WEDNESDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles rallied in the ninth inning to beat the Blue Jays, 3-2... **Adley Rutschman** hit a walk-off two-run home run as the O's avoided the two-game sweep... **Jordan Westburg**, in his first MLB game as a leadoff batter, homered to begin the game... Four relievers combined to throw 5.0 scoreless innings for the Orioles.

- ⚬ Marked the fourth time in MLB history a team hit a leadoff and walk-off home run which accounted for all the team's runs in a game, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*; the other times were in 1983 (PHI, 9/2 vs. SF), 1971 (OAK, 8/22 vs. BOS), and 1966 (ATL, 8/9 vs. LAD).
- ⚬ Rutschman's game-ending blast was hit with a launch angle of 43 degrees, tied for the sixth-highest on any home run by an Oriole during the *Statcast* era (since 2015) and the highest since Rio Ruiz on April 6, 2021 at New York-AL (also 43°); marked the second-highest on a walk-off home run during the *Statcast* era behind Houston's Tyler White on August 29, 2018 vs. Oakland (44°).
- ⚬ Westburg's leadoff homer was the fourth by the O's this season (Henderson, 3x, last: 4/29 vs. NYY); Baltimore's four such home runs are tied with Arizona and Philadelphia for most in MLB in 2024.
- ⚬ Baltimore avoided losing a third straight game for the first time this season; only the Cubs and Phillies have also avoided dropping three straight in 2024.

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 27-14 (.650), the Orioles have the second-best record in the AL and third-best in MLB... Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 211-154 (.578), the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.584, 215-153), Braves (.635, 231-133), and Dodgers (.649, 240-130).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 64 home runs, tied for the second-most homers through the first 41 games of a season in O's history with 2012 and trailing 1987 (66)... The most through Baltimore's first 42 games of a season is 66 in 1987.

- ⚬ The Orioles have an MLB-best seven players with at least six homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (12), **Adley Rutschman** (9), **Anthony Santander** and **Jordan Westburg** (7), and **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, and **Cedric Mullins** (6); the Yankees rank second with five players with at least six long balls.
- ⚬ Henderson's 12 home runs are tied for second in MLB with Atlanta's Marcell Ozuna, Cleveland's Josh Naylor, and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani, trailing only Houston's Kyle Tucker (13).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** enters today tied for third in the AL in hits (53) and fourth in batting average (.314)... He ranks tied for second in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB in multi-hit games (17).

- ⚬ He's homered in three straight games for the first time in his career and is the third Oriole to do so this year (O'Hearn, 4/14-16 & Henderson, 4/15-17); no Oriole has gone deep in four consecutive contests since DJ Stewart from September 5-9, 2020.
- ⚬ Rutschman has hit four home runs during those three games, the first Bird to accomplish the feat since **Anthony Santander**, who hit two home runs in back-to-back games on September 26-27, 2022 at Boston.
- ⚬ He's hit safely in 21 of his last 23 games since April 19 and 26 of his last 29 since April 11; for the season, he has reached safely in 34 of his 40 games and has a hit in 33 of those.
- ⚬ Since April 19, Rutschman is slashing .340/.359/.620 (34-for-100) with four doubles, eight homers, 12 runs, 20 RBI, three walks (11BB), and a stolen base; the home runs are tied for the MLB lead and the hits lead the AL during that time; he also ranks among AL leaders over that period in batting average (2nd), total bases (2nd, 62), and RBI (T-3rd).
- ⚬ He had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

WESTY'S WORLD: **Jordan Westburg** ranks among AL leaders in batting average (8th, .301), slugging percentage (8th, .534), and OPS (10th, .888)... He's recorded a hit in seven of eight games since May 5 while slashing .344/.400/.656 (11-for-32) with four doubles, two homers, five runs scored, seven RBI, and a stolen base during that time.

- ⚬ He and Mariners starter Bryce Miller were high school teammates at New Braunfels (TX) High School; Westburg went 0-for-2 against Miller on August 13, 2023 in Seattle.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue their season-long eight-game homestand tonight with the first of three games against the Mariners (was originally a nine-game homestand before Tuesday's game was postponed due to inclement weather)... Baltimore took two of three against Arizona over the weekend and split a weather-shortened two-game set with Toronto earlier this week.

- ⚬ Since the start of 2023, the O's are 64-41 (.610) at Oriole Park, the second-best home record in the AL (TB, 67-40, .626) and the fifth-best mark at home in MLB.

AGAINST SEATTLE: The O's and Mariners meet for the first time this season this weekend at Camden Yards... Following these three games, the Birds will travel to Seattle from July 2-4 to complete the season series... Baltimore went 4-2 against the M's in 2023, with three of those games going to extra innings and another being decided by one run.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles extended their sweepless streak to 105 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) on Wednesday, which ties the 1903-05 New York Giants for the third-longest such streak in MLB history... According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baltimore's current streak trails only the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115)... During this current stretch, the O's have now avoided being swept in the final game of a series 14 times: May 15 vs. Toronto (2G), May 8, 2024 at Washington (2G), April 14, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (3G), August 10, 2023 vs. Houston (3G), July 19, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3G), July 2, 2023 vs. Minnesota (3G), June 18, 2023 at Chicago-NL (3G), June 8, 2023 at Milwaukee (3G), May 28, 2023 vs. Texas (3G), September 21, 2022 vs. Detroit (3G), September 18, 2022 at Toronto (3G), July 3, 2022 at Minnesota (3G), June 11, 2022 at Kansas City (3G), and May 19, 2022 vs. New York-AL (4G)... Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72... The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)... The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April... It marks the first time in team history that the O's claimed both awards in the same month.

CITY CONNECT FRIDAYS: The Orioles will wear their City Connect jerseys at each Friday home game throughout the regular season... This year, every City Connect Friday will be dedicated to a Baltimore City public school... To learn more, visit orioles.com/CityConnect.

- ⚬ The O's own a 6-9 record when wearing their City Connect uniforms (5-8 in all black, 1-1 in black jerseys/white pants).

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore... In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL... He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Oriole manager to win the award... He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year... Hyde's 342 wins rank fifth all-time among Oriole managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Oriole Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his third start of the season this evening against the Mariners...Made his season debut on May 4 at Cincinnati, tossing 7.0 shutout innings... Began the year on the 15-day Injured List (left forearm strain)...Reinstated on May 1 after making six rehab starts for Triple-A Norfolk...Underwent UCL reconstruction (Tommy John) by Dr. Keith Meister on April 27, 2022, and missed the rest of that season...Threw the sixth no-hitter in team history on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Named to his first career All-Star team in 2019, the lone Orioles representative...Finished second in American League Rookie of the Year voting, the first Orioles runner-up in the Rookie of the Year voting since 2002 (RHP Rodrigo López)...Selected by the Orioles in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of West Virginia University.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on May 11 vs. Arizona after allowing four runs on six hits (1HR) and one hit batter with three strikeouts across 4.2 innings... Extended his scoreless streak to 10.1 innings, dating back to his final start last year on September 29, 2023 vs. Boston, before allowing a two-run homer in the third inning to Ketel Marte...Threw 89 pitches, 60 strikes.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: Scheduled to make his fourth career start against the Mariners and his first since tossing the sixth no-hitter in Orioles history on May 5, 2021 in Seattle...Owns a lifetime 2-0 record with a 1.71 ERA (4 ER/21.0 IP) in his three prior starts against the M's.

WILD WILD AL WEST: Making his 13th career start against the AL West...Owns a 5-3 record with a 1.97 ERA (16 ER/73.0 IP) in his 12 previous starts; the 1.97 ERA is his lowest mark against any division...Opponents are slashing .181/.234/.342 (47-for-260) off him...Did not factor into the decision in his last time out against an AL West foe on September 18, 2023 at Houston; allowed one run on four hits and three walks with one strikeout across 5.0 innings...Has never surrendered more than three earned runs in a start against the division...Recorded eight quality starts in nine outings against AL West opponents in a stretch from May 12, 2019 to May 5, 2021.

YOU CAN'T CLIP MEANS' WINGS: Tossed 6.1 innings, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) with four strikeouts in his only career start wearing the Orioles City Connect jerseys on September 29, 2023 vs. Boston

AT HOME: Has gone 2-10 with a 5.18 ERA (61 ER/106.0 IP) in 22 home starts since the start of the 2020 season...In his career, he has gone 10-15 with a 4.05 ERA (89 ER/198.0 IP) in 40 appearances (38 GS) at Oriole Park.

DAY 'N NITE: Owns a lifetime 14-15 record with a 3.38 ERA (95 ER/252.2 IP) in 46 career night starts, compared to an 8-11 record with a 4.28 ERA (61 ER/128.1 IP) in 25 career daytime starts.

ON THE MEND: Prior to his reinstatement on May 1, Means made six rehab starts for the Tides...In those games, he went 1-2 with an 8.68 ERA (18 ER/18.2 IP) and 22 strikeouts against seven walks...In his last rehab start on April 28 vs. Gwinnett, he earned the win after tossing 7.0 shutout, one-hit innings with a walk, a hit batter, and eight strikeouts...Threw 95 pitches, 61 strikes in that outing.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER/23.2 IP) with 13 hits (4 HR), four walks, one hit batter, and 10 strikeouts in four starts for the O's...Began the season on the 60-day Injured List (left elbow UCL surgery)...Started a rehab assignment with Double-A Bowie on August 10 and made three starts for the Baysox before having his assignment transferred to Triple-A Norfolk for three starts on August 25...Made his first MLB appearance in 517 days on September 12 vs. St. Louis...Did not allow a hit in the first 20 outs on September 23 at Cleveland before Andrés Giménez hit a solo home run; became the first O's pitcher with 6.2 no-hit innings since he no-hit Seattle at T-Mobile Park on May 5, 2021, and the first Orioles hurler to take a no-hitter into the seventh inning since LHP Keegan Akin (6.0 IP) on September 11 (G2), 2021 vs. Toronto...Retired the first 13 batters faced on September 29 vs. Boston...Did not appear on the O's ALDS roster after experiencing left elbow soreness.

HE MEANS BUSINESS: Threw the sixth no-hitter in O's history on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Marked the first Orioles no-hitter since a combined effort by Bob Milacki, Mike Flanagan, Mark Williamson, and Gregg Olson on July 13, 1991 at Oakland, and the first individual no-hitter by an O's hurler since Jim Palmer on August 13, 1969 vs. Oakland...It was the first complete game of his career, while he became the first southpaw to throw a no-hitter in team history (since 1954)...Means' only baserunner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by Pedro Severino; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Means was the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...His 12 strikeouts were the most by an O's hurler in a no-hitter and tied a career high (also: 9/20/20 vs. TB)...Became the second pitcher in AL history to toss a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Felix Hernández, who worked a perfect game on August 15, 2012...Named the AL Player of the Week on May 10, the first Orioles pitcher to accomplish the feat since Arthur Rhodes in August 1994.
