27 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older, Chavez owns the best ERA in the National League and second-best in MLB (1.21)...Texas' Kirby Yates is the only player to lead him in that regard (1.03).
- Just one of Chavez's 13 inherited runners has scored, posting the second-best percentage (7.7%) in the National League (min. 10 IR) behind Hunter Harvey (WSH, 7.7%).
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,005 strikeouts rank sixth behind Craig Kimbrel (1,231), Aroldis Chapman (1,192), Kenley Jansen (1,190), David Robertson (1,104) and Matt Moore (1,036).
