**TONIGHT'S TILT...**the Mariners continue the 6-game homestand with the second of 3 games against the Arizona Diamondbacks (1-0)...Seattle will also host the New York Mets (3 G, 6/1-6/3) on the homestand... tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryon Healy** on the call and **Angie Mentink** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS...**the Mariners beat the Diamondbacks in walk-off fashion by a 7-6 final score in 10 innings in yesterday's series opener...Seattle has won 4-consecutive contests (5/25-c) including a dominant 3-game series sweep at the Athletics.

• **Double Digit Madness** - The Mariners have recorded 10+ hits in their last 5-consecutive games (5/24-c), the first time Seattle has accomplished the feat since July 25-30, 2023...the last time the Mariners recorded 6-consecutive games with 10+ hits was April 6-11, 2019.

• **What a Run** - Over their last 5 games (5/24-c), the Mariners offense is batting .318 (61x192) and has scored 35 runs, while the pitching staff has held opponents to a combined 18 runs.

• **Let Me Lead** - Seattle's 53 go-ahead hits this season rank T-2nd in MLB with the Braves, trailing the Yankees (60 H)...the Mariners have also hit 30 go-ahead home runs, ranking 2nd to only the Yankees.

• **A Woo-tiful Day for Baseball** - **Bryan Woo** has made 8 starts of 6.0+ innings pitched and 2-or-fewer walks allowed this season, tied for the 3rd most such games in the Majors...since making his debut in 2023, he leads MLB with 27 such starts, ranking ahead of the next closest Logan Webb-SF (26 G), Zac Gallen-ARI (24 G) and Tarik Skubal-DET (24 G).

**J.P. = JUST POWER...****J.P. Crawford** recorded his first career multi-homer game last night after hitting his 2nd leadoff home run of the season and a 2-run homer in the 5th inning...he has tallied 16 career leadoff home runs with Seattle, ranking 2nd in franchise history behind only Ichiro Suzuki (37 HR)...Crawford has hit safely in his last 5-consecutive games (5/24-c), during which he is batting .348 (8x23) with 6 runs, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 1 walk...he has also recorded multiple hits in back-to-back contests.

**IN OUR AROZARENA ERA...****Randy Arozarena** last night supplied the walk-off win on an RBI double in the 10th inning, his 7th career walk-off plate appearance and 4th with the Mariners...in 58 games this season, Randy is batting .297 (63x212) with 38 runs, 16 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 26 RBI, going 15-for-17 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .382 clip and slugging .467 for an .849 OPS... among qualified American League hitters, he ranks 6th in average, T-4th in hits, T-2nd in doubles, T-7th in runs, and 3rd in SB.

**J-ROD ON A ROLL...****Julio Rodríguez** has continued his excellent 2026 season, going 3-for-5 with 1 run, 1 double, 1 home run and 2 RBI in yesterday's game...Julio has reached base in 13-consecutive games (5/15-c), the T-4th longest active streak in MLB...Julio has hit 9 home runs during May, ranking T-2nd most in the Majors this month along with Byron Buxton-MIN and Juan Soto-NYM, trailing only Kyle Schwarber-PHI (11 HR)...his 9 homers are also the most he's hit in a single month in his career.

**BIG THUNDER RUMBLES ON...****Luke Raley** last night went 2-for-4 with a go-ahead home run in the 6th inning...he is batting .271 (39x144) with 21 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 12 home runs, 30 RBI, a .327 OBP and slugging .569 for an .896 OPS in 52 games this season...over his last 19 games (5/8-c), he is batting .308 (16x52) with 9 runs, 1 double, 6 home runs, 14 RBI and a 1.030 OPS.

**DOMINANCE ON THE MOUND...**the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.57 ERA (205 ER, 516.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 151 walks, along with 492 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.26), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.63), 5th in ERA, 7th in WHIP (1.23) and 10th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 329.1 innings pitched and ranks T-4th in strikeouts (309) and 6th in quality starts (25)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 6th in the Majors in ERA (3.18).

**PIGGYBACK...**in the 2 instances that **Luis Castillo** and **Bryce Miller** have pitched in the same game, the Mariners pitching staff has posted a 2.00 ERA (4 ER, 18.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts and 5 walks as a team, allowing just 11 hits...in those games, Miller has posted a 1.69 ERA (2 ER, 10.2 IP) with 11 strikeouts and 1 walk...Castillo has posted a 2.84 ERA (2 ER, 6.1 IP) with 10 strikeouts and 4 walks...Miller is scheduled to start tomorrow's series finale vs. the D'Backs.

**HE'S NAYLZ...**over his last 34 contests (4/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .336 (46x137) with 16 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 14 walks and 12 stolen bases with an .833 OPS...he has hit safely in his last 5 contests (5/24-c)...among qualified MLB hitters since April 17, Naylor ranks 5th in average and T-3rd in stolen bases.

**COLT LOCKED IN...**over his last 5 games (5/24-c), **Colt Emerson** is batting .333 (6x18) with 3 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI and 2 walks with a .400 OBP, slugging .611 for a 1.011 OPS...Colt became the second player in Mariners history with 3+ doubles, a triple, and homer over his first 10 career games, joining Jim Presley (1984).

**HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS...**upcoming promotions and events on the Mariners current homestand include '90s Weekend (May 29-31) with **Julio Rodríguez** '90s Jersey Night tonight and '90s Pin Day tomorrow...the Mariners will also celebrate Pride Night on Monday, June 1 and host a Mariners Value Game on Wednesday, June 3, with tickets starting under \$12...visit [Mariners.com/tickets](http://Mariners.com/tickets) for more information.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW...****Randy Arozarena** gave the Mariners the walk-off win last night with an RBI double in the 10th inning, his 7th career walk-off plate appearance and 4th with Seattle...**YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...**Seattle's 4 walk-off hits this season are tied for the most in the Majors (also: 5 teams), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...since 2025, the Mariners 14 walk-off plate appearances lead the Major Leagues?...they rank ahead of the next closest Angels, Red Sox, Cubs, Mets and Brewers (13 PA)...during that span, **J.P. Crawford** and **Josh Naylor** also rank T-1st with 3 walk-off plate appearances.

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 30

- **1989** - Randy Johnson made his Mariners debut at Yankee Stadium by holding the Bronx Bombers to just two runs on six hits while striking out six in six innings. Ken Griffey Jr. hit a pair of home runs to lead the offensive attack as the Mariners hung on to win, 3-2.
- **1998** - Alex Rodriguez steals home; the first steal of home by a Mariner since Edgar Martinez in 1990.
- **2001** - Mark McLemore ties a team record and sets a career-high with 4 stolen bases.
- **2012** - The Mariners tied a club road record with 21 runs scored in a 21-8 route of the Rangers in Arlington to win the series 2-1. Justin Smoak hit a pair of 3-run home runs and recorded a career-high 6 RBI. Kyle Seager went 4-for-6 with 2 doubles and 4 runs scored in the win and Jesus Montero fell a triple short of the cycle (3x4, 4 R, HR, 2B).
- **2013** - Nick Franklin hit a pair of home runs, his first two in the Major Leagues, to become the third-youngest Mariners player with a multi-HR game at 22 years, 89 days (only ARod and Ken Griffey Jr. were younger).
- **2025** - **Cal Raleigh** hit a 3-run home run in the 1st inning, and a 2-run home run in the 8th inning to become the first catcher in MLB history to reach 20 home runs before the end of May.

ABOUT BRYAN WOO...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 12th start of the season and his 82nd career start...is also making his 1st start against the Diamondbacks this season and the 3rd of his career...is facing the Diamondbacks at home for the first time in his career.

LAST TIME OUT...L#3 on May 24 at Kansas City, tossing 4.2 innings and allowing 4 runs (4 ER) on 6 hits and 2 walks (1 IBB) and 3 strikeouts...he threw 91 pitches (58 strikes) in his 11th start of the season and first trip to Kauffman Stadium.

GOOD TO BE HOME...is making his 6th home start of the season...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in each of his last 2 home starts (5/18 vs. CWS and 5/6 vs. ATL) with 17 combined strikeouts and just 4 total hits allowed...his 0.806 WHIP and .222 opponent OBP at home this season each rank 4th-best in MLB (min. 5 GS at home).

WHERE IT RANKS...among pitchers with 200+ IP at home since 2023, he leads MLB in WHIP (0.844) and in opponent OBP (.229), ranks 2nd in SO/BB (6.32), 3rd in opponent batting average (.186), 4th in ERA (2.66), and 5th in BB/9 (1.56)...additionally, his 15 quality starts at home since 2025 are tied for 2nd-most in MLB across that span.

QUALITY STUFF...has tossed a quality start in 4 of his 5 home starts and in 7 total starts this season...threw a quality start in 21 of his 30 starts last season, tied for 4th-most in the Majors that season...his total 28 quality starts since 2025 are 2nd-most in MLB, trailing only Cristopher Sánchez-PHI (31 QS).

SHUTTING IT DOWN...has thrown 6.0+ innings without an earned run allowed in 3 starts this season, including in his last home start on May 18 vs. the White Sox...he has thrown 6.0+ IP without an earned run 8 times since 2025, tied for 8th-most such starts across that span.

PLENTY OF PUNCHIES...has thrown 6.0 innings with 9 strikeouts in 3 starts this season (last: 5/12 at HOU)...his 9 starts of 6.0+ IP and 9+ strikeouts since 2025 are tied for the 3rd-most in MLB across that span, alongside Zack Wheeler-PHI and Chris Sale-BOS.

A PAIR OF ACES...has tossed 6.0+ innings with 1-or-fewer hits in 2 starts this season (4/3 at LAA and 5/6 vs. ATL) and in 5 starts since 2025, which leads MLB, ranking ahead of Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD (4 G)...Woo and Emerson Hancock are 2 of 7 pitchers with multiple games of 6.0+ IP and 1-or-fewer hits allowed this season...the Mariners pitching staff has combined for 5 such games this season (also: Luis Castillo), which leads MLB.

WOOOOO...has tossed 7.0+ innings in 3 starts this season (last: 4/19 vs. TEX)...threw 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just 1 hit on April 3 at LAA, his 3rd career start tossing 7.0+ IP with 1-or-fewer hits...his 3 such starts are tied for the most such games in MLB since the start of last season (also: Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD).

WATCH ME WHIP...his 0.99 career WHIP ranks 3rd-best in MLB among qualified pitchers since 2023, trailing Tarik Skubal-DET (0.91), Paul Skenes-PIT (0.93), and Zack Wheeler-PHI (0.98)...his 0.99 career WHIP is also the lowest in franchise history (min. 400 IP).

GOING THE DISTANCE...has tossed 6.0+ innings in 8 starts this season and in 52 career starts...his 35 starts of 6.0+ IP since 2025 are most in MLB while his 250.1 IP since 2025 are 7th-most in MLB.

EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT...currently averages 14.9 pitches per inning this season, T-7th-fewest among qualified starting pitchers, matching teammate George Kirby...is currently averaging 14.9 pitches per inning across his career, 3rd-fewest P/IP among starters since 2023 (min. 400 IP), trailing Tarik Skubal-DET (14.8) and Cristopher Sanchez-PHI (14.8).

FIRST PITCH STRIKE...his 70.7% first pitch strike percentage currently leads the league this season, ranking ahead of teammate Logan Gilbert (2nd, 69.1%)...Woo's 68.3% first pitch strike percentage across his career ranks 3rd-best in MLB among qualified pitchers, trailing Miles Mikolas-STL (69.0%) and Tarik Skubal-DET (68.6%).

FEW FREE PASSES...among qualified pitchers since 2025, he ranks 2nd in walks-per-nine (1.80), 3rd in walk percentage (5.1%) and 4th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.14)...in addition, he has tossed 6.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer walks in 8 of his 11 starts this season and in 35 total starts since 2025 which leads MLB across that span.

WOO HOLDS THE TRIDENT...his 3.29 career ERA (168 ER, 459.1 IP) is a franchise best mark among Mariners starters (min. 75 GS), ranking ahead of Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA.

MAY FLOWERS...May is historically a high performing month as he is 7-2 with a 2.57 ERA (27 ER, 94.2 IP), 7.89 strikeout-to-walk ratio (83 SO, 12 BB) and a 0.856 WHIP while limiting batters to a .199 average (69x347) across 16 career starts in the month of May...among pitchers with 10+ GS in May since 2024, he ranks 3rd in BB/9 (1.14), 4th in SO/BB ratio (6.92), and 4th in WHIP (0.856)...has tossed 6.0+ IP in 13 of those 16 starts in May, including 11 quality starts.
