AT HOME: The team is 35-19 at home, going 12-5-0 in series play.....are 23-10 in the last 33 home games and 12-3 in the last 15.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 28-24 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play.....are 18-6 in the last 24 road games....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 17 replay challenges this season, going 11-6.....their last challenge (won) came on 7/28 vs. Chicago-NL as a safe call at first base involving Nico Hoerner was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseaso eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons [2017-24].....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 729 wins since 2017 [4th in MLB/2nd in National League].

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 24, will make his 20th appearance and 15th start of the season.....Priester last pitched last Wednesday in a start at Seattle and earned a 10-2 win (7ip. 6h. 2r. 2er. 2bb. 6k. 96 pitches).....the team is 8-6 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .230 (88-for-382, 11hr).....he has gone 6-2 with a 2.64 ERA as a starter (75ip, 22er) and 3-0 with a 5.06 ERA in relief (26.2ip, 15er).....he is on an 8-game winning streak over his last 10 games/7 starts while posting a 2.53 ERA (57ip, 47h, 17r, 16er, 11bb, 54k, 6hr).....Priester was acquired from Boston on April 7 for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named (RHP John Holobetz on May 5).....he began the season at Triple-A Worcester (1 start).

LAST SEASON: Priester went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts with Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1gs).....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....he had 2 quality starts..... opponents batted .277 (56-for-202, 7hr).....he went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter (36.2ip, 18er) and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever (13ip, 8er).....Priester was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/OF Nick Yorke.
