SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles extended their sweepless streak to 105 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) on Wednesday, which ties the 1903 -
05 New York Giants for the third-longest such streak in ML 05 New York Giants for the third-longest such streak in MLB history...According to the Elias
Sports Bureau, Baltimore's current streak trails only the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115)...During this current stretch, the O's have now avoided being swept in the final game of a series 14 times: May 15 vs . Toronto (2G), May 8,2024 at Washington (2G), April 14, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (3G), August 10, 2023 vs. Houston ( $3 G$ ), July 19, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3G), July 2, 2023 vs. Minnesota (3G), June 18, 2023 at Chicago-NL (3G), June 8, 2023 at Milwaukee (3G), May 28, 2023 vs. Texas (3G), September 21, 2022 vs. Detroit (3G), September 18, 2022 at Toronto (3G), July 3, 2022 at Minnesota (3G), June 11, 2022 at Kansas City (3G), and May 19, 2022 vs. New York-AL (4G)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regularseason series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit ( $0-3$ ), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay ( $0-3$ )...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Gunnar Henderson and Colton Cowser were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's claimed both awards in the same month.

CITY CONNECT FRIDAYS: The Orioles will wear their City Connect jerseys at each Friday home game throughout the regular season...This year, every City Connect Friday will be dedicated to a Baltimore City public school...To learn more, visit Orioles.com/CityConnect

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the $0^{\prime}$ 's to an AL-best $101-61$ record, their second straight winning campaign and the first
time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the $A L$. He made his Postseason time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL... He made his Postseason the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year Hyde's 342 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver $(1,480)$.
