BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore allowed a season-high-tying eight runs for the fourth time this year and lost to Cleveland, 8-4, yesterday at Progressive Field...After dropping three of four games against the Guardians, the Orioles wrap up the road trip with three games in Kansas City beginning tonight.

- 👤 **Taylor Ward** hit his first home run with the O's, a three-run homer in the fifth inning.
- 👤 **Tyler Wells** tossed 2.0 perfect innings in relief and struck out five batters, the most by an Oriole reliever this season.

ACTION JACKSON: Since the beginning of the previous homestand on April 10, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .368/.385/.816 (14-for-38) with two doubles, five homers, six runs scored, and 13 RBI in 10 games...During that time, he's second in the majors with 31 total bases behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (36), tied for second in RBI with LAA's Mike Trout, behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (14), tied for second in hits with Alvarez and TEX's Josh Jung, trailing TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (15), third in slugging percentage behind NYY's Ben Rice (.964) and Alvarez (.900), and tied for third in the majors in home runs with four others, trailing NYY's Aaron Judge and Alvarez (both 6).

- 👤 Jackson leads the Orioles with 17 RBI, which is tied for fifth in the AL...HOU's Yordan Alvarez leads the league with 21 RBI...A primary second baseman has not led the Orioles in RBI since Jonathan Schoop in 2017 (105).
- 👤 His five home runs have all come as the second baseman, second in the majors behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (7).
- 👤 Among players with at least 60 plate appearances this season, Jackson's 3.13 pitches per plate appearance ranks fifth lowest in the majors...The Orioles are averaging 3.96 pitches per plate appearance as a team, ranked seventh in the AL and ninth in the majors this season.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 20 of the last 21 games since March 28 while slashing .310/.404/.476 (26-for-84) with 11 doubles, one homer, 11 runs scored, 11 RBI, 13 walks, and one hit by pitch during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

- 👤 His 11 doubles this season leads the majors ahead of SF's Willy Adames and ATL's Matt Olson (both 10).
- 👤 Ward's first Oriole home run came yesterday after 21 straight games without one to begin the year...The only longer such streak to begin a season in his career was in 2020, when he did not homer in any of his 34 games that year.
- 👤 Ward enters play today as the only player in the majors to have four hits in two separate games this season...In 704 career games entering the 2026 season, Ward's career high in hits was three, done 37 times.

LEAVE IT TO LEODY: **Leody Taveras** is batting .394/.524/.576 (13-for-33) with three doubles, one home run, seven runs scored, eight RBI, nine walks, and one stolen base as a starter this season...He's 1-for-6 with one RBI off the bench this year.

- 👤 He's hit safely in six straight starts since April 12 and in 10 of 11 starts overall this season.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has yet to allow a hit in a career-high 10 straight appearances (10.0 IP) to open the season, the longest active stretch in the majors and the longest season-opening hitless streak by a Baltimore pitcher in team history...Garcia has recorded 30 outs without giving up a hit, the second-longest hitless streak to begin a season by an Oriole in the expansion era (since 1961) behind **Yennier Cano** in 2023 (33), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

- 👤 Garcia has also stranded all five inherited runners, only the second pitcher in MLB history to begin a season with 10+ scoreless appearances of no hits and no inherited runners scored along with TB's Scott Aldred, who did so in 11 straight from April 8-May 1, 1999.

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks fourth in the AL with a 3.46 ERA behind the Rangers (2.91), Mariners (3.18), and Tigers (3.24), though relievers have allowed seven runs (3 ER) in the last three games (9.0 IP) and 15 runs (10 ER) in the last eight games (25.2 IP).

- 👤 **Rico Garcia** (65.0%), **Ryan Helsley** (65.0%), and **Anthony Nunez** (59.1%) are three of the top qualified pitchers in groundball rate this season...Only five pitchers have higher rates than Garcia and Helsley, while Nunez ranks in the top eight percent of the majors.
- 👤 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on Friday night...It's the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

WALK IT OUT: The Birds have drawn 4+ walks in 15 games this season, tied for the most such games in the majors with the Twins and White Sox.

- 👤 Baltimore has drawn at least four free passes in 10 of the last 12 games.

THE ROYAL GUARD: The Orioles and Royals meet for the first three of six games this season this week at Kauffman Stadium...Kansas City visits Oriole Park from July 10-12...According to Stats Perform, the last 20 O's road games against the Royals have been decided by two or more runs, tied for the longest active such streak by any MLB team on the road against an opponent with the Royals at Rangers.

- 👤 **Blaze Alexander's** older brother, CJ, made his MLB debut and appeared in four games with the Royals in 2024.
- 👤 First Base Coach **Jason Bourgeois** appeared in 30 games with Kansas City in 2012.
- 👤 Kansas City selected four Orioles in the 1968 Expansion Draft: **RHP Roger Nelson** (No. 1), **1B/OF Mike Fiore** (No. 9), **RHP Wally Bunker** (No. 13), and **RHP Moe Drabowsky** (No. 21).

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY	
April 20, 1992	- Ex-Oriole Mickey Tettleton becomes the first player to homer onto Eutaw Street, but the Orioles rally for a 12-4 win against the Tigers.
April 20, 1999	- Plagued by nerve irritation in his lower back, Cal Ripken, Jr. goes on the Disabled List for the first time in his career. MLB teams had used the DL 5,045 times between the start of his record 2,632-game playing streak and his going on the DL. Ripken would go on the DL again in August and have season-ending back surgery in late September.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season and 72nd of his career in the series opener tonight at Kansas City...He made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peck in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish didn't factor into the decision in the series finale vs. Arizona on April 15, which the Orioles lost 8-5 in 10 innings...Spun a season-high 6.0 innings while allowing four runs on eight hits and one walk with four strikeouts...The eight hits were his most since April 25, 2023 vs. Boston (also 8)...Threw a season-high 97 pitches, 64 strikes (66.0%)

📌 Bradish has allowed at least three runs in four straight starts for the first time in his career...Marks the first time he's done so in consecutive starts since July 26 -August 1, 2023 (2 G).

📌 Reached 400 career strikeouts when he fanned Arizona's Ketel Marte on a slider to end the fourth inning...He's the fastest Oriole to reach 400 career strikeouts (71 G) ahead of RHP Tim Lincecum, who needed 74 games to reach the mark on April 18, 1969.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS: The Royals are one of three teams Bradish has never faced in his career, along with the Orioles and Dodgers...However, he is 4-2 with a 2.70 ERA (13 ER/43.1 IP) over eight career starts (3 QS) vs. the AL Central and has allowed three runs or fewer in his last seven starts dating to September 1, 2022 at Cleveland.

📌 One of Bradish's best starts came against an AL Central opponent on May 26, 2024 at Chicago-AL when he tossed 7.0 no-hit innings and recorded a career-high-tying 11 strikeouts (also 5/10/22 at STL).

📌 Holds a 3.84 ERA (111 ER/260.0 IP) in 50 career starts vs. the American League compared to his 2.99 ERA (39 ER/117.1 IP) in 21 starts against the National League.

DAY 'N NITE: Bradish is scheduled to start his first night game of the season at Kansas City...All four of his starts this year have been during the day, which is tied with eight others for the second-most in the majors this season behind New York-NL's Freddy Peralta (5)...Bradish is 6-6 with a 3.04 ERA (51 ER/151.0 IP) over 29 career starts during the day compared to 14-11 with a 3.94 ERA (99 ER/226.1 IP) in 42 night games.

📌 Bradish has pitched 5.0+ innings and allowed two runs or fewer in seven consecutive night games dating back to September 26, 2023.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE: Bradish's 5.49 ERA (12 ER/19.2 IP) this season is the second-highest figure of his career through the first four starts of a season, ahead of 2023 (6.14)...However, his 3.06 expected ERA ranks in the 74th percentile of MLB and is 2.43 runs lower than his actual mark, while his .223 expected opponent's average is 53 points lower (.286, 22-for-77).

LEFTY FREEZE: Bradish held lefties to a .118 average (2-for-17) over his first two starts this season with four walks to seven strikeouts, but opponents have gone 11-for-33 (.333) since then...His six hits allowed to lefties in his last start on April 15 tied a career high (also 4/25/23 vs. BOS) and marked the first time in his career that he gave up 5+ hits to left handers in back-to-back starts after allowing five on April 8 at Chicago-AL.

WHIFFIN': Through four starts this season, Bradish has recorded 21 strikeouts and a 9.61 K/9...In 2025, he held a 13.22 K/9 over six starts and struck out eight or more batters in three straight starts from 9/15-28, becoming the first Baltimore hurler to do so since **Dylan Bundy's** four-game run from August 7-29, 2017.

📌 Has recorded nine strikeouts with his sinker this season, which opponents are batting .192 (5-for-26) against.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2023, finished fourth in AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since **Zack Britton** in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)...Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since **Mike Mussina** posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992.

📌 Earned his first career win on May 10, 2022 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since **John Means** threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle.
