**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles fell to the Guardians, 10-8, marking their sixth series loss of the season...Have dropped consecutive series to American League opponents after having lost just one prior to facing the Astros this past weekend (vs. Oakland, 4/26-28)...Have lost five straight games for the first time since May 13-18, 2022 (6)...Hit at least four home runs for an AL-best sixth time this season and are 4-2 when doing so.

**ALL-STAR VOTING:** MLB announced the second balloting update for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game this past Monday...The 2024 MLB All-Star Ballot, which is available exclusively online and via mobile devices at [MLB.com/vote](http://MLB.com/vote), all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App, and the MLB Ballpark App, will be accessible until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 12 p.m. ET tomorrow...The top two vote-getters at each position (and the top six outfielders) in each league will be revealed on MLB Network at 6 p.m. on Thursday, and will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who starts for each league...As of the second update, an MLB-high-tying six Orioles are on pace to advance to Phase 2 (see box at right), while three are leading their positions; the Orioles have not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014.

⚬ **Adley Rutschman** leads AL catchers and ranks third in the AL with 1,638,425 votes; seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment; would become the third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; **Matt Wieters** was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).

⚬ **Gunnar Henderson** leads AL shortstops with 1,551,124 votes; vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Manny Machado** in 2018.

⚬ **Ryan Mountcastle** leads AL first basemen with 1,400,373 votes, having overtaken Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (1,338,688) since the first update; seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Chris Davis** in 2013.

⚬ **Jordan Westburg** ranks second among AL third basemen with 846,352 votes, trailing Cleveland's Jose Ramirez (1,426,755); seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since Machado in 2016.

⚬ **Anthony Santander** and **Colton Cowser** are each seeking their first All-Star selections; Santander ranks fifth among AL outfielders with 808,100 votes, while Cowser ranks sixth with 649,710 votes.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Orioles have lost five games in a row for the first time since losing six straight from May 13-18, 2022; following that skid, they won four of five, five of eight, six of 10, seven of 12, and eight of 14...At 49-30 (.620), the Birds own the fourth-best record in MLB, behind the Yankees (.642, 52-29), Phillies (.658, 52-27), and Guardians (.662, 51-26)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 150-91 (.622), the best winning percentage and tied for the most wins in the majors with the Los Angeles Dodgers...The O's are 233-170 (.578) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.583, 235-168), Braves (.620, 248-152), and Dodgers (.644, 261-144).

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 129 home runs and are one of three clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (117) and Dodgers (110)...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, the longest streak in MLB this season and the longest such streak in team history, ahead of a 20-gamer from July 17 to August 9, 1998.

⚬ The Orioles are 42-20 this year when homering, 33-6 when hitting multiple home runs, 17-5 when hitting at least three, and 4-2 when hitting four.

⚬ Baltimore has six players with at least 10 home runs, the most in MLB this season: **Gunnar Henderson** (25), **Anthony Santander** (21), **Adley Rutschman** (14), **Jordan Westburg** (13), **Ryan Mountcastle** (11), and **Colton Cowser** (10).

⚬ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season (CLE's José Ramirez and Josh Naylor).

⚬ The O's lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** ranks second in MLB with 25 homers, trailing only New York-AL's Aaron Judge (29)...He ranks among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

⚬ He owns a career-best 32-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB; marks the longest on-base streak by an O's batter since **Nick Markakis'** 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009, and the longest by a batter under 23 years old in Orioles history.

⚬ His 69 runs scored are the most through the first 79 team games in O's history.

⚬ Through 79 team games, he's tied for the third-fastest in O's history to 25 home runs in a season with **Nelson Cruz** (2014), trailing only **Chris Davis** (73 G, 2013) and **Brady Anderson** (69 G, 1996).

⚬ Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an O's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

**SUMMER SLUGGER:** **Anthony Santander** leads MLB with 12 home runs this month, tied for the most in the month of June in Orioles history with **Boog Powell** (1964), **Rafael Palmeiro** (1998), **Albert Belle** (2000), and **Chris Davis** (2013)...He is the first Oriole with at least 12 home runs in a month since **Manny Machado** in August of 2017 (also 12)...Trails only **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961), **Nelson Cruz** (13 in May 2014), and **Frank Robinson** (13 in July 1966) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Oriole batter.

⚬ Santander's 82 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (128).

**MONTHLY DUES:** The Orioles need two wins in their next five games to clinch a winning record in June...With a 17-9 record in May, the O's have been above .500 in eight consecutive full months since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the team (min. 10 games played in the month) since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors; Atlanta had its streak of 11 straight winning months since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand with tonight's series finale against the Guardians...The O's will then host the Rangers from Thursday through Sunday for a rematch of the 2023 ALDS, including ESPN's *Sunday Night Baseball* on June 30...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it will be Baltimore's 35th appearance on *Sunday Night Baseball*, in which they are 15-19.

**AGAINST CLEVELAND:** The Orioles and Guardians carry on with a seven-game season series with the last of three games in Baltimore tonight...The O's will travel to Cleveland for four games from August 1-4...Baltimore went 3-4 against Cleveland last year, dropping two out of three at Oriole Park from May 29-31 and splitting a four-game set at Progressive Field from September 21-24.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 364 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 14<sup>th</sup> start of the season tonight against the Guardians...Became the first Oriole pitcher to win at least eight of his first 12 starts to begin a season since Chris Tillman in 2012 (also 8)...Activated from the 15-day Injured List prior to the game on May 18 vs. Seattle (right shoulder inflammation), retroactive to April 30...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA (59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year...Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his third loss of the season on June 21 at Houston after allowing a season-high-tying seven runs on nine hits (1 HR) and two walks with eight strikeouts across 5.0 innings pitched; falls to 2-4 in his career against the AL West with a 7.66 ERA (42 ER/49.1 IP)...Threw 94 pitches, 63 strikes.

**AGAINST THE GUARDIANS:** Scheduled to make his second career start against the Guardians and his first in Baltimore...Did not factor in the decision in his only prior start against them on September 21, 2023 in Cleveland; allowed two runs on five hits and three walks with seven strikeouts across 5.0 innings.

**AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Making his ninth career start against the AL Central and first since May 23 at Chicago-AL...Owns a lifetime 4-0 record with an 3.54 ERA (16 ER/40.2 IP) in his eight prior starts against the division...Across the starts, AL Central opponents are slashing a combined .228/.318/.396 (34-for-149).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Has gone 4-1 with a 2.21 ERA (9 ER/36.2 IP) across his six starts at Oriole Park this season...Opponents are slashing .211/.286/.338 (28-for-133) at home compared to .277/.335/.447 (44-for-133) in seven starts away from Oriole Park.

**NIGHT OWL:** Owns a 4-3 record with a 5.08 ERA (25 ER/44.1 IP) across his eight night starts this season compared to a 4-0 record with a 2.03 ERA (7 ER/31.0 IP) in five day starts.

**GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS:** In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and has gone 13-5 with a 3.20 ERA (54 ER/152.0 IP) across 26 starts since...Has posted 13 quality starts in his last 24 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

**GAS 'EM UP:** Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20<sup>th</sup> rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
