

## NEW YORK YANKEES (4-2) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (2-5) April 4, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 4:12 EDT - Game #8/Home #1 LHP Max Fried (0-0, 3.86 ERA) vs. RHP Mitch Keller (1-0, 1.50 ERA)

THE PIRATES: return to PNC Park for the first time this season, following an off-day yesterday preceded by a season-opening, seven-game road trip...Snapped their four-game losing streak with a 4-2 victory on Wednesday at Tampa Bay... Opened the season on the road for the ninth consecutive year and the 10th time in 11 years (only time opening at home in that span came in 2016 against St. Louis)...Finished 2024 with a 76-86 record (fifth place in the N.L. Central)...Won 15 **BUCS WHEN...** games in their last at-bat last season (most since 2021, 16)...Played in 51 one-run games last year, their most since 2018 (also 51).

412 DAY: Today's first pitch between the Yankees and Pirates is scheduled for 4:12 p.m., marking the fourth consecutive season that first pitch for Pittsburgh's Home Opener will be at 4:12 p.m...It's also the third season in a row that the Pirates' Home Opener will be played against an American League team, making them only the second team since MLB moved to year-round interleague play in 2013 to have three consecutive interleague home openers, along with Texas from 2022-24 (per the Elias Sports Bureau).

BIRTHDAY BOY: Mitch Keller will start for Pittsburgh today as he celebrates his 29th birthday...Keller has made one pro appearance on his birthday, coming on April 4, 2021 (25th birthday) at Wrigley Field against the Cubs...In that start, he struck out four batters over 3.0 innings...The last Pirates pitcher to pitch on his birthday was Paul Skenes on May 29, 2024 (G2) at Detroit (22nd birthday).

POWER AND SPEED: Oneil Cruz has reached base safely in six of seven games to begin the season...He hit his second home run and stole his sixth base of the season in Wednesday's 4-2 victory at Tampa Bay, making him the fourth Major League player since 1901 to hit two-plus homers and steal six-plus bases through his team's first seven games of a season...The only other members of that list are Rickey Henderson in 1988 (with the Yankees), Eric Davis (1987 with the Reds) and Joe Morgan (1976 with the Reds).

CAN'T CATCH ME: On Wednesday, Oneil Cruz stole his MLB-best sixth base of the season...It was also his 26th consecutive successful steal attempt, a streak that dates back to April 28, 2024... According to the Elias Sports Bureau, only three other Pirates since 1976 have stolen 26-plus consecutive bases without being caught: Tony Womack (32 steals) from April 6, 1997 to July 4, 1997, Nate McLouth (28 steals) from May 2, 2008 to May 26, 2009 and Frank Taveras (27 steals) from April 23, 1976 to July 20, 1976.

OUR ACE: Paul Skenes earned his first win of the season Wednesday at Tampa Bay after allowing just an unearned run and three hits while striking out six Rays over 7.0 innings... Through his first 25 Major League starts, Skenes has struck out 183 batters and posted a 1.92 ERA (145.1ip/31er)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he's the only Major League pitcher since earned runs became an official stat (1912 in the N.L./1913 in the A.L.) to post a sub-2.00 ERA and have 175-plus strikeouts over his first 25 Major League appearances... His 183 strikeouts since making his MLB debut on May 11, 2024 are fourth-most in MLB.

**<u>HIGH-LEVERAGE LEFTY</u>**: With two outs and the tying run on second base in the eighth inning Wednesday at Tampa Bay, Ryan Borucki struck out the only batter he faced, Curtis Mead, and stranded his inherited runner...Borucki and teammate Tim Mayza are two of just three Major League relievers with five-plus inherited runners this season (also Colorado's Seth Halvorsen), while Borucki and Reed Garrett of the Mets are the only Major League relievers with four-plus inherited runners and zero inherited runs allowed... Borucki's six strikeouts so far are tied for seventh-most among National League relievers.

IKE: Isiah Kiner-Falefa, who played for the Yankees from 2022-23, is 7-for-19 (.368) while hitting safely in each of since going hitless on Opening Day (he has hit out of the ninth spot of the lineup in each of the first seven game

hitting streak is Kiner Falefa's longest-such streak since hitting safely in 13 straight games with Toronto from June 15-29, 2024...Kiner-Falefa is hitting .333 this season to go with his four stolen bases...Prior to him, the last two Pirates with such a high average and that many SB through seven team games of a season were Lee Lacy (1983) and Max Carey (1918).

ON THE BASES: Pittsburgh has stolen an MLB-best 19 bases through its first seven games...The 19 steals are the Pirates' second-most through their first seven games of a season since 1901 (1907 team had 23)...They're also tied with the 1984 Cleveland Indians for second-most by any Major League team through its first seven games of a season in the Live-Ball Era (since 1920), behind the 1992 Milwaukee Brewers (20 steals).

The Bucs took a two-run lead in the eighth inning, highlighted by Bonds' solo home run, before the Expos answered with one run in the eighth and two runs in the ninth to win it.

STARTING OFF: The 29-year-old Keller is in his seventh Major League season...He signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 23, 2024... He earned Opening Day honors in both 2023 and 2024, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16... He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller allowed one run in 6.0 innings (5h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 4k) while winning a 4-3 decision in his first start of 2025 on March 28 against Miami at IoanDepot Park...It marked the longest season debut for Keller in his Major League career.

ALONG THE BANKS OF THE ALLEGHENY: Keller has made 66 career starts here at PNC Park, which is tied with Charlie Morton for third-most in stadium history...The only two pitchers to make more starts at PNC Park are Paul Maholm (100) and Zach Duke (82).

THE 700 CLUB: Keller comes into today nine strikeouts shy of 700 in his career...The first strikeout victim of his career was Cincinnati's Derek Dietrich on May 27, 2019 (game 2)...He has struck out Nick Castellanos (10 times) more than any other player.

AS A STARTER: Keller has made 132 starts as a member of the Pirates since making his Major League debut in May 2019...Keller's 132 starts are tied for the 37th-most in team history, along with Pink Hawley and Heinie Meine...Murry Dickson ranks 36th (137).

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.

Since the beginning of the 2023 season, Keller's 380 strikeouts are the fifth-most among all right-handed pitchers in the National League...The only four National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters during that time are Zack Wheeler (454), Freddy Peralta (426), Aaron Nola (407) and Zac Gallen (393).

KEEPING IT 100: Heading into the 2024 All-Star break, Keller was 10-5 with 105 strikeouts in 114.1 innings pitched...He became the fourth pitcher in club history to have 10-plus wins, 100-plus strikeouts and 100.0-plus innings pitched prior to the All-Star break, along with Gerrit Cole in 2015, Bob Veale in 1966 and Bob Friend in 1960.

AS A PIRATE: The Pirates selected Keller in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa...He was rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect in each season from 2018-20...He was also recognized by the same publication as a top-100 prospect in the game from 2017-20.

**<u>SIGN HERE PLEASE</u>**: The Pirates signed Keller to a five-year contract extension through 2028 last year on February 23...He became the third member of the current team to sign a long-term contract extension, along with Ke'Bryan Hayes and Bryan Reynolds.
