**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 11**

2016 - The Astros play a 16-inning game at home, topping Cleveland, 5-3, in five hours and nine minutes...**1B Marwin Gonzalez** is the hero, as he hits a walk-off, two-run homer in the bottom of the 16th to end it...since this date, the Astros have not played a 16-inning game.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will wear their City Connect uniforms tonight as they open a seven-game homestand against the rival Seattle Mariners...**RHP Peter Lambert**, who shut out the Dodgers in 7.0 innings in his last start, will get the start for Houston tonight opposite the Mariners and Astros nemesis **RHP George Kirby**.

REMEMBERING RENÉ: The Astros will hold a moment of silence tonight for Hall of Fame broadcaster **René Cárdenas**, who sadly passed away yesterday...Cárdenas was a true pioneer in broadcasting as the original Spanish-language broadcaster for the Colt .45s when the franchise was born in 1962...Cárdenas called Astros games for 14 seasons (1962-75) and after a long stint with the Dodgers, returned to the Astros Spanish broadcast in 2007...he called select Astros games since that year, while also covering the team for La Prensa, a Nicaraguan newspaper...Cárdenas was inducted into the Astros Hall of Fame in 2024.

DRIVING THE LAMBO: **RHP Peter Lambert** has been great in his four starts for the Astros, going 2-2 with a 2.42 ERA (6ER/22.1IP) with 23 strikeouts and a .188 opponent average...his advanced metrics back up his counting stats, as he ranks in the 85th percentile in xBA (.205), 77th percentile in barrel % (5.3), and 73rd percentile of whiff % (29.0)...Lambert joined the Astros via free agency this offseason after pitching last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in three appearances) before being called up to join the rotation on April 17.

VS. SEATTLE: The Astros and Mariners are opening their second series of the 2026 season tonight in Houston...the Astros are looking for revenge, as they were swept in a four-game series in Seattle earlier this season from April 10-13...Houston is 132-101 all-time against the Mariners, including a 68-53 record at home.

ON THE TUBE: Tonight's game will be televised locally by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas, Geoff Blum** and **Julia Morales** on the call...the game will also be televised nationally on FS1 with **Eric Collins** and **Eric Karros** behind the mic.

ON THE RADIO: The Astros radio broadcast for the Mariners series will feature **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder** on SportsTalk 790...the Spanish broadcast can be heard on TUDN 102.9 FM with **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on the call.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!: The Astros would like to wish **OF Zach Dezenzo** and **OF Joey Loperfido** Happy Birthdays today...the elder Loperfido is celebrating his 27th birthday, while Dezenzo is turning 26.

YESTERDAY IN CINCINNATI: The Astros were shut out for the second time this season yesterday in Cincinnati in a 5-0 defeat to the Reds...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (3ER/3IP) started hot for Houston, tossing a scoreless 3.0 innings before running into trouble in the 4th...the Astros offense picked up just three singles in the game.

FROM THE TRAINER'S ROOM: The Astros have 15 players on the Major League Injured List...below are updates on a few:

- **RHP Hunter Brown** (rt. shoulder sprain) threw his first bullpen since the injury on Friday in Houston...he will continue throwing bullpens this week.
- **LHP Josh Hader** (lt. biceps tendinitis) made his second rehab appearance for Triple A Sugar Land on Saturday, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning...he is scheduled to pitch next on Tuesday for Double A Corpus Christi.
- **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (rt. arm fatigue) is scheduled to return to the Astros rotation tomorrow vs. SEA.
- **RHP Cristian Javier** (rt. shoulder strain) continues his throwing progression.
- **RHP Nate Pearson** (rt. elbow surgery), who's being built up as a reliever, made his fourth minor league rehab appearance on Saturday for Sugar Land, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning...he will continue his rehab assignment with Sugar Land this week.
- **LHP Bennett Sousa** (lt. elbow inflammation) is rehabbing in Houston, focusing on rehab exercises.
- **IF Carlos Correa** (lt. ankle tendon injury) is scheduled to have season-ending surgery today...details of the surgery will be announced at a later time.
- **C Yainer Diaz** (lt. oblique strain) is rehabbing in Houston, focusing on rehab exercises.
- **OF Joey Loperfido** (rt. quad strain) and **OF Taylor Trammell** (lt. groin strain) continue to progress in their running progression and baseball activity.
- **OF Jake Meyers** (rt. oblique strain) is scheduled to begin a rehab assignment this week.
- **SS Jeremy Peña** (rt. hamstring strain) ran the bases for the first time since the injury over the weekend in Cincinnati...he is scheduled to run again today in preparation for a rehab assignment this week.

AIR YORDAN: **LF Jordan Alvarez** is batting .318 (48x151) with 10 doubles, 13 HR, 29 RBI, 24 walks and a 1.064 OPS (.422 OBP/.642 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in extra-base hits (23), second in OBP, second in OPS, second in SLG, third in batting average and tied for third in home runs.

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 41 different batting orders in their 41 games so far this season...only **LF Jordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

DOWN ON THE FARM: **C Jason Schiavone** hit his 15th homer of the young season for Class Asheville yesterday...Schiavone, an 11th round pick by the Astros in 2024, leads all of minor league baseball in home runs (15), ranks tied for third in walks (33) and tied for seventh in RBI (33)...Schiavone is hitting .260 (27x104) with 38 RBI, a .435 OBP, a .740 SLG and a 1.175 OPS in 29 games this season.

LAST START - 5/5 vs. LAD: Notched the best the best start of his career, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros' 2-1 victory...matched his career high with 7.0 innings, doing so for the 3rd time (last: Aug. 18, 2023 vs. CWS)...also matched his fewest hits allowed among his 23 career outings in which he's tossed at least 5.0 innings.

PISTOL PETE: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has been a stabilizer in the Astros rotation amid a flux of injuries...has allowed 2 runs or less in 3 of his 4 starts this season, including 2 scoreless outings (April 22 at CLE and May 5 vs. LAD)...since making his season debut on April 17, he ranks 4th in the AL in opponent batting average (.188) and 7th in the ERA (2.42) (min. 20 IP).

THE REPERTOIRE: Has been greatly successful working off his 2-pitch mix of a 4-seam fastball (32%) and changeup (23.4%), holding opponents to a combined .136 AVG (6x44) between the 2 pitches.

VS. SEA: Will be making his 2nd career appearance vs. the Mariners...surrendered 6 runs on 6 hits with 5 strikeouts through 3.0 innings in Game 2 of a doubleheader between the Rockies and Mariners on April 21, 2024, at Coors Field.

NO. 200: Recorded his 200th career strikeout in Game 1 of the Astros' doubleheader on April 30 at BAL, a called third strike against **BAL OF Colton Cowser**.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Triple A Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...has appeared at the Major League level in four seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 78 career Major League appearances, including 39 starts, he's recorded a 5.95 ERA (176ER/266IP) with 204 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School, was committed to play baseball at UCLA before signing with the Rockies...was signed by Rockies scout Jon Lukens...as a senior at San Dimas HS in 2015, he went 13-0 with a 0.34 ERA...was also named the Los Angeles Times Baseball Player of the Year.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/9 at CIN): Tossed 0.1 of a scoreless inning on Saturday at CIN, retiring the only hitter he faced (**Sal Stewart**) on 5 pitches (3 strikes).

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (1ER/5.1IP) in his last 5 games dating back to April 24...within that span, picked up his 1st win of the season on May 3 at BOS after he allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 2.0 scoreless innings...was his longest outing of the season...prior to this hot streak, posted a 14.73 ERA (12ER/7.1IP) in his first 9 games of the season.

VS. SEA: Has struck out 52 batters through 36.1 innings in 34 career appearances vs. the Mariners, holding an impressive 12.88 SO/9IP with a 3.47 ERA (14ER/36.1IP)...has the most strikeouts among active relievers against Seattle with 52...has held **C Cal Raleigh** to a 2x10 mark with 6 strikeouts in their career matchups.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 342.1 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (468) and 7th in apps. (331).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Is 2.0 innings from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 4 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 331 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (110ER/342.1P) with 468 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.30 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
