## SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (23-26) vS. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-26) May 22, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME \#50/HOME \#23 LHP BLAKE SNELL ( $0-3,11.57$ ERA) vs. RHP JARED JONES ( $3-4,2.89$ ERA)

THE PIRATES:...erased a four-run deficit in the ninth inning before winning 7-6 in 10 innings last night against the Giants...Have played in 12 games decided by one or two runs in their last 17 contests...Have also played in 18 one-run games overall, which are the second-most in MLB (the Cubs lead the way with 19)...Are tied with the Phillies and Cubs for the most wins (10) in one-run games in all of MLB...Have gone 19-3 when scoring at least four runs in a game... Won each of their first four extra inning games before losing for the only time on May 12 against the Cubs.... Have the second-most extra-inning wins (five) among all National League teams (the only two teams in all of MLB with more are the Marlins and Guardians with six apiece).

A GIANT COMEBACK: Last night the Pirates erased 6 - d deficitit the ninth inning before Nick Gonzales delivered the first walkoff RBI of his career in the 10th to complete a $7-6$ comeback win...It marked the sixth time since 2000 that the Pirates won a game in which the team trailed by four-plus runs in the ninth inning or later and the first time since July 12, 2008 vs. St. Louis...Special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

BANG FOR THE BUCS: Pittsburgh is $14-0$ this season when recording 10-plus hits in a game (the only undefeated team in the Majors in such games)...It matches the club record for the longest such streak to start a season along with the 1939 team that also started 14-0 when recording 10-plus hits to start the season.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Thursday night was the fifth game of seven-plus strikeouts and no walks allowed for Jared Jones after his first nine career starts...That's two more than the previous Major League record by a pitcher to start their career (Stephen Strasburg and Masahiro Tanaka held the previous high of three such games)... Jones has thrown 5.0-plus innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in each of his nine career starts, making him the 15th player since 1900 to put up those numbers in each of his first nine career games and the first since Cleveland's Aaron Civale did so in 2019.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES': Jared Jones has induced 155 swings-and-misses (whiffs) so far this season...That's the most of any pitcher through nine career starts since data started being tracked in 2008...Jones' fastball is averaging 97.3 mph this season and has topped 100.0 mph on 12 occasions.... He has logged seven-plus strikeouts in seven of his nine career outings, as well as 10 -plus punchouts twice...He has also had five starts this season without walking a batter...Gerrit Cole is the only Pittsburgh pitcher to have a longer such streak (10 straight in 2013).

CRUZ MISSILES: Oneil Cruz has the top two exit velocities in Major League Baseball this season as well as three of the top four...Cruz' RBI double in the ninth inning last night was hit 121.5 miles-per-hour, which topped his MLB-high exit velocity set earlier in the game in the first inning ( 120.4 miles-per-hour)...Cruz is the first player in the Statcast Era to have multiple hits of 120.0plus miles-per-hour in the same game and the first player in the Statcast Era to have three hits of 115.0-plus miles-per-hour in a single game.

GOING THE EXTRA MILE: Oneil Cruz leads all National League players with 12 extra base hits this month...Since May 5, the Pirates have the fourth-most extra base hits (47) among all National League teams behind the Brewers (52), Phillies (49) and Diamondbacks (48).

NICKY G: Nick Gonzales has gone 10-for-32 (.313) with a double, two home runs and seven RBI in his last eight games...Since his season debut on May 10, Gonzales' nine RBI leads the Pirates and are tied for the eighth-most in the National League.


CUTCH CLUTCH: Andrew McCutchen is hitting at a . 361 clip (13-for-36) with three homers, five RBI, eight runs scored and a . 452 OBP in his last nine games... McCutchen's 13 hits since May 11 are tied for the eighth-most in the National League (Kevin Newman leads with sixteen).

LOVING LEFTIES: The Pirates are $10-7$ in games started by opposing
lefthanders...The only two National League teams with more wins in games started by opposing southpaws are the Dodgers (13) and Phillies (12)...The Pirates have hit 18 home runs against left-handed pitchers this season, which are tied for the second-most in all of MLB along with the Astros (the Orioles lead with 24).


## ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 22, 1997: The Pirates erased a 3-1 deficit with a three-run seventh inning while going on to beat Montreal 9-3 at Olympic Stadium. Adrian Brown keved Pittsburgh's comeback with his first homer of the vear with a three-run shot in the seventh off Expos Carlos Perez. The Buccos scored two more times in the eighth and added three runs in the ninth as Jon Lieber recorded the win while Ricardo Rincon was credited with the save.

#### Abstract

TOMORROW'S STARTER PAUL SKENES: The 21-year-old righthander will make his third career start tomorrow afternoon in the finale of this three-game series against the Giants...Earned the first win of his big league career in his last start Friday against the Cubs at Wrigley Field after tossing 6.0 shutout, hitless innings while also striking out 11 batters (the most ever by a Pirate at Wrigley Field)...He had a no-decision (4.0ip+/3er) in his big league debut in the team's $10-9$ win against the Cubs on $5 / 11$ at PNC Park... Entered this season rated as the No. 1 pitching prospect (and third-best prospect overall) by MLB Pipeline...Struck out 42.9 percent of the batters he faced this year at Triple-A Indianapolis, where he went $0-0$ with an 0.99 ERA (27.1ip/3er), 45 strikeouts, 175 batting average against and 0.91 WHIP in seven starts...Made his Major League debut just 307 days after being selected N ㅇ. 1 overall in the 2023 draft, making him the quickest top pick to reach the Majors in 35 years (RHP Ben McDonald of the Orioles made it to the Majors in 1989 in the same year he was drafted).

His two-run homer in the first inning on $5 / 13$ was his third of the year and first since his grand slam on 4/14 at Philadelphia. Has gone 14-for-43 (.326) with a triple and two home runs against lefthanders dating back to $9 / 20$ of last season.
