### So Nice, They Did It Twice!

The Brewers batted around in the first and second innings in Game 1 as they sent 11 batters to the plate in the first inning for 6 runs and nine batters to the plate in the second inning for 3 runs....prior to 2025, the team batted around in an inning in a postseason game just four times in franchise history with the last instance coming in the first inning of Game 6 of the 2018 NLCS vs. Los Angeles.

The Brewers scored 6 runs in the first inning in Game 1, tying the franchise record for most runs in an inning in a postseason game.

Missed It By That Much!
The Brewers, who have made it to the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row, were just two games away from qualifying for the posteason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing in both 2017 and 2022 by a one game.

Making a Habit of It
The Dodgers (13), Phillies (4) and
Brewers (3) are the only Major League teams to make the postseason in at least each of the last three seasons.

Simply the Best
The Brewers (97-65, 599) posted the
best record in the majors this season, marking the second time in franchise history that the team accomplished the feat.....the team went 95-67 (.586) for the best record in baseball in 1982.

### That's How Winning Is Done!

The Brewers set a franchise record with 97 wins in 2025.....the previous record of 96 wins was accomplished in 2011 and 2018.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 of the National League Division Series against Chicago.

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marked just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (195 days): The Brewers spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 81, SECOND: 57, THIRD: 43, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the team finished in first place, ahead of the second-place Cubs by 5.0 games, third-place Reds by 14.0 games, fourth-place Cardinals by 19.0 games and fifth-place Pirates by 26.0 games.....the Brewers spent the last 63 days of the season (7/28-9/28) in sole possession of first place, clinching a postseason berth on September 13 and the NL Central on September 21.

TEAM STREAK: The Brewers had a pair of double-digit winning streaks this season..... the team won 11 consecutive games from 7/6-7/21 and a franchise-record 14 in a row from 8/1-8/16....the Brewers were the first team in the Major Leagues since the 2015 Blue Jays (11 games twice) to have multiple winning streaks of 11+ games in a season and the first National League team to do it since the 1935 Cubs (11 and 21 games).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers went 30-19-3 in series play this season. AT HOME: The Brewers went 52-29 at home this season, tying the Dodgers and Padres for the third-best record in the Major Leagues.....the team was 17-8-1 in series play..... Milwaukee won 50+ home games for the eighth time and first time since going 51-30 in 2018.....the team had a season-high 7-game home winning streak from 8/8-8/22.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers went 45-36 on the road this season, posting the best record in the Major Leagues.....the team was 13-11-2 in series play... franchise-record-tying 9-game road winning streak from 7/23-8/16.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy completed in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he became the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.
