FINAL TWO ON THE ROAD	
The Washington Nationals continue their last road series of the season against the Detroit Tigers with the second of three games tonight...Washington has won six of its last nine games...The Nationals 73 wins this season are their most since 2019 when they won 93.	
Following this series, the Nationals will return home for the final three games of the season against the New York Mets from Friday-Sunday.	
ONE MORE WOOD WALK	
With one more walk, James Wood would become the first player in Major League history to hit 30 home runs, steal 20 bases and walk 100 times while playing in less than 140 games in a season.	
He would become just the 10th player to accomplish the feat while playing in any number of games, joining Shohei Ohtani (2025), Juan Soto (2025), Paul Goldschmidt (2015), Bobby Abreu (2001, '04), HOF Jeff Bag-well (1996-97, '99), HOF Chipper Jones (1999), Barry Bonds (1992-93, '95-'98), HOF Mike Schmidt (1974-75) and Jimmy Wynn (1969).	
START ME UP	
In 26 games since Aug. 19, Simon Mathews' starting pitchers/openers rank in MLB in opponents' slugging (1st, .319), opponents' average (1st, .202), home runs allowed (1st, 11), opponents' OPS (2nd, .614) and ERA (3rd, 3.04).	
- Starters/openers have allowed just five home runs in 101.1 innings across the last 22 games. - Starters/openers have not allowed a run in four of the last eight games, pitching to a 2.86 ERA (11 ER/34.2 IP) with 42 strikeouts and a .188 opponents average.	
30/30/20 BEFORE 26	
CJ Abrams and James Wood are just the fifth pair of teammates in Major League history to record 30 home runs, 30 doubles and 20 stolen bases in the same season, joining Francisco Lindor/José Ramírez (CLE, 2018), Carlos Beltrán/David Wright (NYM, 2007), Ken Griffey Jr./Alex Rodriguez (SEA, 1998) and Ellis Burks/Dante Bichette (COL, 1996).	
Wood and Abrams are just the second pair of teammates to accomplish the feat while both were 25 years old or younger, joining Lindor and Ramírez.	
CJ, DAYLEN AND JAMES...THE 25 AND UNDER CLUB	
CJ Abrams (31 HR, 99 RBI) and Daylen Lile (21 HR, 88 RBI) have both eclipsed the 20 HR/80 RBI mark this year, while James Wood (30 HR, 76 RBI) is close to joining them.	
- There are only 10 players in MLB age 25 and younger to hit the 20/80 mark this season and Washington is the only team with more than one player in that group...With four more RBI, James Wood joins the club. - If Wood reaches the 80 RBI mark, the 2026 Nationals would become the eighth team in Major League history with at least three players age 25 and younger to record a 20/80 season. - The last team to do so was the 2007 Milwaukee Brewers, who hold the record with four (Ryan Braun, Prince Fielder, J.J. Hardy, Corey Hart)...The last team to have three was the 1999 Kansas City Royals (Carlos Beltrán, Jermaine Dye, Mike Sweeney).	
ALIEN ENCOUNTERS	
CJ Abrams has reached safely in seven of his last eight games, including hits in six, three multi-hit efforts and an extra-base hit in five of the eight...Abrams is 9-for-33 (.273) with four doubles, a homer, four RBI, five stolen bases and five runs scored over his last eight games.	
- With one more RBI, Abrams will become the 12th player in Nationals history to record 100 RBI in a season and first since Anthony Rendon (126) and Juan Soto (110) in 2019. - He joins Alfonso Soriano (40 HR/41 SB in 2006) as the only two players in Nationals history with at least 30 home runs and 30 stolen bases in a season...Only Abrams and Pete Crow-Armstrong have reached the 30/30 mark in MLB this season. - Also of note, Abrams leads Major League Baseball with an 86% ABS Challenge success rate (min. 10 chal-lenges)...He is 12-for-14 in ABS Challenges this season. - Abrams homered and stole a base in the same game on Sunday for the fourth time this season and the 12th time in his career...His 12 career games with a home run and a stolen base are the most in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

The Nationals boast 10 players with at least 10 home runs this season: CJ Abrams, James Wood, Luis García Jr., Daylen Lile, Curtis Mead, Dylan Crews, Andres Chaparro, Brady House, Keibert Ruiz and Jacob Young .	
- Washington ranks third behind the New York Mets (11) and with the New York Yankees (11) for the most players with at least 10 home runs this season. - The 2026 Nationals join the 2019 and 2017 clubs as the only teams in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with at least 10 players to hit at least 10 home runs in a season.

The Rochester Red Wings (90-58, 45-30) punched their ticket to the postseason in emphatic fashion Sunday after-noon, erasing an early four-run deficit and launching eight home runs and 19 total hits en route to a 15-8 victory over the Buffalo Bisons (33-39, 68-79) in the regular-season finale...The win clinched Rochester's first postseason berth since 2013 and gave the Red Wings 90 victories in a season for the first time since 1953.
