RAY REPORT—The Rays open three-game homestand tonight at Tropicana Field against the Tigers...following the three-game stretch vs. Detroit, Tampa Bay will embark on a six-game road trip against the White Sox and Brewers from April 26–May 1...they have alternated wins and losses over their last nine contests (4-5) following a 5-1 stretch from April 6-12...they are 5-5 so far in a stretch of 13 consecutive games without an off day that concludes on Wednesday evening.

✦ With yesterday's 5-4 defeat to the Yankees, the Rays saw their three-game winning streak in rubber matches come to an end, having previously defeated the Rockies (April 7), Angels (April 10) and Giants (April 14)...it also signaled the Rays first road series defeat of 2024.

✦ **Kevin Cash** remains four victories shy of surpassing **Joe Maddon** (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays recalled **RHP Kevin Kelly** from Triple-A Durham and placed **RHP Pete Fairbanks** (nerve-related issue) on the 15-day IL.

ALL ABOUT AMED—With a two-hit effort yesterday, **Amed Rosario** extended his hitting streak to a career-best 13 games, surpassing his previous high of 12 games from June 5-18, 2022...during the run, he is batting .411 (23-for-56) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 11 RBI and 3 SB...the streak is the longest by a Rays batter since **Yandy Díaz** hit safely in 14 straight from May 3-21, 2023.

✦ Rosario has multiple hits in seven of his last nine games since April 12, the most by any player in the majors during that period, ahead of 13 others (5G)...his 10 multi-hit efforts on the season are tied for fifth most in the AL behind **CLE Steven Kwan**, **HOU Jeremy Peña**, **TEX Marcus Semien** and **HOU Kyle Tucker** (all 10G).

✦ His .351 (26-for-74) average ranks second in the AL behind **Kwan** (.358), while ranking fifth in the majors behind **LAD Shohei Ohtani** (.368), **LAD Mookie Betts** (.355) and **MIL William Contreras** (.354).

✦ In 12 career plate appearances opposite Detroit starter **LHP Tarik Skubal**, Rosario is 0-for-10 with two walks and one strikeout.

ROUNDING INTO FORM—In six games since April 16, the Tampa Bay bullpen has posted a 0.77 ERA (23.1IP, 2ER) with 21 strikeouts against six walks while holding opponents to a .160 (13-for-81) average...in the previous 17 games to open the season, Rays relievers posted an MLB-worst 6.92 ERA (67.2IP, 52ER) with 60 strikeouts against 46 walks while opponents hit .279 (74-for-265).

✦ The Rays pitching staff as a whole has turned in a 2.21 ERA (57.0IP, 14ER) with only 6 HR allowed over the last six games...in seven games prior, they registered a 4.94 ERA (62.0IP, 34ER) while allowing 11 long balls.

TROP TROUBLES—Tampa Bay has allowed 20 HR this season at Tropicana Field, the most by any team at their home ballpark, with the next closest club being Toronto (18HR)...the Rays 1.38 HR/9.OIP at home is second highest in the majors behind only the Angels (1.83 HR/9.OIP).

✦ The 20 HR allowed through 14 home games are the most by a Tampa Bay team since the 2004 Devil Rays also surrendered 20 HR...the club record for most homers allowed through 15 home games is held by the 2000 Devil Rays (31HR).

✦ Tampa Bay has conceded at least one home run in 10 of 14 home games, including a season-high 5 HR on April 13 vs. San Francisco.

✦ Rays pitchers have allowed 30 HR overall, the second-highest figure in the majors behind the Blue Jays (31HR).

HOT AND COLD—In 14 games this month, **Richie Palacios** is batting .341 (14-for-41) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 BB and 11 R...he has plated a run in a career-best four consecutive games, tied for the longest-active run in the AL with **MIN Austin Martin** and tied for the second-longest streak in MLB behind **PHI Trea Turner** (8G).

✦ In 18 April games, **Randy Arozarena** is batting .116 (8-for-69) with 1 XBH (2B) and 22 strikeouts...it is the lowest batting average by any MLB player in April, with the next closest being **BOS Cedanne Rafaela** (.129)...it marks his second-lowest average over any 18-game stretch in his career, behind a run from July 16–Aug. 8, 2023 (.109, 7-for-64)...Arozarena has, however, reached base safely in 15 straight games against the Tigers dating back to Sept. 17, 2021.

RISPY BUSINESS—Over their last seven games, the Rays are batting .164 (10-for-61) with 0 HR and three walks against 19 strikeouts with runners in scoring position...in their previous seven games, they hit .310 (13-for-42) with 2 HR, four walks and 10 SO.

✦ On the season, Tampa Bay's .256 RISP AVG ranks 9th in the AL 18th in the majors...the Rays 2023 RISP average of .285 was second highest in the majors behind only the Orioles (.287).

STAYING IN THE FIGHT—Tampa Bay is batting .281 from the 7th inning on, the third-highest average in the majors behind Atlanta (.314) and Baltimore (.298).

✦ **Amed Rosario's** .407 (11-for-27) mark in such situations ranks third in the AL behind both **TEX Adolis Garcia** and **BAL Cedric Mullins** (both .417).

✦ Rosario is also batting an MLB-best .517 (15-for-29) with two outs, ahead of **MIL William Contreras** (.476) and **KC Salvador Perez** (.464).

MOTOR CITY MATCHUP—Tampa Bay and Detroit open a six-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays will travel to Comerica Park from Sept. 24-26, the first leg of their final road trip of the season closing out the year in Boston.

✦ The Rays earned a 5-1 season series victory over the Tigers in 2023, including a three-game sweep at Tropicana Field to open the year from March 30–April 2.

✦ Since the beginning of the 2017 season, Tampa Bay is 15-4 (.789) vs. Detroit at Tropicana Field, including an active five-game winning streak since May 17, 2022.

✦ Overall, Tampa Bay's 26-13 (.667) winning percentage vs. Detroit since 2017 is its second highest against any AL opponent, trailing only Los Angeles-AL (33-15, .688).

DOWN ON THE FARM—It was announced today that **Montgomery C Kenny Piper** was named Southern League Player of the Week for the week of April 15–21...in five games, Piper went 8-for-18 (.444) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 5 RBL...he currently ranks among the SL in RBI (2nd, 12), XBH (T2nd, 6), AVG (3rd, .327), total bases (T3rd, 27), runs (T5th, 9) and OPS (6th, .968).

✦ The Biscuits swept the first round of Southern League weekly awards a week ago, as **SS Carson Williams** was named Player of the Week and **RHP Cole Wilcox** was named Pitcher of the Week.

- ✦ **Ron Cash**, the late uncle of Rays Manager **Kevin Cash**, played two seasons in the majors with the Tigers (1973-74) and hit .297 in 34 career games.
- ✦ Tigers Vice President, Assistant General Manager **Rob Metzler** spent 15 seasons with Tampa Bay, seven of which were as the Senior Director of Amateur Scouting.
- ✦ Rays Assistant Pitching & Rehab Coach **Rick Knapp** was the pitching coach for the Tigers under Manager **Jim Leyland** from 2009-11...his son, **Ricky**, was selected by the Tigers in the 44th round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft out of Port Charlotte High School, but opted to attend Florida Gulf Coast University.
- ✦ Rays LHP **Tyler Alexander** was selected by the Tigers in the second round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Christian University...he made 120 appearances with Detroit from 2019-2023 before being placed on waivers this past offseason.
- ✦ Tigers RHP **Casey Mize**, selected first overall by Detroit in 2018 First-Year Player Draft, resides in St. Petersburg during the offseason.
- ✦ Rays Coordinator, Communications **Allison Schubert** spent the 2021 season as a Communications Assistant for the Tigers.

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander makes his fifth start of the season, including his third at home...has gone 1-2 with a 1.94 ERA (46.2IP, 10ER) in his last eight starts dating back to Sept. 7, 2023...is seeking his first victory since his season debut on March 30 vs. TOR, taking three consecutive no-decisions since that outing...enters tonight's contest with 247 SO, three shy of reaching the 250 SO mark for his career.

LAST TIME OUT—Threw a career-high 107 pitches, but fell one out shy of a quality start in the Rays 5-4 loss to the Angels on April 17 (5.2IP, 8H, 3ER, 7SO, HR)...allowed season highs in both hits and runs...saw his career-long six-start (123BF) homerless streak come to an end following **Mike Trout's** 1st-inning blast...also allowed RBI hits to **Anthony Rendon** (1B) and **Luis Rengifo** (2B)...the 107 pitches were the most by a Ray since **Ryan Yarbrough** on July 19, 2021 vs. BAL (108).

MOTOR CITY KITTIES—Littell has not allowed a run in 10.0 IP spanning five games (1GS) against the Tigers, going 2-0...in his lone previous start opposite Detroit, he tossed 6.0 scoreless frames on Aug. 4, 2023 at Comerica Park, facing three batters over the minimum (W, 6.0IP, 3H, OR, BB, SO)...he is one of nine active pitchers with 10.0+ IP vs. the Tigers without allowing a run—Rays reliever **Colin Poche** (10.1IP) is also a member of that group.

✦ Current members of the Tigers active roster are a combined 4-for-30 (.133) lifetime against Littell.

✦ In 33 games (5GS) against AL Central opponents, Littell is 6-2 with a 3.78 ERA (64.1IP, 27ER), including 1-2 with a 5.47 ERA (24.2IP, 15ER) in his five starts.

✦ In his last five outings against the division, he is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (11.2IP, 7ER)...from July 30, 2020–Aug. 4, 2023, he posted a 1-0 mark and 1.89 ERA (19.0IP, 4ER) over 11 games (1GS) against the AL Central.

EARLY RISER—Littell is 1-0 with a 1.17 ERA (15.1IP, 2ER) in three daytime starts—min. 2 GS, it marks the fourth-lowest day ERA in the AL behind **BOS Kutter Crawford** (0.77), **OAK Joe Boyle** (0.90) and **KC Cole Ragans** (0.98)...he produced a 4.76 ERA (5.2IP, 3ER) in his first nighttime start of 2024 on April 17 vs. LAA.

✦ In his last five day starts dating to Sept. 17, 2023 at BAL, he is 1-0 with a 1.05 ERA (25.2IP, 3ER)...this, compared to 0-2 with a 4.73 ERA (26.2IP, 14ER) in his last five night games (4GS) since Sept. 2, 2023 at CLE.

NO FLY ZONE—He has yielded only 1 HR in his last seven starts since Sept. 17, 2023, a **Mike Trout** solo shot in his last outing on April 17 vs. LAA...Trout's homer is the only long ball Littell has surrendered to his last 146 BF...his current run follows a stretch from Aug. 10–Sept. 12, 2023 in which he allowed 9 HR in a seven-start span (1.90 HR/9.0IP).

SLIDE PIECE—Littell's most effective pitch through four starts has been his slider...opponents are batting 3-for-25 (.120) with 0 XBH and 6 SO against the pitch, including 0-for-8 with 5 SO against left-handed hitters...min. 25 AB ending with sliders, it ties NYY **Ian Hamilton** for the second-lowest opp. average on any MLB pitcher's slider behind SEA **Luis Castillo** (.100)...opponents are 20-for-59 (.339) against Littell's other four pitches.

PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell's 68.9 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks fourth in the AL/fifth in the majors (min. 1,250 pitches thrown)...he trails SEA **George Kirby** (70.6%), DET **Tarik Skubal** (69.6%), MIN **Joe Ryan** (69.1%) and MIA **Sandy Alcantara** (69.6%).

✦ Littell issued multiple walks in two of his first three starts to open the season...he did not have a multi-walk start in all of 2023, going walkless in nine of his 14 starts.

✦ Since walking three consecutive batters in the 1st inning on April 10, Littell has not issued a free pass to his last 43 BF.

ODDS AND ENDS—Opposing leadoff hitters are 1-for-12 (.083) against him, but the 2-4 spots are batting 10-for-30 (.333) with 4 of the 6 total XBH he has allowed...opponents are 3-for-16 (.188) with RISP, including 1-for-10 (.100) with RISP/two outs...has held opposing hitters to 1-for-13 (.077) in full counts...opponents are 10-for-32 (.313) the first time through the order and 7-for-35 (.200) the second time.

✦ His 27.4 pct. hard-hit rate ranks in the 90th percentile of all major league pitchers...he recorded a 41.9 pct. mark in 2023.
