

## San Francisco Giants 10, Los Angeles Dodgers 4

June 30, 2024 | Oracle Park

The **Giants** grabbed their first series victory over the Dodgers here at Oracle Park since sweeping LA in a three-game set here from June 10-12, 2022.

- SF's 21 runs scored this weekend were their most in a three-game home series against the Dodgers in Oracle Park history (since 2000).
- Each of SF's nine starters collected a hit today, marking the first time every player in SF's starting lineup has recorded a hit since June 11, 2023 vs. CHC.
- The Giants have scored at least three runs in each of their last 11 games dating to June 19, the longest active streak in MLB...it also matches SF's longest 3+ run game streak this season (also: May 15-27).
- With an attendance of 40,428, the Giants had recorded their third straight sellout and ninth this season.

**RHP Spencer Bivens (W, 5.0ip, 4h, r, er, 3k, hr)** threw a career-high 5.0 innings today...entering today, Bivens had only reached the 5.0-inning mark twice in his minor league career (81 games).

 Today also marked his first MLB start...he had started just four minor league games in his career. **IF Matt Chapman (1x3, r, hr, 3rbi, bb)** logged his 11th home run of the season...he hit safely in each of the seven games on the homestand.

 In the seven games, Chapman slashed .385/.452/.808 with five extra-base hits (two doubles, three homers), seven runs and nine RBI.

**DH Jorge Soler (2x4, 2r, 22b, rbi, bb, k)** slashed .284/.361/.484 (.845 OPS) in 26 games during June...he had 10 doubles, three homers, 15 RBI and 21 runs scored.



The **Dodgers** dropped their 10th series of the season and first since losing two-of-three vs. Texas June 11-13 at Dodger Stadium.

**LHP James Paxton (L, 4.0ip, 12h, 9r, 9er, 2bb, 4k, hr)** allowed a career-high 12 hits in today's game...it's the 10th time this year any MLB pitcher has allowed 12 hits in a game.

- Paxton's nine runs allowed also matched a career-high (also September 22, 2014 at Toronto with Seattle).
- His seven extra-base hits allowed also matched a career-high (also July 26, 2019 at Boston with New York-AL).

**Kiké Hernández (3x4, r, 2b)** recorded a season-high three hits today.
