TODAY'S GAME: The Giants play their road trip finale this afternoon here in Miami...yesterday's 6-3 defeat evened out the series and left the Giants in need of a win today to secure their first road series victory of the year as well as a .500 road trip.

- ▶ Today's game is scheduled 12:10 p.m. local time, which will be the second-earliest scheduled first pitch time the Giants will have this season.
- ▶ The only game that will start earlier will be the final game of the season vs. St. Louis at Oracle Park, which is scheduled to begin at 12:05 p.m. PT as all teams across the league start their games at the same time on the season's final day.

THE HIGH ROAD: A victory today would hand the Giants their first series win in Miami since taking two-of-three here in 2016...since then, SF has gone six consecutive series without a win here in the 305...according to *Stats, LLC*, this streak is SF's longest in Miami all-time, and tied for its second-longest active streak on the road against a single opponent (having not won their last seven series in Seattle).

EXORCISE THE DEMONS: SF fell to 10-18 (.357) here at loanDepot park since 2015 after yesterday's defeat...the .357 winning percentage is SF's second-worst in any road facility they've played at least 20 games in since 2015.

POWER HOUR: Giants sluggers have been hitting the ball hard this season and making the one of the biggest increases in solid contact rate in comparison to last year...after finishing last season with a 88.7 mph average exit velocity (22nd in MLB), SF's 89.5 mph figure in 2024 is third-highest in the NL behind the Braves (90.2) and Cubs (90.1).

- ▶ SF's +0.8 increase in velocity ranks as the sixth-largest in MLB...their contact rate in the zone (84.3%) has increased 3.4% compared to last season, which marks the largest differential in the NL.

YOU WINN SOME...: RHP Keaton Winn takes the ball for SF today for to make his fourth start of the year and first career appearance against the Marlins...the right-hander has been dealt a tough hand early this year as he hasn't pitched with a lead at any point this season.

- ▶ Winn has received just two runs of support over his three starts...his 1.13 run support average this year is third-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 16.0 innings.
- ▶ However, he has been very successful early in his career when getting ahead of the count...in 92 career PAs ending with Winn ahead in the count, opponents are hitting .135 with a .300 OPS, including a 3-for-22 split this season (SIS)

CAN WE START OVER?: The Giants have struggled against a starting pitcher for a second consecutive game last night...entering play today, SF hitters are slugging just .340 off starters, the second-lowest figure in the NL ahead only of the Mets (.338).

EVERYTHING YOU OWN IN THE BOX TO THE LEFT: The Giants are facing a left-handed starter for a second consecutive day in Marlins LHP Trevor Rogers and just their fourth time overall this year...despite going 1-2 in those games, SF hitters are slashing .287/.339/.406 when facing a southpaw starter.

- ▶ SF's .287 average in those games is fourth-best in MLB and second only to the Cubs (.306) in the National League.

FOOT ON THE GAS: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.'s pinch-hit single yesterday extended his on-base streak to 12 games dating to April 3.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 16 of 18 games this season, and is slashing .386/.481/.523 with seven runs, three doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- ▶ He ranks third in the Majors in batting average and on-base percentage entering play today (min. 45 PA).

- ▶ In his brief MLB career, Wade has excelled during the season's first month, slashing .300/.447/.525 in 46 March/April games with a 19.1% walk rate...Wade's .972 OPS in March/April is by far the best of any month in his career (May - .798, June - .840, July - .734, August - .655, September/October - .751).

JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee lined an 8th-inning single yesterday to extended his current hitting streak eight games...Lee is slashing .314/.351/.371 with two doubles, two walks, two steals and six runs scored in that stretch (since April 7).

- ▶ Lee's 32 hard-hit balls for this season are tied for seventh-most in MLB entering play today.

TOUGH STRETCH: After striking out 13 times yesterday, Giants batters now have 25 strikeouts in the series and 53 in five games this road trip...since Friday (April 12), only the Tigers (63), Twins (61) and Pirates (56) have struck out more than the Giants.

- ▶ Giants batters had just 27 strikeouts over SF's previous five games (April 6-10)...the 27 K's ranked as the third-fewest in MLB in that span.

IT'S IOWA: The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Marlins for the first time in his young career... Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his third consecutive loss on Friday at Tampa Bay after working 5.0 innings and giving up two runs on five hits with six strikeouts...the right-hander walked three in the start and matched a career-high 89 pitches...on the flipside, batters were 0-for-4 with three strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seam fastball...they were 3-for-8 with a homer and just two strikeouts off the pitch in two starts prior.

SEND HELP!: Winn hasn't had much luck in terms of offense this season, getting a combined two runs of support across his three starts this year...his 1.13 runs run support average this season fewest in the NL (min. 16.0ip) and third-lowest in MLB behind the pair of Detroit Tigers Jack Flaherty (0.98) and Reese Olson (1.10)... among pitchers who have made at least three starts this season, only CWS' Chris Flexen has received fewer run support (none).

BANANA SPLIT: Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 41.9% of the time this season...six of his 13 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .192 (5x26) average with just two extra-base hits.

GOT 'EM: Has been very successful at retiring batters when he gets ahead of the count in his young career...in 92 career plate appearances ending with Winn ahead in the count, opponents are hitting .135 with a .300 OPS...this season, he's held opponents to just three hits in 22 such at-bats.

KEEP THEM IN THE YARD: Despite the rocky start to the season, Winn has given up just one home run over his three starts (16.0ip)... the righty surrendered six home runs in nine outings (42.1ip) last year.

SPRING TRAINING: Missed most of the spring while dealing with right elbow soreness...saw Cactus League action twice (one start) in late March and went 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (2er, 5.2ip) and three strikeouts for SF.

2023 SEASON: After starting the year in Triple-A Sacramento, Winn made his Major League debut on June 13 at St. Louis in relief, firing 4.0 innings and picking up the save...he joined SF's rotation two weeks later and made five starts for the Giants, going 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA as a starter...overall, the right-hander posted a 1-3-1 record with a 4.68 ERA and 1.04 WHIP across nine MLB appearances.

SAVING THE DAY: After collecting the save in his Major League debut on June 13, 2023 at St. Louis, Winn became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).

#58 NICKAVILA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/16 at MIA; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in just four of SF's 14 games since having his contract selected on April 1.
- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker
Last Game: 4/15 at MIA; SV, 1.1ip, h, 2k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his second save of the season on Monday.
- ▶ The outing marked his eighth career 1.1ip+ save...since his debut in 2021, only five MLB relievers have recorded more such saves.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: 4/16 at MIA; 1.0ip, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last five outings, Miller has struck out nine hitters over 5.1 innings and held batters to just one hit in 17 at-bats (.059).
- ▶ LHBs are 1-for-11 off him early on...RHBs are 2-for-16.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight games for SF, allowing six runs in 8.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter
Last Game: 4/16 at MIA; 0.1ip, h (5 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 5.1 innings of work with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is 1-0-3 with a 1.93 ERA and 15 strikeouts (9.1ip) in 12 career appearances vs. the Marlins.
- ▶ Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- ▶ Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 4/15 at MIA; 1.0ip (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's first 18 games, allowing three runs (two on HRs) in 6.1ip.
- ▶ Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring.
- ▶ Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (269g).

#65 LANDEN ROUPP ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter
Last Game: 4/12 at TB; 2.0ip (21 pitches)

- ▶ Made his MLB debut on March 29 and has appeared in seven of the Giants' first 18 games...six of his seven outings were scoreless.
- ▶ Roupp struck out 13 of the 29 batters he faced this spring (44.8%).
- ▶ Is the Giants No. 11 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 14 according to *Baseball America*.
- ▶ Was selected by SF in the 12th round of the 2021 draft and appeared in his first big league camp this year.
- ▶ Roupp struck out 42 batters over 31.0 innings (12.2 K/9ip) with Double-A Richmond in 2023 and held opponents to a .206 average.
- ▶ His 1.74 ERA prior to hitting the IL last season ranked as the fourth-lowest in all Double-A (min. 30.0ip).
