BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a nine-game road trip tonight against the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (3-0), and Rockies (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays...The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and 1.0 game behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

⚾ Yesterday, **Chris Bassitt** earned the win after working 5.2 innings, allowing five runs on eight hits (1 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts...Bassitt has won each of his last two starts when allowing at least five earned runs (also 4/22/26 at KC) after opening his career going 2-20 in starts when allowing 5+ earned runs.

⚾ **Coby Mayo** has scored a run in a career-high-tying five straight games (also 9/13-17/25), tied for the longest active streak in MLB along with PHI's Edmundo Sosa and CIN's Sal Stewart...Mayo also hit his sixth three-run homer of the year yesterday, tied for the AL lead with NYY's Ben Rice...The last Oriole with seven three-run homers in a season was Renato Núñez in 2019.

⚾ Sunday's win marked Baltimore's fifth series sweep of the season, joining July 17-19 at Houston, July 10-12 vs. Kansas City, May 25-27 vs. Tampa Bay, and April 6-8 at Chicago-AL.

⚾ Tonight, the Birds can win a fourth straight game for the first time since a season-best seven-game run from July 9-19, and move to .500 for the first time since winning Game 1 of the doubleheader on April 30 vs. Houston.

SCORING CHANGE: On August 25 at St. Louis, **Jackson Holliday** led off the game and reached on what was originally scored a throwing error by pitcher Matthew Liberatore...That call has since been overturned, with Holliday now being credited with a single.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles have made the following roster moves: Recalled **LHP Cade Povich** from Triple-A Norfolk, claimed **OF Luis Robert Jr.** off waivers from the New York Mets, optioned **RHP Anthony Nunez** to Triple-A Norfolk, and designated **INF Luis Vázquez** for assignment.

GUNNAR GOES OFF: **Gunnar Henderson** went 4-for-4 with a triple, two home runs, three runs, and five RBI in yesterday's win...He became the fifth Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) with a triple and two home runs in the same game, joining Nelson Cruz (9/7/14 at TB), Chris Richard (9/3/00 at CLE), Jeffrey Hammonds (7/5/97 at DET), and Cal Ripken, Jr. (4/13/91 at TEX).

⚾ He recorded a career-high 12 total bases, the most by an Oriole since **Ryan Mountcastle** (13) on June 19, 2021 vs. Toronto.

⚾ Henderson became the first left-handed hitting Oriole to hit two home runs off left-handed pitching in a game since Luke Scott on May 29, 2009 vs. Detroit.

PICKIN' IT: The Orioles have gone a season-high nine straight games without committing an error, the longest active streak in MLB ahead of the White Sox (7 G)...The Birds last went 10 straight games without an error from May 15-25, 2023.

ROAD TRIPPING: Since the All-Star Break, the O's are averaging 5.56 runs per game on the road, the second-highest figure in the majors behind the Cubs (6.42)...Prior to the break, the Birds averaged 4.32 runs per game away from Camden Yards, ranking 18th in the majors.

⚾ Baltimore is 16-9 (.640) on the road following the All-Star break, the most such wins in MLB ahead of Tampa Bay (15-8).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 34 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (41).

⚾ The O's have hit multiple home runs in nine of their last 14 road games (26 HR total).

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: In 18 career games at Coors Field, **Pete Alonso** is slashing .373/.427/.773 (28-for-75) with four doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 18 runs, and 18 RBI...Among all active players with at least 80 career plate appearances, his 1.200 career OPS at Coors Field is the highest in MLB, outpacing LAD's Shohei Ohtani (1.194).

⚾ Alonso enters play today with 91 RBI, ranking second in the AL behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (93)...Alonso looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

'PEN PALS: **Yennier Cano** has gone 47 consecutive appearances (35.2 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (61 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (52 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (48 G).

⚾ In 27 appearances since June 24, **Andrew Kittredge** has posted a 1.09 ERA (3 ER/24.2 IP) and seven saves.

⚾ **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 10 appearances (8.2 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5.

⚾ Over the last 10 games since August 20, Oriole relievers have pitched to a 1.10 ERA (4 ER/32.2 IP)...It is the lowest bullpen ERA in MLB during that period, ahead of the Braves (147) and Brewers (1.50).

⚾ Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 45-46 (.495) in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the second-most such games in MLB this season behind the Guardians (93 G).

⚾ Despite owning a 15-19 (.441) in one-run affairs this season, the Birds have won three straight and are 5-1 in their last six such games since August 14.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 34 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least six pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

⚾ **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, led by with CHC's Michael Conforto (4)...O'Neill's three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).

⚾ **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.

⚾ The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Povich is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season (7th appearance) tonight in the series opener at Colorado...Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster in 2025 and went 3-8 with a 5.21 ERA (65 ER/112.1 IP) on 125 hits (17 HR), 43 walks (2 IBB), one hit batter, and six wild pitches with 118 strikeouts in 22 appearances (20 GS)...Acquired from Minnesota along with **RHP Yennier Cano**, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nunez in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022.

- Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to tonight's game, marking his fourth stint with the Orioles this season.
- Spent time on the 15-day Injured List (left elbow inflammation) from May 8-June 27.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 10-5 Orioles victory on August 9 at Texas, allowing three runs in a season-low-tying 3.0 innings pitched (also 5/7 at MIA) on four hits (1 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts...Threw 61 pitches, 33 strikes.

Is 0-1 with a 7.47 ERA (13 ER/15.2 IP) over four road appearances (3 GS) this year compared to 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER/12.2 IP) in two home starts.

MILE HIGH: Povich is scheduled to make his first career start opposite Colorado...Over three career starts vs. the NL West, he is 2-1 with a 6.00 ERA (10 ER/15.0 IP) but has earned the win in each of his last two starts against the division, including his outing vs. San Francisco earlier this season on April 12 (6.2 IP, 1 ER, 5 H, 0 BB, 5 K).

Is 3-4 with a 5.28 ERA (36 ER/61.1 IP) over 12 career appearances (11 GS) vs. Interleague opponents, including a 1-0 mark and 3.52 ERA (6 ER/15.1 IP) in three games (2 GS) this season.

AHEAD OF THE CURVE: Through six major league appearances (5 GS) this season, opponents are slashing .158/.273/.211 (3-for-19) against Povich's curveball with a 38.9 percent whiff rate...Last season, hitters slashed .309/.358/.485 (30-for-97) on the curve with a 29.0 percent whiff rate.

Uses the pitch 27.0 percent of the time against right-handed batters, who are hitting .125 (2-for-16) off it with one double.

However, Povich has allowed a .270/.341/.622 (10-for-37) slash line on the curve in 13 minor league starts this year with a 38.6 percent whiff rate and four walks to 15 strikeouts.

SETTLING IN: In the first and second innings, owns a 6.30 ERA (7 ER/10.0 IP) with four doubles and three home runs (.989 OPS)...From the third inning on, has a 3.44 ERA (7 ER/18.1 IP) with one double and two home runs (.691 OPS).

However, all three of the runs he allowed in his last start on August 9 at Texas came in the third inning.

HEATING UP: Povich has recorded a run value of four on his four-seam fastball this season, the highest mark on any of his pitches...He is holding opponents to a .191/.269/.340 (9-for-47) average on the offering, which he is using a career-high 45.0 percent of the time compared to 37.2 percent in 2025.

Batters are 7-for-12 (.583) with three doubles against his sinker, which holds a negative two run value.

SMALL SAMPLE: Although he has tossed only 28.1 innings in the majors this season, Povich's 29.1 percent out of zone swing rate is up 2.5 percent from last season (26.6%), while his 30.8 percent first pitch swing rate is up 4.2 percent from 2025 (26.6%).

WHIFFIN': Recorded 17 swings and misses on April 12 vs. San Francisco, his second most in his career behind August 16, 2025 at Houston (18 whiffs)...Tallied a career-high seven whiffs on his curveball, surpassing his previous high of six (4x, last: 9/25/25 vs. TB).

MINORS RECAP: Povich has made 13 starts this season between Triple-A Norfolk (11 GS) and Double-A Chesapeake (2 GS), going 2-5 with a 5.46 ERA (35 ER/57.2 IP)...Has recorded a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) over his last three starts for Triple-A Norfolk following his last MLB appearance on August 9.

Held opponents to a .179/.198/.345 (15-for-84) slash line when ahead in the count with five doubles, three home runs, zero walks, and 35 strikeouts compared to a .354/.530/.667 (17-for-48) mark when behind in the count with three doubles, four home runs, 18 walks, and seven strikeouts.
