BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore continues a nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles-NL (0-1, 2 to play), and Los Angeles-AL (3 G)...The Birds are coming off a seven-game homestand, splitting a four-game set with the Mariners before dropping two of three to the Padres...The O's enter play today 3.5 games back in the Wild Card and 12.5 games behind the Yankees in the AL East.

👉 Last night marked the third walk-off plate appearance against the Orioles this season, joining May 7 at Miami (error) and April 4 at Pittsburgh (double)...It was the O's fourth walk-off defeat overall, having lost on a wild pitch on April 21 at Kansas City.

👉 Prior to yesterday's defeat, the Orioles were 30-0 when leading after eight innings...Their last such defeat came on September 13, 2025 at Toronto (led 4-2, lost 5-4).

👉 **Trey Gibson** did not factor into the decision after working 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits and four walks with a career-high eight strikeouts...He is one of 10 pitchers in franchise history (since 1954) to have 7+ strikeouts in at least two of his first six career appearances, joining Brian Matusz/Tom Phoebus (both 3) and Keegan Akin, Steve Johnson, Dean Kremer, Rick Krivda, Mike Mussina, John Parrish, and Grayson Rodriguez (all 2).

👉 After hitting two home runs last night, the Birds have gone deep 46 times since May 16, the fifth-highest mark in MLB during that period behind the Athletics (54) and Astros/Giants/Twins (also 47).

NOT SO DODGER BLUE: The Orioles have scored multiple runs in 21 straight games against the Dodgers, their second-longest active streak against a single opponent, trailing the Guardians (24)...It marks the longest active streak by any MLB team against Los Angeles-NL.

👉 **Taylor Ward** has scored 1+ run in nine of his last 12 games opposite the Dodgers since July 7, 2023...During the 12-game period, Ward is batting .364 (16-for-44) with two doubles, six home runs, 14 runs, and nine walks against 12 strikeouts.

HOLLYWOOD PETE: **Pete Alonso** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games against the Dodgers since April 21, 2024, batting .326 (14-for-43) with one double, five home runs, seven runs, 13 RBI, and three hit-by-pitches...Over his last four games in Los Angeles, he is 8-for-17 (.471) with one double, four home runs, and 10 RBI.

👉 In 23 career games at UNIQLD Field at Dodger Stadium, Alonso is slashing .330/.369/.732 (32-for-97) with four doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 17 runs, and five hit by pitches...His career 1.101 OPS at the venue, which opened in 1962, is the second highest by any player in MLB history (min. 100 PA), trailing HOU's Christian Walker (1.197).

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .384/.426/.545 (38-for-99) with eight doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 runs, 18 RBI, six walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 39 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1st), on-base percentage (5th), and OPS (9th, .971).

👉 During this period, Alexander is slashing .403/.433/.581 (25-for-62) with six doubles, one triple, and one home run on all fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, sinker)...His .403 average off such offerings since May 1 is fourth highest in the majors (min. 60 AB ending in pitch) behind MIA's Otto Lopez (.446, 33-for-74), PHI's Brandon Marsh (.421, 32-for-76), and TB's Junior Caminero (.416, 32-for-77)...Over his first 25 games of the season, he hit .139/.244/.194 (5-for-36) with two doubles off such offerings.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 63), times on base (4th, 137), and on-base percentage (10th, .393)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

👉 The only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June that season.

👉 Ward recorded 63 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the Orioles...The only other player to have at least 60 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) was Ken Singleton (64 BB, 81 H).

👉 His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

👉 Ward has seen 1,473 pitches, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,489)...The next closest player is ATH's Nick Kurtz (1,470).

TROUBLE WITH THE 2'S: Orioles pitching has allowed opponents to slash .263/.354/.415 with two outs...The batting average is tied with Texas for the highest mark in MLB...The on-base percentage is second highest in MLB ahead of the Angels (.365)...Their .769 OPS is second highest in the majors ahead of the Royals (.778).

👉 Baltimore hurlers own a .561 opponent OPS with two strikes, the third-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.612) and the Athletics (.566).

👉 Orioles hitters own a .153 batting average with two strikes, tied for the lowest clip in the majors along with the Phillies and Mets.

RISPY BUISNESS: Over its last 12 games since June 6, Baltimore owns a .176 (15-for-85) RISP average, the third-lowest mark in MLB during that time ahead of Arizona (.144) and Cleveland (.154).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 68 straight games since April 6, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind St. Louis (74).

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh...The Orioles join the Brewers as the only teams in MLB to have only one game with zero walks.

👉 Baltimore is 27-25 when drawing 3+ walks, compared to 8-17 when drawing two or fewer free passes.

ROAD TRIPPIN': The Birds are 13-23 (.361) on the road, the fifth-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Tigers (12-28, .300), Angels (13-27, .325), Rockies (14-27, .341), and Royals (13-24, .351).

👉 O's pitching owns a 5.32 ERA on the road, the third-highest mark in MLB ahead of the Twins (5.52) and White Sox (5.48).

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 14th start of the season and 116th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on June 14 vs. San Diego after tossing 6.0 innings, permitting two runs on five hits and two walks with four strikeouts...Threw 82 pitches, 55 strikes.

- Marked his fourth quality start of the season, including his first since April 7 at Chicago-AL (ND, 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 0 BB, 6 K).
- Both of his runs allowed came in the second frame...A two-out double by Rodolfo Durán drove in Samad Taylor...Fernando Tatis Jr. followed Durán with an RBI single.

LA LA LAND: Rogers has made two career starts vs. Los Angeles-NL, going 0-0 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP)...Tonight will mark his first career start at UNIQLO Field at Dodger Stadium.

- Faced them last season at Camden Yards on September 6 and threw 5.1 innings of two-run ball, scattering eight hits and one walk with six strikeouts.

ENCOURAGING SIGNS: Over three June starts, Rogers is 1-1 with a 3.12 ERA (6 ER/17.1 IP) and a .604 opponent OPS.

- He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .374/.430/.527 (34-for-91) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 27 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

- His .957 opponent OPS with two outs is fourth highest in MLB (min. 75 BF) ahead of ATH's Jeffrey Springs (1.028), TEX's Jack Leiter (1.009), and TOR's Patrick Corbin (.988).
- Opponents are slashing .500/.561/.778 (18-for-36) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.

LEFT-SIDE STORY: Opposing left-handed hitters are 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, and six RBI off Rogers over his last seven starts after going a combined 2-for-22 (.091) with two doubles over his first six outings.

- Overall, Rogers has limited lefties to a .143 (2-for-14) mark on his four-seam fastball, but both hits have gone for extra-bases (3B, HR)...Left-handed hitters are 1-for-11 (.091) with a single and six strikeouts off Rogers' sweeper.

ORDER OF OPERATIONS: Rogers has held the opposition to a .223 (25-for-112) batting average the first time through the order... However, they are hitting .316 (31-for-98) the second time through and .327 (18-for-55) the third time around.

- Nine-hole hitters are slashing .417/.462/.542 (10-for-24) with three doubles off Rogers.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

- His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP).
- On August 1 at Chicago-NL, threw his first career complete game (L, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 8 K), becoming the first Oriole starter to throw a complete game since Dean Kremer (9/23/22 vs. HOU, 9.0 IP)... Became the first Oriole to suffer a loss in a complete game since Chris Tillman (9/14/13 at TOR, 8.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).
