RECENT REDBIRDS: The 2022 National League Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals open their final homestand of the season with the first of a three-game series vs. the Pittsburgh Pirates ... The Cardinals finished an eight-game road trip 3-5 through San Diego (1-2), Los Angeles (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-1), all teams contending or have qualified for the postseason.

RED OCTOBER: St. Louis enters the National League playoffs as the #3 seed and will host the third NL Wild Card (#6 seed) in a best-of-three series next weekend at Busch Stadium from Oct. 7-9 ... The Cardinals have joined the Dodgers, Mets, and Braves as teams to qualify for the NL postseason.

DIVISION DANDIES: The 2022 Cardinals are NL Central Champions for the 13th time since Divisional Play began in 1994, including five times in the last 10 seasons (2013, 2014, 2015, 2019, 2022) ... St. Louis has won 16 Division titles overall, with the first three coming in the NL East (1982, 1985, 1987).

AHOY, MATEY!: For the first time in nearly 110 years, the Cardinals end the season by playing the same opponent in 6+ games as they play the Buccos ... The 1914 Cardinals ended their season with six straight at home against the Cubs (Oct. 2-5, 1914) at Robison Field, which included back-to-back doubleheaders over the season-ending four-day span ... Due to the recent offseason lockout that caused the season to be delayed by one week, the upcoming three-game series in Pittsburgh was initially scheduled for March 31-April 3 at PNC Park. - *Elias*

BLOW UP THE DECK! SINK THE SHIP!: St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh for nine consecutive seasons (2014-22) and 20 times in the last 23 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013) ... The Cardinals have outscored Pittsburgh by a 51-run margin (83-32) over the first 13 games.

AGE IS JUST A NUMBER: With his appearance tonight, **Albert Pujols** (age 42.257) surpasses catcher **Walker Cooper** (42.255 in 1957) as the 4th-oldest position player in franchise history ... Older position players in Cards history include catcher **Gabby Street** (48.355 in 1931), infielder **Bobby Wallace** (44.302 in 1917), and left fielder **Stan Musial** (42.312 in 1963).

VS. FORMER BIRDS: Former Cardinals pitcher **Johan Oviedo** (2020-22) faces St. Louis for the first time since being traded to Pittsburgh, and tonight is the 4th time this season that a former Cardinal has made a start against St. Louis ... In three combined starts this season, Boston's **Michael Wacha** (June 17) and Miami's **Sandy Alcantara** (April 20 & June 29) have gone 2-0 with a 1.21 ERA (3er/22.1ip). St. Louis was 2-1 in those games.

DONNIE, YOU'RE (NOT) OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: **Brendan Donovan's** .393 OBP is the 2nd-highest by a Cards rookie over the last 70 seasons (min. 400 PA) since 2001 NL Rookie of the Year **Albert Pujols** (.403 OBP) ... Donovan leads all MLB rookies in OBP and leads all NL rookies in walks (58).

FOREVER YOUNG: 36-year old manager **Oliver Marmol** (36.087) became the youngest manager to lead his team to a postseason since Divisional Play began in 1969, edging out Hall of Fame manager **Sparky Anderson** (36.207), who took the 1970 Cincinnati Reds to the National League West Division title ... The last manager younger to lead his team to the postseason was 31-year-old player/manager **Lou Boudreau**, who led Cleveland to a 1948 World Series title ... If Marmol was on the Cardinals roster, he would be the 4th-oldest player.

FABULOUS FRESHMAN: Among Cardinals first-year managers, Marmol's 90 wins rank 9th with six games to go ... The most wins by a Cardinals manager in his first full season is by **Eddie Dyer**, who piloted the 1946 Cardinals to a World Series championship ... Marmol can tie his predecessor **Mike Shildt** with his next victory (see chart left).

BABY BIRD BLASTS: St. Louis rookies have combined to hit 47 homers this season, 3rd-most among MLB rookies behind the Royals (70) and Pirates (68) ... The next blast by a rookie will surpass the 47 homers hit by the 2017 Cardinals rookies for most in franchise history.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 30, 2001): **Albert Pujols** hits his 37th and final home run of his 2001 Rookie of the Year campaign, a two-run blast off Pirates starter Tony McKnight in the first inning of a 7-3 win over the Pirates at Busch Stadium II ... Pujols' 37 homers still stands as the Cardinals rookie record and were the most by an NL rookie since **Frank Robinson** (38 HR) for the Reds in 1956.

GÓMEZ NAMED MINOR LEAGUE BASEBALL HR KING: Cardinals minor league outfielder **Moisés Gómez** hit 39 homers this season between Springfield (AA) and Memphis (AAA) to claim the Joe Bauman Award, given annually to the top home run hitter in the Minors ... Gómez is the second St. Louis farmhand to win the award and first since the year it debuted in 2004 (34-year-old **Iván Cruz** hit 35 HR for Memphis to lead MiLB in 2002) ... Gómez's 39 home runs are a new Cardinals single-season minor league record, passing the previous mark of 37 shared by OF **Felix DeLeon** (1962) & OF **Tyrone Horne** (1998) since 1960.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park) made MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Andrew Knizner's uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (A).

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Corey Dickerson played parts of two seasons in Pittsburgh (2018-19) ... Won a 2018 Rawlings Gold Glove award in left field.

Mike Maddux signed with Pittsburgh in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before released in May.

José Quintana signed with Pittsburgh before the season, while **Chris Stratton** pitched parts of four seasons with the Pirates (2019-22)...the duo was traded to St. Louis for **Malcom Nunez** and **Johan Oviedo** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22).

José Godoy signed with St. Louis as an international free agent (July 2, 2011) and played parts of eight minor league seasons with the Cardinals (2012-19).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 8th start of the season & 98th career start (101st career appearance).
- It's his 5th start since being activated from the 60-day Injured List on Sept. 5.
- Has pitched against the Pirates more than any opponent in his abbreviated season making his third start. Has an 8-1 career record against the Bucs, his best against any opponent.
- Posted season highs in strikeouts (9), innings pitched (6.0) and pitches thrown (99) in his last start, a 5-4 win at SD (9/22) for his first win of the season and since 8/13/21 at KC.
- Missed a total of 122 games this season due to a right shoulder injury (64 games from April 7-June 14 and another 58 games from June 27-Sept.4)
- Made five injury rehab starts in August between Springfield (AA) and Memphis (AAA), going 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (20.0 IP) and 25 strikeouts.
- Ranks 31st in franchise history in career strikeouts (593), and after just 97 starts, leads the organization in fewest starts needed to reach 593 career strikeouts.
- Since becoming a full-time starting pitcher in 2018, ranks 16th among MLB pitchers with a 10.34 strikeouts/9 IP. (min. 400 IP).
- St. Louis sports a 51-46 overall record in Flaherty's 97 career starts. In his first 51 starts from his MLB debut (9/1/2017) until the 2019 All-Star Break, St. Louis went 21-30 (.412). In his last 46 starts (July 16, 2019-present), St. Louis is 30-16 (.652).
- In 97 career starts, is 32-10 when receiving 2+ runs of support, 26-2 when receiving 3+ runs, and 23-0 with 4+ runs of support. Has received 2 or fewer runs of support in 58 of 97 (59.8%) career starts.

LAST TIME OUT

- Struck out a season-high nine batters for his first win of the season as the Cardinals rallied for a 5-4 win on a grand slam by Brendan Donovan. Was his longest start of the season with all seven starts holding the opposition to six hits or less.

2022 SEASON

- Returned to the Busch Stadium mound on 9/5 vs. WSH for the first time since June 26 and worked 5.0 IP, allowing one run on six hits. Took the loss, as the Cardinals were blanked, 6-0, by the Nationals, managing just 3 hits.
- Previously was activated from the 60-day Injured List on June 15 and made his season debut vs. Pirates. Took ND in Cardinals 6-4 loss, allowing 3 unearned runs (4 total) in his 3.0 IP while throwing 60 pitches.
- Retired all nine batters faced in his first Minor League rehab start with Springfield (AA) vs. Arkansas on June 5 at Hammons Field. Threw 30 pitches with a 70% strike rating and struck out three batters.
- Took 4-0 loss in 6/10 rehab start for Memphis (AAA), retiring 12 of 13 batters faced over his 4.0 IP, including the last 9 following solo HR by Luke Raley in the 2nd inning.

CAREER

- Since 2018, Flaherty (.203, 28%), is one of three MLB pitchers to record an opponent batting average of .203 or less and a strikeout pct. of 25% or higher (min. 1,800 batters faced), joining **Jacob deGrom** (.187, 35%) and **Justin Verlander** (.186, 33%).
