**LET'S TRY THIS AGAIN:** The Detroit Tigers and Baltimore Orioles today play a split doubleheader after seeing their series opener last night postponed due to inclement weather ... the Tigers welcome the Orioles as the third and final team to come through their season-long, 11-day, 10-game homestand ... while Thursday's off day marked the end of 13 games in 13 days, the Tigers today continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days, including 10 games in the next nine days.

- At 10-3, the Tigers have begun a season by winning 10 of their first 13 home games for just the third time in the 26-season history of Comerica Park (also 2013 and 2010).
- More broadly, the Tigers have started a season by winning six of their first eight series for the first time in 10 years when they did so in 2015.
- The Tigers have gone 15-7, a .682 winning percentage, in their last 22 games since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium.
- After this weekend, the Tigers embark on their longest road trip of the year, an 11-day, 10-game, three-city trek through the Houston Astros (April 28-30), Los Angeles Angels (May 1-4) and Colorado Rockies (May 6-8).

**IT ALL MAKES A DIFFERENCE:** At 15-10 (.600), the Tigers begin the day with the best record in the American League on the strength of a +30 run differential this year, also the best mark in the A.L. ... the Tigers are one of only four A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, just ahead of the New York Yankees (+29) and well ahead of the Houston Astros (+9) and Tampa Bay Rays (+9) ... overall, Detroit's +30 run differential is fourth best in all of baseball.

**OFF AND RUNNING:** The Tigers enter today having won seven-straight series openers since losing Opening Day in Los Angeles ... it's the club's longest series-opener winning streak since August 18-September 12, 2016 when they won eight-straight series openers ... Detroit's 7-1 mark in series openers this year is tied with the Cleveland Guardians for tops in the big leagues.

**MIZE LOVES COMPANY:** Tigers starter Casey Mize today takes the ball for the fifth time after going 3-1 with a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) his first four times out ... Mize is one of four Tigers starters with a sub-3.00 ERA so far this season, joining Jack Flaherty (2.63 ERA), Jackson Jobe (2.70 ERA) and Tarik Skubal (2.83 ERA), while Reese Olson (3.29 ERA) crept closer to the threshold following his 7.1 scoreless innings on Wednesday vs. San Diego.

- The Tigers are the only team in all of baseball to have four starting pitchers with sub-3.00 ERAs ... in fact, no other team in all of baseball has more than even two starting pitchers with sub-3.00 ERAs this season.
- Collectively, Tigers starters lead the American League with a 3.09 ERA (47 ER/137.0 IP) this season, third in the majors behind the New York Mets (2.33 ERA) and Texas Rangers (3.07).
- The Tigers also have half (three of the six) of the A.L. starting pitchers with sub-2.00 ERAs at home this year: Reese Olson (0.98 ERA), Casey Mize (1.38 ERA) and Jack Flaherty (1.59 ERA).

**THE MIGHTY PEN:** The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.70 ERA (25 ER/83.1 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest mark in all of baseball and second-lowest in the American League behind only Houston (2.53 ERA from their bullpen) ... Tigers relievers have also combined to limit opponents to a .586 OPS, the sixth-lowest mark in the majors and third lowest in the A.L. ... Detroit's 83.1 relief innings pitched are the fewest in the American League.

**HOME, SWEET, HOME:** Zach McKinstry leads the majors with a .486 batting average (17-for-35) at home this season, 29 points ahead of his next closest competitor in New York's Aaron Judge with his .457 home batting average ... McKinstry also has a .558 on-base percentage and a .743 slugging percentage at home, good for a 1.301 OPS, second in the majors behind only Judge (1.518).

**IN THE BIG INNING...:** The Tigers are averaging seeing 20.6 pitches in the first inning this season, the best mark in the A.L. and second-best in the majors behind only the Phillies ... Detroit has scored 19 first-inning runs, tied for second most in the A.L. behind only the Yankees (22) and tied for seventh most in the majors ... the Tigers lead the majors with a .411 on-base percentage and a .333 (36-for-108) batting average in the first inning this year.

**HIGH-END TORK:** Spencer Torkelson enters the day with 14 extra-base hits, tied for third most in the A.L. behind only New York's Aaron Judge (15) and Boston's Alex Bregman (15) ... Torkelson ranks seventh in the A.L. with a .944 OPS ... Torkelson and teammate Andy Ibáñez are tied for second in the A.L. with four game-winning RBI this season ... overall, Torkelson's 21 RBI are tied for third in the A.L. (New York's Aaron Judge leads with 26) and tied for ninth in the majors.

**AND FINALLY:** Gleyber Torres has totaled 23 career home runs vs. the Orioles, fourth-most among active players behind only Aaron Judge (45), Mike Trout (28) and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (27).

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
- Appeared in 21 games (three starts) for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 1-1 record with a 1.84 ERA (6ER/29.1IP), six walks and 23 strikeouts...also made 34 appearances with Triple-A Toledo last year, going 1-2 with one save, a 5.17 ERA (27ER/47.0IP) and 53 strikeouts.
- Made his first career Major League start on Aug. 8 at Seattle...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, became the first Tigers pitcher to finish and then start consecutive games since Steve Sparks, who finished the July 26, 2000, game vs. Tampa Bay and started on July 27, 2000, at Texas.
- Allowed only one earned run over 13 outings from Aug. 4-Sept. 7, posting a 0.49 ERA (1ER/18.1IP) with 13 hits allowed, three walks and 12 strikeouts.
