WHIP: 0.93 K/9: 11.12 BB/9: 2.20
vs. ALL: .189 (53-for-280) vs. LHB: .194 (25-for-129) vs. RHB: .185 (28-for-151)
Picked up his first save of the season on 9/25 at NYY, the third of his career, and his first since 8/11/22 at TEX after completing 0.2 perfect inning; in his two prior career saves, had thrown at least 3.0 innings
Has allowed one earned run over 10 games this month (10.1 IP) on six hits (1 HR), two walks, and 14 strikeouts
His 13 relief appearances with three or more strikeouts are tied for the third most in MLB with NYY's Mark Leiter Jr., trailing NYY's Luke Weaver (16) and OAK's Mason Miller (14)
Was charged with the loss and a blown save on 9/11 at BOS after allowing a three-run walk-off homer to Tyler O'Neill in the 10th inning with the team leading 3-2; marked his first loss since 6/28/23 vs. CIN and his third blown save of the year (last: 6/12 vs. ATL)
Reinstated from the Paternity List on 8/23 after the birth of his daughter, Kennedy
Ranks among MLB leaders in xBA (96th percentile, .189), xwOBA (96th, .251), xERA (96th, 2.54), K% (93rd, 31.2), wOBA (93rd, .250), and xSLG (91st, .324), per Statcast
His 96 strikeouts lead O's relievers

Worked a perfect ninth inning with one strikeout on 9/21 vs. DET, his first perfect outing since 7/23 at MIA; marked his first O's outing since 8/16 vs. BOS
Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk on 9/18; was optioned on 8/17; marks his fourth stint with the O's this season (also recalled 6/11, 7/25, and 8/7)
Went 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA (2 ER/7.1 IP) in seven appearances for the Tides since last being optioned
Suffered his first loss of the year after allowing three runs on one hit and two walks with two strikeouts on 7/4 at SEA; all three runs scored after he exited
Has gone 2-1 with a 5.17 ERA (18 ER/31.1 IP) and 43 strikeouts to 16 walks in 32 outings with the Tides this year

Allowed four runs on four hits (1 HR) with one strikeout in 0.1 inning on 9/25 at NYY; marked his first home run surrendered since 6/10 vs. CWS (w/SEA)
Has not been charged with a run in 11 of his 13 appearances with the O's
Earned the win on 8/27 at LAD with 1.2 perfect innings, his first win since 9/5/19 vs. PHI (w/CIN); began his Orioles career with three perfect outings (4.0 IP)
Signed a minor league contract with the Orioles on 8/15
Pitched to a 5.40 ERA (9 ER/15.0 IP), allowing 11 hits (3 HR) and seven walks with 10 strikeouts across 10 appearances with SEA, MIN, and ARI this season; five of the nine runs allowed came on 5/17 vs. DET (w/ARI)
Has appeared in an MLB game with seven different organizations, including the Orioles (SEA, AZ, MIN, NYY, CIN, & STL)

Recorded his team-leading 34th save of the season on 9/24 at NYY, tossing 0.2 inning on two hits; allowed two inherited runners to score
Has struck out multiple batters in four of seven September appearances and in seven of his last 12 appearances since 8/18; had two such games in his previous 23 games from 6/11-8/17
Worked 1.0 perfect inning with two strikeouts on 9/6 vs. TB; entered with the bases loaded and no outs before stranding all three runners, becoming the second Oriole to do so this season (Coulombe, 4/6 at PIT)
Recorded his 32nd hold of the season on 9/6 vs. TB, breaking the Orioles single-season holds record that he set last season when he led MLB with 31
His 34 holds rank third in MLB, trailing HOU's Bryan Abreu (37) and STL's Andrew Kittredge (36); since being recalled on 4/14/23, his 65 holds lead MLB, four more than SF's Tyler Rogers, who ranks second
Ranks in the 99th percentile in Groundball Rate (63.5), according to Statcast

Tossed a scoreless eighth inning on two hits with two strikeouts and a wild pitch on 9/20 vs. DET after being reinstated from the 60-day Injured List earlier in the day; marked his first MLB appearance since 6/8 at TB after being placed on the 15-day IL with left elbow inflammation on 6/11; transferred to the 60-day on 7/13 due to left elbow surgery
Appeared in three rehab games with Triple-A Norfolk; did not allow a run on two hits with two strikeouts in 2.2 innings
Tossed a season-high 2.0 perfect innings on 6/8 at TB with a season-high-tying three strikeouts
Has stranded all 13 inherited runners this season
Threw a perfect sixth inning, striking out the side on 5/23 at CWS; the three strikeouts tied a season high (4/9 at BOS)
Converted his first save of the season and third of his career on 4/29 vs. NYY
Appeared on his fifth Opening Day roster and second straight with the O's
Set career highs in holds (22) and strikeouts (58) in 2023

Recorded his 11th save of season, 10th with the Orioles, on 9/24 at NYY after tossing 0.2 scoreless inning; stranded an inherited runner
Suffered his first blown save as an Oriole and second of the year in the ninth inning on 9/19 vs. SF; walked the first two batters and allowed a game-tying single with one out before leaving with two on; both runners were stranded following a Gregory Soto double play on one pitch
Converted his first nine save opportunities to begin his O's career, the first to do so since George Sherill in 2008
Allowed walk-off home runs in two of three games at NYM on 8/19 (Alvarez) and 8/21 (Winker)
Made his O's debut on 7/26 vs. SD
Acquired with OF Cristian Pacheco from PHI for OF Austin Hays on 7/26
Was 3-2 with one save and a 4.75 ERA (19 ER/36.0 IP) with 12 walks and 40 strikeouts in 38 relief appearances with the Phillies this year

Notched his 22nd hold of the season on 9/24 at NYY after allowing two runs on two hits in 0.2 inning; both runs scored after he exited the game
Has allowed seven runs and 17 baserunners (12 H, 4 BB, 1 HBP) in nine outings (7.2 IP) this month; since 8/31, his ERA has risen from 3.63 to 4.30
Has not allowed a home run in 101 games since 6/3/23, the longest such streak in Orioles history and the longest in MLB since KC's Wade Davis (123, 9/4/13-7/28/15); also had a 53-game homerless stretch from 7/16/22-5/29/23, snapped 5/31/23 vs. CLE (2 HR); his 85.1 straight homerless IP is tied for the second longest in team history with Zack Britton (4/15/16-8/10/17)
Is one of three pitchers in MLB this season to not have a loss while appearing in at least 60 games; CLE's Nick Sandlin (67) has the most such games this year; CIN's Frank Williams in 1987 (85) has the most appearances in a season in MLB history without a loss, while KC's Peter Moylan in 2017 (79) holds the most in the AL
His 4.5 Barrel Percentage ranks in the 93rd percentile in MLB, while his 54.8 Groundball Rate is in the 92nd percentile, per Statcast
Leads the Orioles with 191 appearances since the start of 2022

Tossed a perfect eighth inning with two strikeouts on 9/25 at NYY
In 19 appearances since 8/8, has posted a 1-0 record with a 1.13 ERA (2 ER/16.0 IP) and a 0.94 WHIP after allowing eight runs in his first three O's appearances
Earned his first win as an Oriole and third of the season on 9/19 vs. SF; entered with runners on first and second and one out in the ninth inning of a tie game before inducing a double play on the first pitch; became the fourth Oriole since 2000 to earn a win and the first to get two outs when throwing one or no pitches
19 of the 34 lefties he's faced with the O's have reached (14 H, 4 BB, HBP)
Made his Orioles debut on 8/2 at CLE
Acquired by the Orioles from PHI on 7/30 in exchange for RHP Seth Johnson and minor league RHP Moisés Chace
Went 2-4 with two saves and a 4.08 ERA (16 ER/35.1 IP) on 36 hits (2 HR), 19 total runs allowed, six hit-by-pitches, 20 walks (2 HBP), and 44 strikeouts in 43 relief appearances for the Phillies this season
Is one of 10 pitchers in MLB that has made at least 60 appearances in each of the last four seasons from 2021-24

Earned his second win of the season on 9/25 at NYY, completing 1.1 innings on two hits with one strikeout; stranded two inherited runners
Reinstated from the 15-day IL on 9/15; was placed on the IL on 8/7, retroactive to 8/4, with right elbow inflammation
Made four rehab appearances across stints with Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk, posting a 10.80 ERA (4 ER/3.1 IP); all four runs scored in his lone outing with the Baysox on 9/4
Holding opposing left-handed batters to a .153/.247/.212 (13-for-85) slash line on the season; in seven appearances since 8/1, they are slashing .316/.300/.526 (6-for-19) off him after allowing five total hits to lefties in 33 outings between 5/10-7/29
Had a nine-game (11.0 IP) scoreless streak from 5/23-6/13; the stretch was snapped on 6/14 after two runners scored in the 11th inning
Earned his first win with the O's on 6/1 vs. TB; threw a career-high-tying 2.1 innings, his most as an Oriole; entered with the bases loaded and two outs and stranded all three inherited runners
Recorded his first save of the season and the fifth of his career on 4/30 vs. NYY; also earned a save in the 12th inning on 5/8 at WSH
