



# San Diego Padres (5-6) vs. San Francisco Giants (3-6)

**SUNDAY, SUNDAY, SUNDAY:** SF looks to win its first series of the season with a victory in this afternoon's series finale with San Diego...the series is tied at a game apiece after San Diego won last night's game 4-0.

- ▶ Today's game will end a stretch of 10 straight games against division foes to open the 2024 campaign...SF's next three series will all be non-division opponents (vs. Washington, at Tampa Bay and at Miami).
- ▶ In fact, only two of the Giants' next 10 series will be against divisional foes (a four-game series vs. Arizona April 18-21 and a three-game series in Colorado May 7-9).

**ACE HIGH:** The Giants send **RHP Logan Webb** to the hill in search of their first series victory this afternoon.

- ▶ On Tuesday, Webb only worked 3.2 innings and allowed five runs in the Giants 5-4 loss down at Chavez Ravine...Webb, who led MLB in innings pitched last season, only had one start all of last year where he failed to complete 5.0 innings... that start came on July 22 at Washington (1.1ip, 5h, 6r).
- ▶ Webb has been superb against the Padres in his last five starts against them, going 2-1 with a 1.23 ERA (5er, 36.2ip) and 28 strikeouts...despite the super ERA, the Giants as a team are 2-3 in those five outings.
- ▶ The righty's last outing vs. the Padres here at Oracle came last September 25 when Webb twirled the second complete game of his 2023 season (and career)...he limited SD to one run on nine hits with seven strikeouts.
- ▶ This afternoon's outing is Webb's first start at home in 2024...a season ago he went 7-6 with a 2.26 ERA in 16 home starts...SF as a team was 8-8 in Webb's 16 starts at Oracle.

**GETTING COMFORTABLE:** **OF Michael Conforto** walked in his final at-bat in the 8th inning last night and has reached base safely in each of his nine games so far this season.

- ▶ He is slashing .382/.432/.765 with four doubles, three homers and 10 RBI...he currently ranks inside MLB's top-10 in batting average (10th), RBI (T-7th), slugging percentage (5th), OPS (1.197, 5th), hits (13, T-9th), extra-base hits (seven, T-3rd) and total bases (26, 3rd).

**'PEN TO PAPER:** Rookie **RHPs Landen Roupp** and **Nick Avila** continued the recent run of mostly clean bullpen innings for SF last night despite the loss...the duo combined for 3.0 scoreless innings, two hits allowed and one strikeout.

- ▶ After a tough start to the season, the Giants bullpen has performed better in recent days...SF relievers have allowed just one run (a HR) on eight hits with 12 strikeouts over their last four games in 12.1ip (0.73 ERA), as opposed to a 10.00 ERA (20er, 18.0ip) with four homers and 10 walks over their first five contests.
- ▶ The Giants have needed to rely heavily on their young pitchers, with four relievers make their MLB debuts in the past week (**RHP Nick Avila**, **LHP Erik Miller**, **RHP Landen Roupp**, **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**).

**HATS FOR BATS:** Over their last six games dating to March 31, the Giants are slashing .188/.283/.302 as a team...the Giants have averaged 3.0 runs/game in that stretch (18 runs in six games) and are 1-5 in those six contests

**RUN AROUND:** SF pitching has allowed 52 runs through its first nine games...the 52 runs are the fourth-most allowed by a Giants team through the first nine games of a season...only the 1999 and 1983 Giants (54 runs) and 2009 Giants (53 runs) allowed more.

- ▶ SF's 52 runs allowed are tied for fourth-most in MLB with the Dodgers...only the Rockies (73), Marlins (62) and Padres (57) have allowed more...the Dodgers and Padres, however have played two more games.

**THANKS FOR WAXING MY CAR, ROOK:** Through the first nine games, the Glants have had five different players make their MLB debuts this year (**RHP Nick Avila**, **OF Jung Hoo Lee**, **LHP Erik Miller**, **RHP Landen Roupp** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**)

- ▶ That total is most in the Majors entering play today ahead of San Diego (four), Oakland (three) and six other teams that have had two players make their debuts.

**HARD KNOCKS:** The Giants are hitting the ball harder than anyone this season after ranking in the bottom half of the Majors in 2023 (depicted in the table below).

**SELLOUT, WITH ME, OHYEAH:** SF logged is second consecutive shutout yesterday...it's the first time since September 3 and 4, 2022 the Giants have had two consecutive home sellouts.

- ▶ The Giants had four home sellouts all of last season...the first was Opening Day vs. KC but they did not log their second until July 3 vs. Seattle.

**IT ALL COMES OUT IN THE WASH:** The Giants welcome the Washington Nationals to Oracle Park for a three-game series beginning tomorrow night.

- ▶ SF went just 1-5 versus the Nationals last year (1-2 here at Oracle and 0-3 at Nationals Park).
- ▶ **LHP Blake Snell** will make his Giants debut tomorrow night... Snell is 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (7er, 27.0ip) in five lifetime starts against the Nationals...his teams have gone 4-1 in those five games.

**WEBB GEMS:** SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension last April that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his first loss of the season on Tuesday night in Los Angeles at the hands of the Dodgers in SF's 5-4 defeat...Webb allowed all five of LA's runs on seven hits (one homer by Mookie Betts) in just 3.2 innings of work...he struck out five and walked two while throwing 96 pitches...for comparison, Webb used 97 pitches to navigate 6.0 innings on Opening Day down in San Diego.

**AN OUTLIER:** Webb's outing in LA was certainly rare in the fact that he did not complete 5.0 innings...he had one start all of last season where he failed to complete 5.0 innings and that start came on July 22 at Washington...in that outing, Webb permitted six runs on five hits in 1.1 innings at Nationals Park.

**VS. SAN DIEGO:** Is facing the Padres for a second time in the first 10 games of this season after facing them only once all of last year...in 11 games (10 starts) vs. SD in his career, Webb is 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA (18er, 63.2ip)...here at Oracle Park, Webb has been even better against the Pads, boasting a 1.77 ERA (7er, 35.2ip) in six games (five starts) against them...last time he faced them here on September 25, 2023 he spun the second complete game of his career (and season) with 9.0 innings of one-run ball in a 2-1 Giants win.

**NOT AS EASY AS 1-2-3?:** In Webb's last five starts vs. San Diego dating to April 13, 2022 the righty has gone 2-1 with a 1.23 ERA (5er, 36.2ip) with 28 strikeouts...Padres hitters are batting .214 off Webb in those five outings...despite that, SF is 2-3 as a team in those five games.

**IT'S THE BREAKDOWN:** Below is chart breaking down Webb's pitch usage between his Opening Day start at San Diego and his last start against the Dodgers on Tuesday...Webb told reporters postgame in LA he thought he didn't throw his changeup enough...data seems to back that up...Webb's 14 changeups thrown last time out were his fewest in a single game since he only threw 11 on September 21, 2022 at Colorado.

**IN THE OPENER...:** Webb took a no-decision in San Diego on March 28 after working 6.0 innings of two-run ball versus the Padres at Petco...Webb left the outing trailing 2-1 before the Giants scored twice in the top of the seventh to put him in line for a win...it was short-lived, however, as San Diego went back ahead off the Giants bullpen in the bottom half of the seventh...with the Opening Day nod, Webb became the first Giants starter to get three consecutive Opening Day nods since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** started four consecutive Opening Days from 2014-2017.

**WHERE SAGUARO CACTUS GROW...:** Webb's Cactus League numbers were a bit rough with him posting a 10.97 ERA in six starts...on the positive side, Webb struck out 22 and walked only three.

**BAND TOGETHER:** The Giants as a team are 54-39 (.581) in Webb's 93 regular season starts since 2021...SF went 15-18 in his 33 starts in 2023 and gave him two or fewer runs of support in 22 of those 33 starts (66.7%)...Webb had the lowest run support average of any qualified starter in baseball last year (3.21)...the next closest pitcher was Oakland's J.P. Sears (3.39)...Webb went 9-1 in 2023 when receiving at least three runs of support...in his first starts of 2024 he's received three and two runs of support, respectively.

**A RECORD YEAR:** Last season, Webb finished second in the NL Cy Young voting behind current rotation-mate **LHP Blake Snell**...Webb went 11-13 with a 3.25 ERA, setting new career bests in starts (33), innings pitched (216.0), strikeouts (194) and fewest walks in a full season (31)...his 216.0 innings a season ago led the Majors, something someone 26 or younger had not done on any Major League team since Justin Verlander did so as a 26-year-old in 2009...Webb was the first Giant to lead MLB in innings pitched since **Gaylord Perry** in 1970.

**2023 LEADERBOARDS:** Outside of leading MLB in innings pitched, and being tied for the lead in quality starts, Webb ranked among the Majors' best in ERA (3.25, 10th), complete games (two, T-3rd), games started (33, T-3rd) and WHIP (1.07, 6th).

**QUALITY EATS:** Webb's 24 quality starts were most in the National League, and tied for most in MLB with NYY's Gerrit Cole...he's the first Giant to lead or share the league lead in quality starts since **Rick Reuschel** led with 28 quality starts in 1988 (Stats, LLC).

**BOOTS ON THE GROUND:** Webb's 62.7% ground-ball rate led the Majors in 2023, and was up from 2022's 57.8% mark and above his career average of 59.5%...his 62.1% mark last season also established a career-best, slightly upping his 62.4% total from his breakout 2021 campaign.

**EL CAMBIO:** Webb dominated hitters last year with his changeup, using the pitch 41.6% of the time with opponents hitting .225 with a .309 SLG% off the pitch...according to Statcast, Webb's changeup was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball) (run value is defined as the run impact on an event based on the runners on base, outs ball & strike count).
